

NATIONAL

National Disaster Risk Index

- The first ever National Disaster Risk Index, which gauges potential hazards and disasters across the 640 districts of India was released.
- It is currently in the form of a draft report prepared by the Union home ministry with support from the UNDP.



- Maharashtra is the most disaster vulnerable state followed by West Bengal, Uttar Pradesh, and Madhya Pradesh.
- ❖ Delhi is most at risk among Union territories (UTs).

Brahmaputra and Sutlej Data Sharing

❖ China has resumed sharing hydrological data on the Brahmaputra and Sutlej rivers with India after a year's gap.





- China stopped the exercise citing that the hydrological gathering sites were washed away due to floods. It also coincided with the 73-day Doklam stand-off that took place during the peak monsoon period.
- China has resumed sharing hydrological data after the two sides held talks over the issue in March.
- ❖ Data will be shared twice daily until October.
- Beijing has started providing data from three hydrological stations Nugesha, Yangcun, and Nuxia, lying on the mainstream of the Brahmaputra, also known as Yarlung Zangbo in China
- ❖ Data is shared from the station at Tsada for the Sutlej, known as Langgen Zangbo

INTERNATIONAL

Annual Passport Index

- ❖ India has bagged the 76th position in a list of the world's most powerful passports, granting its holders visa-free access to 59 countries.
- ❖ The results are part of citizenship planning firm Henley and Partners' annual passport index.



❖ The Index ranks passports based on the number of countries a holder can go to without a visa or the number of countries a holder can go to where they can obtain a visa, visitor's permit, or electronic travel authority upon arrival.





- ❖ As per the annual passport index, Japan has been deemed the world's most powerful passport, with access to 189 countries.
- ❖ The list of 5 most powerful passports are,
 - o Japan 189 countries
 - o Germany, Singapore 188
 - o Denmark, Finland, France, Italy, Sweden, Spain, South Korea 187
 - o Norway, U.K., Austria, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Portugal, U.S. 186
 - o Belgium, Switzerland, Ireland, Canada 185

Dendrobrium Narendra Modi

- ❖ The Indian Prime Minister paid a three-day visit to Singapore.
- ❖ An orchid was named after Prime Minister Narendra Modi to mark his visit to the National Orchid Garden of Singapore.
- ❖ The orchid is named Dendrobrium Narendra Modi.



- ❖ The prime minister visited Singapore's oldest Hindu Temple Sri Mariamman.
- ❖ Built in 1827, the temple was constructed for worship by immigrants from the Nagapatnam and Cuddalore districts of South India.
- ❖ The temple is located in the heart of Chinatown.





Peace Mission 2018

- Member states of the SCO will participate in the joint military drill named 'Peace Mission 2018'.
- The exercises are biannual, multinational drills with the goal of enhancing counterterrorism coordination and cooperation among the eight member countries.



- ❖ Indian and Pakistani armies are taking part for the first time will help ease tensions between the two neighbours and promote positive interactions.
- ❖ The last exercise of the SCO was held in Kyrgyzstan in September 2016.
- ❖ The 2018 exercise will be the first for India and Pakistan since becoming full members of the SCO in 2017
- It also will be the first time India and Pakistan take part in a military exercise together since their independence, though their militaries have previously worked on United Nations peacekeeping missions

Security Council - Non-Permanent Members

- ❖ The United Nations General Assembly elected five new non-permanent Members of the Security Council.
- ❖ Each member serves two-year terms on the body that sets the UN's whole peace and security agenda.





❖ The elected member nations are Germany, Indonesia, South Africa, the Dominican Republic and Belgium.



- ❖ They will fill the seats being vacated by Bolivia, Ethiopia, Kazakhstan, the Netherlands, and Sweden.
- ❖ The other five non-permanent members who will remain on the Council are Côte d'Ivoire, Equatorial Guinea, Kuwait, Peru, and Poland.
- ❖ This will be the Dominican Republic's first time on the Security Council with the other four countries having previously served on the body.

STATES

Zero Based Natural Farming

- ❖ The Andhra Pradesh government launched a Zero Based Natural Farming (ZBNF) scale-out scheme, aimed at benefitting around six million farmers by 2024.
- ❖ The state agriculture department also signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in this regard, with the Sustainable India Finance Facility (SIFF).
- SIFF is an initiative with the partnership of the United Nations Environment Program, the World Agroforestry Center, and the BNP Paribas.
- ❖ The SIFF will extend financial and investment support to the farmers.





Paternity leave for government employees

- ❖ The Haryana government has announced a 15-day paternity leave to all male government employees.
- ❖ The move makes Haryana the first state to grant paternity leaves to its employees.
- ❖ In 2017, Congress MP Rajeev Satav had introduced the Paternity Benefit Bill, 2017 (a private member bill) in Parliament.
- ❖ As per the draft Paternity Benefits Bill, 2017, men will get a benefit of leave up to 30 days as paternity leave.
- ❖ At present, only the All India and Central Civil Services Rules allow Central government employees to get 15 days of paternity leave.

'Urban forest - Museum of Trees'

- ❖ Vadodara Municipal Corporation (VMC) has converted a garbage dumping ground into a "museum of trees".
- ❖ The VMC stopped dumping garbage at a landfill site at Vadasar, on the city's outskirts, in October 2016 and instead planted 12,663 tree saplings of 100 varieties spread over an area of 50,000 square meters.
- ❖ All the saplings have survived.
- This place has been named as 'Urban forest museum of trees'

SPORTS

Women's Asia Cup T20

- ❖ Bangladesh defeated India in final of the Women's Asia Cup T20.
- ❖ Indian captain Harmanpreet Kaur was declared the Player of the Tournament for her consistency with batting.







Shakib Al Hasan

❖ Bangladesh veteran Shakib Al Hasan has become only the third all-rounder in the history of international cricket to complete the rare double of 10,000 runs and 500 wickets.
