NATIONAL

Student Police Cadet Programme

- The Union Home Minister has launched the Student Police Cadet (SPC) Programme nationally.
- The programme focuses on students of class 8 & 9. It covers two kinds of topic: Crime prevention and control and Values and ethics.
- The programme will be steered by a state-level committee headed by the Principal Secretary, Home Department with the Principal Secretary, Education and Director General of Police as members.
- ✤ A similar committee will be formed at the district level, headed by the District Magistrate with the District Inspector of Schools and Superintendent of Police as members.

'Padhe Bharat- Badhe Bharat'

The Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) has announced 'Padhe Bharat- Badhe Bharat' an initiative to promote the reading culture among students.







- The initiative has been launched under 'Samagra Shiksha'.
- Under this initiative, the government will give an annual library grant to schools to allow students to widen their ambit of learning.
- 'Samagra Shiksha' is an overarching programme for school education extending from Primary to class 12 which was introduced in the Union Budget 2018-19.

INTERNATIONAL

International Army Games 2018

- India will be participating in a major army games event alongside Pakistan and China in Russia and six other countries
- The annually held event, International Army Games 2018, will be conducted from July 28 to August 11 in Russia, China, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Iran, and Kazakhstan.
- The military games, initiated by Russia in 2014, will be co-organised this year by China, Russia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Kazakhstan, Iran, and Armenia.
- The Indian Armed Forces have been participating in the Army Games since its inception.
- This year, two events (Tank Biathlon and Elbrus Ring) will see full participation from the Indian side.
- Armenia and Iran will be hosting competitions on their territory for the first time.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Advanced weather forecasting system

- Minister for Science and Technology Harsh Vardhan unveiled the first of its kind Air Quality and Weather Forecast System, SAFAR at Chandni Chowk in New Delhi.
- The giant true color LED display will give real-time air quality index on the 24x7 basis with color coding along with 72-hour advance forecast.
- The new system can track UV-Index, PM1, Mercury and Black carbon in real time and will provide health advisory and related precaution.







The system was developed by the Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology, Pune in record time and operationalized by the India Meteorological Department.

STATES

'Kharchi Puja'

- Tripura Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb on 20th July, inaugurated the 7 days long "Kharchi Puja" at Puran Habeli, in Tripura.
- The annual festival is meant to cleanse the sins of mortal souls. Originally a Hindu tribals' festivity, it is now observed by all communities and religion.
- The worship starts with the dipping of 14 deities in the Howrah river, followed by the sacrifice of 108 animals
- Kharchi Puja is the biggest festival for the Hindu tribals in the northeastern region.

Forbes highest paid actor

- Forbes has named Hollywood actor Dwayne 'The Rock' Johnson the highest paid actor in the world.
- His earning at \$124 million last year was the largest ever recorded on the Forbes celebrity list.



- ✤ He ranked fifth on the overall list.
- Dwayne Johnson has earned more money for acting in a single year than anyone in the history of the Forbes Celebrity 100 list.
- ✤ The 2018 list calculates earnings from June 2017 to June 2018.

MISCELLANEOUS

Indian Trust for Rural Heritage and Development (ITRHD)

✤ 7th Annual General Body Meeting of Indian Trust for Rural Heritage and Development (ITRHD) was held in New Delhi.





- ITRHD is an NGO devoted to the preservation of Indian Heritage and Culture in Rural India and working in about 7 states of India.
- ITRHD's conservation works include works of 17th 19th century village of terracotta temples, Maluti, Dumka, in Jharkhand.
- The Maluti Project was inaugurated by PM Modi which involves conserving 62 temples of the108 temples which were in a dilapidated condition.
