Justice C Manickam Committee	To organize Jallikattu 2020 in Avaniyapuram, Palamedu and Alanganallur in Madurai

- 3) **Riya**, a *transgender*, became the **first person from the community** to get elected as Tiruchengode Panchayat Union member from Karuveppampetti ward.
- 4) **J Sandhiya Rani**, a 21-year old has become the **youngest woman village panchayat president** in the state to get elected as Kattinaikanthotty village panchayat in Krishnagiri district
- 5) In Tamil Nadu, **“One Nation – One Ration Card Scheme”** was implemented first time in **Tirunelveli and Tuticorin districts** on pilot basis.
- 6) **India’s highest Female Child Birth rate has been Registered in Tamil Nadu:**
 - ✓ India = 914 Females / 1000 Males
 - ✓ Tamil Nadu = 943 Females / 1000 Males
- 7) In **Uzhavan app**, 3 more services such as **FARM GUIDE, ORGANIC PRODUCTS and FPO PRODUCTS** are added, already there 14 services in the app.
- 8) The **222 Squadron (Tiger Sharks Squadron)** of Sukhoi - 30MKI fighter jets was inducted by the Indian Air Force in **Thanjavur, Tamil Nadu**.
- 9) The **Goat Research Institute** will be set up at **Sankarankoil in Tenkasi district**
- 10) **Tamil Nadu Assembly** passed the Bills to rename Tamil Nadu Fisheries University and Tamil Nadu Music and Fine Arts University as **“Tamil Nadu Dr. J.Jayalalithaa Fisheries University (TNJFU) and Tamil Nadu Dr. J.Jayalalithaa Music and Fine Arts University (TNMFAU)”** after the late Chief Minister and AIADMK leader J Jayalalithaa.



- 11) **Tamil Nadu** has retained the *third rank in the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) India Index 2019*, released by NITI Aayog.
- 12) **Thiruverkadu Police** had introduced the first set of boards with *QR (quick response) codes* recently within their limits. *The boards are intended to help people find the nearest police station.*
- 13) **Vice President M. Venkaiah Naidu** inaugurated the **173rd annual Thyagaraja Aradhana** in Thiruvaiyaru on 11th January 2020.
- 14) **Tamil Nadu** has received an award from the Defence Minister Rajnath Singh for *“Best Performance in Road Safety”*
- 15) **The Governments of Tamil Nadu and Kerala** planned to conduct a joint study of the archaeological sites at *Muziris near Kodungallur, Kerala, and Keeladi in Sivaganga district.*

NATIONAL

- 1) India celebrated its **71st Republic Day on 26th January 2020**
 - ✓ **CHIEF GUEST:** Brazilian President Jair Bolsonaro
- 2) The Andhra Pradesh Assembly has passed **The Andhra Pradesh Decentralisation and Equal Development of All Regions Bill, 2020**. This law paves the way for **three capitals for the state**.

Amaravati	Legislative Capital
Visakhapatnam	Executive Capital
Kurnool	Judicial capital

- 3) **Telangana state** has declared the **“Year 2020 as the Year of Artificial Intelligence”**
- 4) The Railways has renamed the **Railway Protection Force (RPF) as “Indian Railway Protection Force Service”**
- 5) The central government told the Supreme Court that **state governments were free to decide whether to implement the 10% reservation for the economically backward in jobs and admissions**.
- 6) Cabinet approves **Extension of term of the commission constituted under Article 340** of the constitution **to examine the issue of Sub - categorization within other Backward Classes in the Central List**.
- 7) The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has declared the **entire State of Nagaland as a “disturbed area”** for six more months, under **the Armed Forces (Special Powers) Act, 1958 (AFSPA)**.
- 8) **India achieved complete phase out of HCFC - 141 b**, one of the most potent ozone depleting chemical after **Chloro Fluoro Carbons (CFCs)**
- 9) From 2020, people in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir will have a **public holiday on October 26 for the first time**. The day, which will be observed as Accession Day, marks the signing of the Instrument of Accession by the last Dogra ruler of J&K, Maharaja Hari Singh, with the then Governor-General of India, Lord Mountbatten.



- 10) **Kerala and Chhattisgarh** have filed a suit in the Supreme Court challenging the constitutional validity of various central laws such as **Citizenship Amendment Act (Kerala) and the National Investigation Agency Act (Chhattisgarh)**, under **Article 131** of the Indian Constitution.
- 11) **Kerala** has become the **1st state in India to pass an Anti - Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA)**
- 12) India's First **"Rehabilitation Centre for Freshwater Turtles"** has been opened in **Bihar**
- 13) **Andhra Pradesh Cabinet** has approved a statutory resolution **seeking the abolition of the Legislative Council.**
- 14) **Ministry of Law and Justice** has started a scheme for setting up **1023 Fast Track Special Courts (FTSCs) for rape and POSCO act cases, as a part of National Mission for Safety of Women (NMSW).**
- 15) The **3rd Bodo Peace Accord** as tripartite agreement between **the Centre, Assam Government and the banned Assam-based insurgent group National Democratic Front of Bodoland (NDFB)** was signed on 27th January 2020, for bringing a lasting peace in Bodo-dominated areas in Assam.
- 16) A four-party agreement among **the Centre, Mizoram government, Tripura government, and leaders of Bru community** was signed to end the 23 - year old Bru - Reang refugee crisis.
- 17) The **Zoological Survey of India (ZSI)** and Gujarat's forest department joined together for the first time a process **to restore coral reefs using the bio rock technology.** A bio rock structure was installed one nautical mile off the Mithapur coast in the Gulf of Kachchh.
- 18) **The Ramsar Convention has declared 10 more wetlands in India** as sites of international importance.

- 20) **Nagardhan excavations:** Archaeological excavations at Nagardhan, near **Nagpur**, have provided the evidence on the life, religious affiliations and trade practices of the **Vakataka dynasty** and also about the **Vakataka rule under Queen Prabhavatigupta**
- 21) **Akhil Bharatiya Marathi Sahitya Sammelan**, passed a resolution demanding the declaration of **Marathi as a 'Classical' language**
- 22) **Ministry of Finance** announced on 30th January 2020 that the union government will achieve the aim of **Housing for All by 2022 under the scheme of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Grameen (PMAY-G)**.
- 23) **Hyderabad** has been named as the **most dynamic city in the world by Jones Lang Lasalle (JLL)**



- 24) Recently, Supreme Court has approved the **import of “African Cheetahs” from Namibia**
- 25) **Andhra Pradesh** will launch the “**Jagananna Amma Vodi programme**” a financial assistance of ₹15,000 will be provided to **Parents or guardians who send their children to school.**
- 26) **Gujarat Government** to set up “**Vikram Sarabhai Children Innovation Center**” to identify, nurture and promote innovation by children in the state.
- 27) **Andhra Pradesh Government** signed Memorandum of Understanding with a **German firm to implement Zero Budget Natural Farming in the state.**
- 28) **Gujarat Government** has decided **to import water - soluble fertilizers from China**
- 29) The Union Government has proposed **to conduct “Saksham campaigns” across the country to highlight the importance of fuel conservation**
- 30) **Punjab** became the second state in the country after Kerala **to pass an assembly resolution seeking repeal of the Citizenship (Amendment) Act on 17th January 2020**
- 31) The Union Government renamed its “**National TB Control Programme**” to “**National Tuberculosis Elimination Programme**”
- 32) Oxford University Press **named “Samvidhaan” (Constitution) as the Oxford Hindi Word of 2019**
- 33) The Ministry of Tribal Affairs has recommended the Central Government to declare **Ladakh as a Tribal area under the 6th Schedule of Indian constitution**
- 34) **The Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) observed 2020 as the Year of Mobility for the welfare of the troops.**

- 7) **Australia is facing worst wildfires seen in decades** that led to a huge humanitarian and environmental crisis







Tax proposals

- Concessional tax rate for cooperatives proposed.
- Turnover threshold for audit of MSMEs increased.
- Extension of time limits pertaining to the tax benefits for affordable housing.
- Issuance of Unique Registration Number to all charity institutions for easy tax compliance.


