- 2) BANGLA: West Bengal government passed the resolution in the assembly for rename the state as "BANGLA" in all the 3 languages (Bengali, Hindi & English) on 26<sup>th</sup> July 2018. [Art. 3 in the constitution speaks about the changing the name of state]
- 3) India was in the 1<sup>st</sup> position in Organ Donation in the World. Turkey & Spain are in the 2<sup>nd</sup> position; Brazil was in the 3<sup>rd</sup> position.
- 4) **Indian Origin US 15yr old boy "Tanishq Abraham"** finished his Engineering at the very young age and now he joined PhD for the research.
- 5) The Union government has reduced the minimum annual deposit requirement for accounts **under Sukanya Samriddhi Yojana from Rs. 1,000 to Rs. 250**
- 6) **President nominates four members to Rajya Sabha:** Ram Shakal, Rakesh Sinha, Raghunath Mohapatra and Sonal Mansingh are the new Rajya Sabha members appointed by the president **according to the Art. 80 of the constitution.**
- 7) **Ravindra H Dholakia committee:** The committee for Sub-National Accounts has been constituted by the Union Government *to upgrade norms for state & district level economic data collection.*







- 8) Agartala Airport: The Union Cabinet has approved the proposal for renaming Agartala Airport in Tripura as *"Maharaja Bir Bikram Manikya Kishore Airport" Agartala.*
- 9) **Prabhadevi Station:** Western Railway renamed **Elphinstone Road** suburban railway station in Mumbai, Maharashtra to "**Prabhadevi Station**"
- 10) **Design University for Gaming:** UNESCO will plan to set up the "Design University for Gaming" in **Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh.**
- 11) Airports Authority of India (AAI) is going to set up a state-of-the-art Civil Aviation Research Organization (CARO) at Hyderabad's Begumpet airport.
- 12) **"I am not afraid of English" initiative:** *Haryana* has launched "I am not afraid of English" initiative to make primary school students fluent in English
- 13) Bengaluru was India's first-ever state-of-the-art e-waste recycling unit.
- 14) Assam government has recently decided to set up a separate directorate for the Divyangs (differently abled people)
- 15) Samsung inaugurates **World's largest mobile phone factory** in Noida, Uttar Pradesh.

- 18) Minority Status for Jews: Gujarat became the 3<sup>rd</sup> state after West Bengal and Maharashtra to give minority status for Jews.
- 19) **"The Eat Right Movement":** FSSAI has launched national campaign *"The Eat Right Movement"* to improve public health and combat lifestyle diseases.







- 20) Jal Bachao, Video Banao, Puruskar Pao: It is the video contest launched by the Union Ministry of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation aims to engage with people of the country on the important issues of water conservation and water management.
- 21) Dharohar Bhawan: Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated 'Dharohar Bhawan' – the New headquarters building of the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI)
- 22) Bansagar canal project: PM Modi inaugurated 171 km long Bansagar canal project in Mirzapur, Uttar Pradesh. It is a joint venture of Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh and Bihar,
- 23) **Paudhagiri campaign:** *Haryana Government* has launched *"Paudhagiri campaign"* a unique program for the planting of saplings.
- 24) SAFAR: Ministry of Earth Sciences has unveiled state-of-the-art Air Quality and Weather Forecast System has launched SAFAR (System of Air Quality and Weather Forecasting by IIM Pune) at Chandni Chowk in Delhi.
- 25) **Tribal Atlas:** *Odisha Government* has unveiled first-ever "**Tribal Atlas of Odisha**", a compilation of demographic and cultural information of the tribal population in the state.
- 26) **Khadi Mall:** India's first dedicated 'Khadi Mall' will be set up by the Jharkhand government to boost the market for khadi and khadi made products.
- 27) The museum for all former Prime Ministers of India will be constructed in the *Teen Murti Bhavan complex* that houses the Nehru Memorial Museum and Library in **New Delhi**.
- 28) **No Toilet, No Bride: Godikan panchayat in Haryana** has become the first panchayat in the country to marry off girls only to families who have a toilet in their house.
- 29) **Trafficking of Persons (Prevention, Protection and Rehabilitation) Bill, 2018.** The Bill provides for the prevention, rescue, and rehabilitation of trafficked persons. *The offenders were*







imprisonment over 7 years extends over 10 years also fined over 1 lakh rupees.

- 30) **Criminal Law (Amendment) Bill, 2018**: Death penalty for those convicted of raping girls below the age of 12 years.
- 31) Uttarakhand high court has declared **the entire animal kingdom**, **including birds and aquatic animals**, **as a legal entity** having rights of a "living person". The move aims to ensure "greater welfare" of animals.
- 32) Mahatma Gandhi International sanitation convention: It will be launched at the 150<sup>th</sup> - anniversary celebrations of Mahatma Gandhi. It will be a first-of-its-kind International Sanitation Convention.
- 33) **MISSION SATYANISHTHA:** Indian Railways has launched "Mission Satyanishtha" **To train every employee to understand the need and value of ethics in Personal and Public life** from the **"Ethics in Public Governance"** programme were organized by Indian Railways. It was first of its kind event organized by any government organization in the country.
- 34) **HOSTESS:** The Kerala tourism development corporation is all set to launch *India's first public sector hotel run entirely by women* for women in the state's capital city, Thiruvananthapuram.
- 35) **Khangchendzonga Biosphere Reserve:** *Khangchendzonga Biosphere* Reserve was included in the UNESCO's World Network of Biosphere Reserve (WNBR) under the Man and Biosphere Programme (MAB). it was 11<sup>th</sup> Biosphere Reserve from India to achieve this recognition.
- 36) **STATUE OF RAMANUJACHARYA:** A 216-foot tall statue of Vaishnavite saint Sri Ramanujacharya is set to be unveiled in Hyderabad. It will become the world's second tallest statue in a seated position and will be called as Statue of Equality, after the statue of the Great Buddha of Thailand (302 feet).

*Leopard, Arabian Sea Humpback Whale and Red Panda* into Centre's Recovery Programme for Critically Endangered Species. They were added on the recommendation by Wildlife Division of Ministry of Environment and Forests and Climate Change (MoEFCC).

- Blood Moon 2018: Century's longest lunar eclipse of 1 hour 43 minutes seen on 27<sup>th</sup> July 2018.
- 5) **World's oldest colour:** Scientists have discovered the oldest colour in the geological record- the **bright pink** pigment aged 1.1 billion years old in rocks deep beneath Sahara desert.
- 6) **The New sources of Neutrinos are discovered:** The IceCube observatory at the South Pole has discovered that a *"blazar"*, a galaxy with a supermassive black hole at its centre, also produces neutrinos.
- 7) **"P NULL" PHENOTYPE:** A team of doctors from Mangaluru's Kasturba Medical College (KMC) has identified a rare blood group called **"pp" or "P null" phenotype for the first time in India**.
