- 5) DefExpo India- 2018: PM inaugurated the 4 Days DEFENCE-EXPO, 10th edition of the expo was held on (11th Apr - 14th Apr 2018) in Thiruvidanthai, Thiruporur Taluk, Kancheepuram District. THEME: "India: The Emerging Defence Manufacturing Hub"
- 6) **My Green Bin:** It is an "Organic Composter" which converts the *garbages into Organic* Compost which will be given by **Arakkonam Municipality** to every home.
- 7) Train Tickets for unreserved is again started to be printed in "TAMIL" from 25th April 2018, already there are only English & Hindi languages.
- 8) **Elections for cooperative societies:** *M. Rajendran, Commissioner* of Tamil Nadu State Co-operative Societies Election Commission announced that the polls would be held in **five phases.**
- 9) Uzhavan App: It is a Bi-Lingual (Tamil & English) App launched by TN CM. Through this app, the farmers can get the details of Crop Insurance, Farm Subsidies, Weather forecast report.
- 10) Amma Free Wi-Fi zones: TN govt has launched Amma Free Wi-Fi zones (1st 20min's free & Next Rs.10 charged per hour) in five cities on 5th April 2018Namely,

- 11) **12th Century Inscription:** 12th Century Old Inscriptions, Nandhi statue, Romanian style Red pots, Iron knives are found in the **"Mangudi Village" in Rajapalayam Taluk, Virudhunagar District.** (Ancient Tamil Poet **"Mangudi Maruthanar"** lived in the village who was a contemporary to the Ancient Pandiyan King: "Thalaiyalanganathu SeruVendra Pandiya Nedunchezhiyan")
- 12) **Tamil Nadu Digital Library**: *(www.tndigitallibrary.ac.in)* TNCM launched the Tamil Nadu Digital Library.







- 13) Mr. M.K.Surappa was appointed as the Vice-chancellor of Anna University.
- 14) Anitha SAT: is a 500gm lightweight Conical Shaped satellite was made by 17yr old 12th STD student Villet Oviya from Trichy to measure the effects of air pollution and global warming of the earth. The Satellite was launched from Aztra Lab, Mexico.
- 15) Water Desalination plant: The1stphase of desalination plant using electromagnetic waves was launched at Ilayankudi and Suranam in Sivagangai district.
- 16) Governor of TN, Banwarilal Purohit inaugurated and flagged off the "Swachh Thiruvalluvar" awareness van in the Thiruvallur district. It comes under the Swachh Bharat scheme.
- 17) **Thamizhchuddar Award:** Kamban Thamizh Kalagam gave the award to Prof. **Rukmani Paneerselvam.**
- 18) Ramanujar 1001: On 12th April 2018, Ramanujar's 1001 avatar festival was celebrated in Sriperambuthur.
- 19) St. Andrew's Church / The Kirk: The Kirk located in Egmore, Chennai celebrated the 200th Anniversary. One of the oldest churches in Madras built by Scottish Community.
- 20) The best Engineering student of the year awarded to Ms. Janani from Salem. Award was given by India Institute of Technical Education.
- 21) Chennai Metro Rail &State Bank of India jointly released the "SBI PAY" App for the travellers.
- 22) Website & App for Vandaloor Zoological Park: "www.aazp.in" website was introduced to explore the animals & birds virtually. App named as "Vandaloor zoo"
- 23) Tamil Nadu Defence Quad: The Finance Minister announced in the Budget (2018-19) setting of Defence Production Corridors in Tamil Nadu. The corridor will extend from Chennai, Hosur, Coimbatore, Salem, and Tiruchirappalli.







NATIONAL

- Right to convert is a Fundamental Right: From the case of Hadiya, the Supreme Court has recently given a judgment that the right to convert is a fundamental right on 8th March 2018.Right to Freedom of Religion (Art 25 - 28).
- 2) GST e-way Bill: From April 1, 2018, the e-way bill will be mandatory for the interstate transportation of goods worth over Rs. 50,000 through roadways, railways, airways, and waterways. Intra – State transportation bill will come to effect from 15th April 2018. Karnataka was the 1st state to operationalize the intrastate e-way bill system in Sep-2017.
- 3) The University of Hyderabad has discovered **two endangered** languages Walmiki and Malhar predominantly spoken in Odisha.
- 4) **Chennai** is set to join the list of 50 cities notified by **World Council** on City Data Certification. It has been established by the Tata Trusts and the World Council on City Data to develop the urban infrastructures and life of urban people.
- 5) **Bihar government** reduced the *government exam fees for women*. (For Preliminary exams: Rs. 600/- to Rs. 160/- & for Mains Exams: Rs. 750/- to Rs. 200).
- Hyderabad in Telangana has been ranked as the top city and Chennai has been ranked 14th in the "Global City Momentum Index -2018" by JLL.
- 7) Sikkim government gave Rs.1000/- as pension for organic farmers.
- 8) Best Panchayat of India: *Ministry of Panchayati Raj* has given the best panchayat award to the *Digambarpur panchayat in West Bengal*
- 9) **Multi-Modal Logistics Park:** Multi-Modal Logistics Park was planned to set up at **Balli Station near Madgaon in Goa**.
- 10) GI tag has been given to Telangana's **Adilabad dokra and Warangal Dhurries.**







- 11) World's largest solar park (5000MW) was planned to set up at *Dholera, Gujarat.* (Shakthi Sthala of Karnataka 2000MW)
- 12) **Cleanest Airport in India:** *Airports Authority of India* released the report that **Mangalore International Airport** is the Cleanest Airport in India.
- 13) **Toll-Free number in Cigarette packets:** The Union government has ordered to **print the toll-free number 1800-11-2356** in Cigarette packets.
- 14) The **Madras High Court** became 1st High court in south India and overall 8th in India to introduce *e-court fee payment facility*.
- 15) According to the report released by the Steel Users Federation of India (SUFI). India becomes a 2nd largest manufacturer of crude steel and China is the largest producer of crude steel in the world.
- 16) **Intelligent Traffic Management Solution:** *Bengaluru city* tested the prototype of the Intelligent Traffic Management Solution for the 1st time.
- 17) 5G lab: India's 1st 5G is a Massive MIMO Radio lab inaugurated in IIT New Delhi on 13th April 2018. The lab has been set up in Bharathi School of Telecom Technology and Management.
- 18) BS-VI fuel: To suppress the pollution level, Delhi government has planned to impose the ultra-clean Bharat Stage VI grade fuel (both petrol and diesel) on 1st April 2018. (BS-VI = Euro VI) Delhi will be the 1st city in India to impose the BS-VI fuel and Nationwide implementation from April 2020
- 19) Internet Security Threat Report: India is the 3rd most vulnerable country (India moved 1 position above from previous year) to cyber threats after USA and China. The report is released by Symantec.
- 20) National Institutional Ranking Framework 3 (NIRF 3) Rankings
 2018: IISc Bangalore tops in the Ranking and AIIMS Delhi is the Best Medical College in the country released by *Ministry of Resource & Development.*







- 21) Competition Commission of India: The Union Cabinet decided to reduce the number of members from one chairperson and six members to one chairperson and three members.
- 22) **Uttarakhand's second Mega Food Park:** Himalayan Mega Food Park is located at Mahuakhera Ganj in Kashipur, Udham Singh Nagar district. 1st Park was located in Haridwar.
- 23) The Union Cabinet has approved the Protection of Human Rights (Amendments) Bill, 2018 on 5th April 2018 in Parliament. The Bill was previously amended in 1993 and 2006.
- 24) The Union government has **banned the import of hormone oxytocin** to stop its misuse in livestock industry from 7th April 2018.
- 25) The Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) has introduced the secured digitally-signed **QR Code on e-Aadhaar**
- 26) The 8th edition of Theatre Olympics was concluded in Mumbai, Maharashtra after a glorious run of 51 days across 17 cities of India. It was inaugurated in New Delhi on Feb 2018.
- 27) **One nation one election:** Justice B.S. Chauhan Committee released the white paper draft about the simultaneous elections to Lok Sabha and state assemblies.
- 28) West Bengal government gave the approval for the Sunderban Reserve Forest to get Ramsar site status.
- 29) **Project Dhoop**: Food Safety and Standards Authority of India, NCERT and New Delhi Municipal Council jointly introduced this project to create awareness and address **vitamin D deficiency (VDD)** among young people. The aim of the project is to encourage schools to shift their morning assembly to around noon-time, mainly **between 11 am to 1 pm**
- 30) **e-Vidhan project**: To digitize all the **State Legislatures in India** to make them **paperless**.
- 31) Protected Area Permit Regime: *Ministry of home affairs* allowed the foreign tourists to access border areas of *Nagaland*, *Mizoram*, *and Manipur for five years* from April 1, 2018.







- 32) ArchaeoBroma: India's 1st nationwide food archaeology conference was held in Mumbai.
- 33) Supreme Court has issued directions regarding Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (*Prevention of Atrocities Act*), 1989 to prevent the misuse of provisions of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities).
- 34) National Commission for Minority Education Institutions **(NCMEI)** has **original jurisdiction (Art 29 & Art 30)** to determine an *establishment as a minority educational institution.*
- 35) The first meeting of the newly constituted 'NITI Forum for North *East*' took place in Agartala, Tripura.
- 36) NITI Aayog has released a report of Task Force, constituted under
 "Cleaner Air Better Life" initiative on Biomass Management.
- 37) Madhubani Painting: Madhubani/Mithila Painting was used to decorate Madhubani railway station in Bihar which also became one of the cleanest railway stations in India.

- 2) Bangladesh government removes the Quota System from the Government Services.
- 3) Sin tax or Sugar tax: UK government has imposed a tax on Soft Drinks to reduce the obesity and sugar related disease.
- 4) **CLOUD ACT:** U.S. President has declared the **C**larifying **L**awful **O**verseas **U**se of **D**ata Act (CLOUD Act). *The Act establishes processes* and procedures for law enforcement requests for data in other countries.







- 5) **Justice Rajesh Bindal committee:** The committee recommended the Indian government to establish *Inter-Country Parental Child Removal Disputes Resolution Authority* in India.
- 6) **ASIAN PREMIUM:** India, China and other Asian countries combined together to raise voice against **the "Asian premium"** being charged by the **Organisation of the Petroleum Exporting Countries (OPEC).** (Asian Premium is the **extra charge being collected by OPEC** countries from Asian countries when selling oil).
- 7) **Pollution-forecast system:** *India, US, and Finland* jointly developed a new pollution-forecast system.
- 8) India becomes a 2nd largest producer of mobile phones in 2017 and replaced Vietnam. Currently, China is in the no. 1 position.
- 9) **Permanent Indus Commission:** 114th Commission meeting of the Permanent Indus Commission between India and Pakistan was held in **New Delhi.** It was established under the Indus Water Treaty 1960.
- 10) Moscow Conference on International Security 2018:7th Edition of the Conference was held in Moscow, Russia. The Union Defence Minister Mrs. Nirmala Seetharam participated.
- 11) PANMUNJOM DECLARATION: North Korea President Kim Jong-Un and South Korea president Moon Jae-in signed Panmunjom Declaration on 27th April 2018.(Panmunjom is located in South Korea)About Nuclear weapons, Peace Deal, Inter-Korean Communication.
- 12) **African Asian Rural Development Organization** (AARDO) conducts a workshop in **Kochi, Kerala** that mainly focused on food security, agriculture, and fisheries.
- 13) China planned to build a canal to reshape the Indian Ocean. A
 100-km canal built across Thailand which divides it into two parts.
- 14) Global Energy Transformation: International Renewable Energy Agency has launched its long-term renewable energy outlook "Global Energy Transformation: A Roadmap to 2050".

- Global Logistics Summit 2018: The Ministry of Commerce & Industry and World Bank Group organized the summit to improve logistics and connectivity between Intra-state and International trade flow held in New Delhi from April 5 - 6, 2018.
- 2) World Expo 2020: India has signed the contract with Dubai to have *India's Pavilion in World Expo 2020* to be held in Dubai.
- 3) World Hindi Conference 2018: The 11th edition of the conference will be held in Port Louis, Mauritius on August. THEME: Vaishvik Hindi Aur Bharatiya Sanskriti.
- 4) International Buddhist Conference: The Conference was held in Lumbini, Nepal on 29 and 30 April 2018 to commemorate 2562nd Buddha Jayanti. THEME: The birthplace of Lord Buddha and the fountain of Buddhism and the world.
- 5) India-Wiesbaden Conference 2018: The India-Wiesbaden Conference 2018 was held on April 16-17, 2018, in New Delhi. THEME: Securing Global Supply Chains through Government-Industry Partnerships towards Effective Implementation of UNSC Resolution 1540.
- 6) International Energy Forum: 16th Edition of the Conference was held in New Delhi on April 10-12, 2018. THEME: The Future of Global Energy Security: Transition, Technology, Trade, and Investment.
- 7) India Mobile Congress: Department of Telecommunications will be conducting the 2nd edition of the India Mobile Congress in New Delhi on October 2018. THEME: NEW DIGITAL HORIZONS Connect, Create, innovate.
- 8) The 1st Regional Conference of eastern states on Water Resources was conducted by the Ministry of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation held in Kolkata, West Bengal to address outstanding water resources issues.
- 9) Malaria Summit: Malaria No More (Non-Profit Organization) in association with Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation conducts the malaria summit in London, UK.







- 25th Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting 2018 (CHOGM 2018): The Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting 2018 was held in London, UK on 20th April 2018. THEME: Towards a Common Future.
- 11) Atal New India Challenge: The *NITI Aayog* has launched Atal New India Challenge under Atal Innovation Mission to *bring innovations and technologies to the people.*
- 12) **SCO Peace Mission:** India and Pakistan joined together for the 1st time to participate in SCO **counter-terror exercise** in **Russia** in September. Also, all the SCO members participated in the Mission.
- 13) Arab League Summit 2018: 29th edition of the conference was held in Dhahran, Saudi Arabia.
- 14) **WUHAN SUMMIT:** Recently the leaders of **China and India** held an *informal summit* at the **Chinese city of Wuhan**.
- 15) INDIA-NORDIC SUMMIT: 1st India-Nordic Summit took place in Stockholm, Capital of Sweden. Nordic countries include Sweden, Norway, Finland, Denmark, and Iceland. Modi will be the Indian Prime Minister to visit Stockholm since 1988.

- Satyagraha Se Swachhagraha: The Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation launched this Campaign in New Delhi to commemorate the 100th Year of the Champaran Satyagraha (19th April 1917).
- 2) Rupashree scheme: West Bengal government Launches Rupashree scheme for the marriage of poor girls. Before the marriage of a girl an amount of Rs. 25,000 will be credited to that girl's account.
- 3) GOBARdhan Scheme: Galvanising Organic Bio-Agro Resources. The Union Drinking Water & Sanitation Minister has launched the GOBARdhan Scheme in Karnal district of Haryana on 30th April 2018
- 4) Ganga Hariteema Yojana / Ganga Greenery scheme: UP government has launched the scheme in the Banks of River Ganga by planting more trees to Control the soil erosion. THEME: One Peron One Tree.







- 5) POSHAN Abhiyaan: Prime Minister's Overarching Scheme for Holistic Nutrition. The 1st meeting of National Council on India's Nutrition Challenges under POSHAN Abhiyaan was held in New Delhi. The Scheme was launched by PM in Jhunjhunu, Rajasthan on March 2018.
- 6) Gram Swaraj Abhiyan: The Abhiyan was launched for the rural development based on the principle of convergence and saturation launched on the birthday anniversary of B.R. Ambedkar (14th April 2018)
- 7) Van Dhan Scheme: PM inaugurated the Van Dhan Scheme for *Tribal's economic development* during the Ambedkar's day on 14th April 2018 at Bijapur, Chattisgarh.
- 8) 8th Regional 3R Forum: The Ministry of Housing and Affairs inaugurated the 8th Regional 3R Forum in Asia and Pacific was held in Indore, Madhya Pradesh. 3R means (Reuse, Reduce, and Recycle). THEME: Achieving Clean Water, Clean Land, and Clean Air through 3R and Resource Efficiency- A 21st Century Vision for Asia-Pacific Communities.
- 9) Rashtriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan: PM inaugurated the scheme to strengthen the country's Panchayati Raj system on the occasion of the National Panchayat Raj day (24th April 2018).
- 10) Rashtriya Avishkar Abhiyan: Human Resource Development Minister, Prakash Javadekar has launched the scheme. The aim of the scheme is to motivate and engage children of the age group of 6-18 years in Science, Mathematics, and Technology through observation, experimentation, inference drawing, model building, etc.
- 11) Ayushman Bharat Scheme 1st Health & Wellness Centre: On the occasion of Ambedkar birthday on 14th April 2018. Prime Minister inaugurated the first Health & Wellness Centre in Bijapur district, Chhattisgarh to mark the launch of Ayushman Bharat yojana-National Health Protection Mission (AB NHPM).
- 12) **Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana:** Ministry of Agriculture and Farmer welfare has revised the Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana. *The Scheme is to support and promote organic farming and improving soil health.*







- The Union government allowed States to set up its own insurance companies for implementing Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY).
- 14) The Union Government has achieved the village electrification targets after the full electrification of the last village, Leisang Village, Senapathi District, Manipur on 28th April 2018 under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana.
- 15) Unnat Bharat Abhiyan 2.0: Human Resource Development Minister, Prakash Javadekar launched Unnat Bharat Abhiyan 2.0 in New Delhi on 25th April 2018. The aim of the Scheme is to Build Institutes of higher education in research & training relevant to the needs of rural people.

DEFENCE & SPACE

- 1) **Defence Planning Committee:** The Union government has established a Defence Planning Committee (DPC) **under the** *chairmanship of the National Security Adviser (NSA).*
- 2) **SAGAR KAVACH:** Two-day coastal security *exercise Sagar Kavach* was held in Kerala coast conducted by Indian Coast Guard (ICG).
- 3) CHAKRAVAT EXERCISE: Indian Navy conducted Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief (HADR) exercise named Chakravat meaning cyclone with Kerala Government in Kochi Coast.
- GAGANSHAKTI 2018: Indian, Pakistan, and China are going to conduct Joint Air Combat Exercise Gaganshakti 2018, from April 10 to 23, 2018.
- 5) SAHYOG-HYEOBLYEOG 2018: India and South Korea coast *guards* jointly conducted **anti-piracy**, search and rescue exercise in Chennai Coast, Bay of Bengal.
- 6) **KHANJAR V:** *India and Kyrgyzstan* joint military exercise was held in Mizoram.
- 7) HARIMAU SHAKTI 2018: Bilateral military joint training exercise HARIMAU SHAKTI 2018 between India and Malaysia was conducted in Sengai Perdik, Hulu Langat, Malaysia.
- 8) **FOAL EAGLE:** U.S and South Korea joint military exercise.







- 9) **DESERT TIGER 5:** The *United Arab Emirates and Malaysia* jointly concluded military exercise in Dubai, UAE.
- 10) IRNSS-1I: It is the 8th navigation satellite by India, successfully launched on 12th April 2018 by PSLV-C41 from Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh
- 11) **RH-300 MKII:** The *RH-300 MKII sounding rocket* developed by Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre was successfully launched from Thumba Rocket Launching Station in **Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala**.
- 12) **SARMAT:** *Russian* Intercontinental Ballistic Missile was successfully tested.
- 13) **F/A-18 Super Hornet Fighter Aircraft:** Boeing, Hindustan Aeronautics Ltd, and Mahindra Defence Systems make an agreement to manufacture the **fighter aircraft F/A-18 Super Hornet in India**.
- 14) Bhabha Kavach: The Bhabha Atomic Reseach Centre has developed Bhabha Kavach, a next-generation bulletproof jacket, which is of low cost and lightweight.
- 15) LYRID 2018: The Lyrid 2018 meteor shower was visible across the Northern hemisphere. This meteor shower was caused by remains of the C/1861 Thatcher comet.

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

- National Biopharma Mission: The Ministry of Science & Technology launched this Mission on 27th April 2018. The aim of the mission is to accelerate the research towards early development of *biopharmaceuticals under National Biopharma Mission.*
- 2) Earth Bio-Genome Project: The Earth Bio-Genome Project was announced through a paper titled- "Earth Bio-Genome Project: Sequencing life for the future of life" by an international consortium of scientists.
- Fimbristylis agasthyamalaensis: Scientists have discovered a new grass like plant species named Fimbristylis agasthyamalaensis in Ponmudi hills, Agasthyamalai Biosphere Reserve, Western Ghats.







- 4) **4 New Kingfisher Species:** Pied Kingfisher, White-throated Kingfisher, Black-capped Kingfisher, and Common Kingfisher are found in the **Krishna Wildlife Sanctuary, Andhra Pradesh.**
- 5) **Fejervarya goemchi:** Scientists have identified a *new frog species* called Fejervarya goemchi in the *Western Ghats, Goa.*
- 6) **World's Largest Mosquito:** Scientists have discovered a giant mosquito with a wingspan of **11.15** centimetres in Sichuan, China.
- 7) **Odilorhabdins:** Scientists have discovered a new class of **antibiotics** called odilorhabdins that **fights drug resistance**.
- 8) Global nitrogen: New source of *global nitrogen* discovered on Earth's bedrock.
- 9) World's Smallest Land fern: Scientists have discovered the world's smallest land fern (just 1cm long) named *Malvi's adder's-tongue fern* (Ophioglossum malviae) in Ahwa forests of the Western Ghats in Gujarat's Dang district.
- 10) Virtual Reality 360°: Ministry of Tourism and Google has launched a 360° Virtual Reality (VR) video on Incredible India.


