TNPSC BITS

- Senior Uttarakhand high court judge Vijay Kumar Bisht has been appointed as the new Chief Justice of Sikkim high court.
- PNB MetLife, a private life insurer, has gone live with an Artificial Intelligencepowered customer service app 'Khushi', which aims to aid policyholders for their insurance-related queries.
- According to data from the U.S. Department of Labour, Tata Consultancy Services is the only Indian company among top 10 firms to get foreign labour certification for the H-1B visas for the fiscal year 2018.

NATIONAL

India's first engine-less train - Train 18 (T-18)

- India's first engine-less train, Train 18, which is being regarded as a successor to the 30-year-old Shatabdi Express, is set to hit the tracks for trials on October 29.
- The swanky train is a 100% 'Make in India' project, manufactured at the ICF (Integral Coach Factory), Chennai.
- The full AC train is equipped to run at a speed of up to 160 kmph as against Shatabdi's 130 kmph which will cut down travel time by 15%
- T-18 is not only a self-propelled engine-less train (similar to the Metro trains) but also energy-efficient as its coaches will be fitted with LED lights.

Nageshwar Rao - Interim Director of CBI

- Alok Kumar Verma, Director of CBI (Central Bureau of Investigation) and Rakesh Asthana, Special Director of CBI were divested of their roles.
- The move comes following allegations of corruption by senior functionaries of CBI one against another.
- The Appointments Committee of the Cabinet has approved the appointment of M. Nageshwar Rao as Interim Director of CBI with immediate effect (October 24).
- ✤ He is currently working as Joint Director of CBI.





INTERNATIONAL

Paul Biya re-elected as Cameroon's President

- Cameroon's President Paul Biya has been re-elected for a seventh term, extending his 36-year rule over the nation.
- Biya has won 71.3 % of the vote, far ahead of opposition candidate Maurice Kamto's 14.2 %.
- Biya is currently the longest-ruling non-royal leader in Africa.
- He is also the oldest ruler in Sub-Saharan Africa after Robert Mugabe stepped down during the 2017 Zimbabwean coup d'état.

First trilateral meeting on Chabahar port project

The first trilateral meeting between India, Afghanistan and Iran of Coordination Council of Chabahar Agreement was held in Tehran, capital city of Iran.



- India, Iran and Afghanistan in May 2016, had signed the agreement.
- The pact involves establishment of transit and transport corridor among the three countries using Chabahar Port as one of regional hubs.





The meeting assumes significance as strategically-located Chabahar port on energy-rich Iran's southern coast was coming under the ambit of US sanctions on Iran.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Superflares from the Young Red Dwarf Stars

- By using Hubble Space Telescope, NASA scientists have found that violent flares from the Young Red Dwarf Stars may make planets orbiting it uninhabitable by affecting their atmospheres.
- Hubble is observing such stars through a large programme called HAZMAT (Habitable Zones and M dwarf Activity across Time).
- ✤ "M dwarf" is the astronomical term for a red dwarf star.
- The purpose of the HAZMAT program is to help understand the habitability of planets around low-mass stars.
- The word "HAZMAT" describes substances that pose a risk to the environment, or even to life itself.
- The HAZMAT programme is an ultraviolet survey of red dwarfs at three different ages: young, intermediate, and old.
- Red dwarf is the smallest, most abundant and longest-lived type of star in our galaxy.

PERSONALITIES, AWARDS AND EVENTS

UN Award for excellence

- Invest India, the country's investment promotion body, has won the United Nations (UN) Award for excellence in promoting investments in sustainable development.
- It has been awarded for excellence in servicing and supporting major global wind turbines company in establishment of blade manufacturing plant in India.
- The award was presented by Armenian President Armen Sarkissian to CEO of Invest India Deepak Bagla at the World Investment Forum, Geneva.

UN Investment Promotion Award

- The awards are given annually by United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD).
- ✤ It has been awarded since 2002 as part of its investment promotion and facilitation programme.



- It honours Investment Promotion Agencies (IPAs) and their governments for their achievements.
- The 2017 winners were Ethiopian Investment Commission, COFIDES of Spain, and Board of Investment of Mauritius.

2018 Seoul Peace Prize

- The Seoul Peace Prize Committee has decided to confer 2018 Seoul Peace Prize on Prime Minister Narendra Modi.
- He is the fourteenth recipient of this award and it will be presented to him by the Seoul Peace Prize Foundation.
- It was awarded to him in recognition of his dedication for improving international cooperation, contributions to the growth of Indian and global economies.
- It also credited 'Modinomics' for reducing social and economic disparity between rich and poor.





Seoul Peace Prize

- It was established in 1990 to commemorate the success of the 24th Olympic Games held in Seoul, South Korea.
- It was established to crystallize Korean people's yearning for peace on Korean Peninsula and in the rest of the world.
- It is awarded biennially to those individuals who have made their mark through contributions to harmony of mankind, reconciliation between nations and world peace.
- Past laureates include distinguished global personalities like German Chancellor Angela Merkel, former UN Secretary General Kofi Annan.

SPORTS

Fastest to reach 10,000 Runs in ODI Cricket History

- The Indian cricket captain Virat Kohli has become the fastest batsman to score 10,000 runs in the history of ODI (One Day International) cricket.
- ✤ He achieved this feat in his 205th innings against West Indies.
- The 29-year-old overtook Sachin Tendulkar, who had reached 10,000 ODI runs in his 259th innings, against Australia in 2001.
- ✤ Kohli has become the 5th Indian to reach the mark in ODIs.
- ✤ Apart from Kohli, Tendulkar, Sourav Ganguly, Rahul Dravid, and MS Dhoni have scored over 10,000 runs in ODIs.

IMPORTANT DAYS

United Nations Day – 24 October

- The United Nations Day was observed across the World on October 24 marking the 73rd anniversary of the UN Charter's entry into force.
- The Day was observed since 1948 with an aim to celebrate everything that the UN represents and has achieved since its establishment in 1945.
- The 2018 UN Day Concert was held in the General Assembly Hall at United Nations Headquarters in New York.
- The Concert was sponsored by the Permanent Mission of India to the United Nations.





- ✤ The theme of 2018 UN concert was "Traditions of Peace and Non-violence".
- United Nations Day is part of United Nations Week, which runs from 20 to 26 October.

World Development Information Day - 24 October

- The World Development Information Day (WDID) is observed every year on October 24.
- Its aims to draw attention of world to development problems and necessity of strengthening international cooperation to solve them.
- ✤ The day has been observed since 1972, coinciding with the United Nations day.
- The UN General Assembly in 1972 established the World Development Information Day by adopting measures proposed by UNCTAD (United Nations Conference on Trade and Development).
