# **TNPSC BITS**

- Digital security company Gemalto released the latest findings of the Breach Level Index, a global database of public data breaches, which ranked India at 2nd place next to US in terms of Data breach.
- The 7th edition of Hand-in-Hand (HIH) combat military drill between India and China to resume in December in the Chengdu region of China. The annual exercise was cancelled after the Doklam stand-off in 2017.
- Congress leader Shashi Tharoor introduced his new book "The Paradoxical Prime Minister" and a 29-letter word "floccinaucinihilipilification".
  - The word "floccinaucinihilipilification" means "The action or habit of estimating something as worthless."
- K Jennitha Anto (Tamilandu) won the gold medal in women's individual rapid P1 chess event by defeating Manurung Roslinda of Indonesia in the recently concluded Para Asian games 2018.

# NATIONAL

## 12th Asia-Europe Meeting (ASEM) summit

- ◆ The 12th Asia-Europe Meeting (ASEM) summit was held in Brussels.
- Vice President M. Venkaiah Naidu led the Indian delegation at the two-day summit.
- ✤ The theme for this year is, 'Global Partners for Global Challenges'.

## **Global Competitiveness Index 2018**

- ✤ India has been ranked as the 58th most competitive economy on the World Economic Forum's Global Competitiveness Index for 2018 (GCI 4.0).
- ✤ The GCI 4.0 assesses competitiveness through the factors that determine an economy's level of productivity.
- ✤ India's rank rose by five places from 2017, the largest gain among G20 economies.
- On the list of 140 economies, the US topped the list and it is followed by Singapore and Germany at the 2nd and the 3rd positions respectively.





- Among the BRICS economies, China topped the list at 28th place. India, however, remained the "South Asia's main driving force".
- The report stated that the global economy is projected to grow nearly 4% in 2018 and 2019.

- ROSHNI is Centre of Women Collectives led Social Action. It is technically and financially supported by UNICEF India.


# India - World's most depressed country

- ✤ According to a World Health Organization report, India is the world's most depressed country, closely followed by China and the US.
- ✤ According to the 2015-16 National Mental Health Survey (NMHS), at least 6.5% of the Indian population suffers from some form of serious mental disorder.





- The average suicide rate in India is 10.9 for every one lakh people. Worldwide, depression increased by 18% from 2005 to 2015.
- Depression is ranked by WHO as the single largest contributor to global disability.



## Dharma Guardian

- The first joint military exercise named "Dharma Guardian" between India and Japan will be held at Vairengte (Mizoram) from November 1 to 14, 2018.
- The exercise is aimed at developing mutual understanding and respect between militaries of both countries, as also facilitate in tracking worldwide phenomenon of terrorism.

## GI Tag for Muzaffarpur's Shahi Litchi

- Muzaffarpur's Shahi Litchi has got official recognition as it receives the Geographical indication (GI) tag.
- The famous Shahi litchi, which is famous for its sweet, juicy, unique flavour and aroma, is mostly grown in Muzaffarpur and adjoining areas of Bihar
- The GI registration was done in the name of 'Litchi Growers Association of Bihar', who had applied for the tag.

# World Anesthesia Day – October 16

- The World Federation of Societies of Anaesthesiologists celebrates World Anaesthesia Day annually with over 134 Societies representing anaesthesiologists from over 150 countries taking part.

## National Ayurveda Day – 17 October

- National Ayurveda Day is observed across the nation on the occasion of Dhanwantari Jayanti (17th October).
- Lord Dhanvantari is considered as divine propagator of Ayurveda.
- National Dhanwantari Ayurveda Award is conferred on this day every year by the Ministry of AYUSH.

## India's highest tricolor

- Union Minister for Minority Affairs Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi unfurled India's highest tricolour on the terrace of the majestic Haj House in Mumbai.
- ✤ The national flag measured 20x30 feet and stood 350 feet above the ground level.
- The flag atop a 20-meter high mast on top of the iconic building near the Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus (CSMT) in south Mumbai.
- It is billed as the highest tricolour installed on the terrace of any building of such height in the country.

## World's biggest book sale

- The first-ever 'Big Bad Wolf Book Sale Dubai', the world's biggest book sale, has been started in the Emirate of Dubai on 18th October, 2018.
- Sig Bad Wolf Books was founded in 2009 in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.
