

TAMIL NADU

1) HIGHLIGHTS OF THE TAMIL NADU BUDGET 2020-2021:

PRESENTED BY: Deputy Chief Minister Mr. O. Paneerselvam

PRESENTED ON: 14 – 02 - 2020

Every Year on **24**th **February**, birth anniversary of the late chief minister J Jayalalithaa will be celebrated as the "STATE GIRL CHILD PROTECTION DAY"

- Famil Nadu's economy grew at 8.17 per cent in 2018-19.
- In 2019-20, growth is projected to be 7.27 per cent,
- Which is significantly higher than the projected all India growth rate of 5 per cent.

Tamil Nadu Energy Development Agency (TEDA) will establish 'Amma Green Gramam' as sustainable energy villages with mini rural renewable energy parks each with a capacity of 5 MW.

The Tamil Nadu Solar Energy Policy 2019 that was recently unveiled by the Hon'ble Chief Minister, will increase the **solar power generation capacity of the State to 9,000 MW by 2023**.

Kadaladi Ultra Mega Solar Photovoltaic Park Power Project with a capacity of 500 MW at a cost of Rs.2,350 crore.

A new **Tamil Nadu State Child Policy** is under formulation and will be launched shortly.

The Chief Minister has sanctioned an amount of Rs.12.21 crore for the establishment of a world class new site museum at Keeladi

The Chief Minister Declare the Cauvery Delta Region as a "Protected Special Agricultural Zone (PSAZ)" - The protected zone will include Thanjavur, Tiruvarur, Nagapattinam districts and delta regions of Trichy, Ariyalur, Cuddalore and Pudukkottai

Tamil Nadu securing the **first rank amongst 18 biggest States** in the composite ranking in the **Good Governance Index** released by Government of India on December 25, 2019.

The Government will launch the **'Uzhavar-Aluvalar Thodarbu Thittam'** to ensure closer interface of department officials with farmers

- The Government will launch the **Tamil Nadu Road Safety Mission**, to co-ordinate the efforts of different departments and agencies to achieve the goal of **'Road accident-free Tamil Nadu'**
- Road safety cells will be created in Chennai, Madurai and Coimbatore Corporations.





The Chief Minister launched the **Tamil Nadu Water Resources Conservation and Augmentation Mission** as a people's movement.

The Government has obtained the environmental clearance for the **Athikadavu** - **Avinashi** *irrigation scheme*. A sum of Rs.500 crore is provided in the Budget Estimates 2020-21 for this project.

The Government will launch a new five year 'Chief Minister's Rural Self Sufficiency Development Programme' for the rural development

Erode, Vellore and Hosur has been selected for the "Tamil Nadu Sustainable Urban Development Project"

- 2) Chief Minister released the book about his three year achievements namely "Coffee Table Book"
- 3) For the Farmer's welfare, **"NADANTHAI VAZHI CAVERY SCHEME"** has been launched to Restoration of Cavery River and its tributary
- 4) Sahitya Akademi Prize 2019 for her Tamil translation:

- 5) **Girl Child Protection Scheme, 2020** was launched by the chief minister on 26th February 2020
- 6) The **2nd International Airport** in chennai was planned to set up in **Parathoor** near Kancheepuram district.
- 7) Tamil Nadu Polymer Industries Park will planned to set up at Ponneri,
 Thiruvalluvar district.
- 8) The 'kumbhabhishekam' (consecration) of the 1,010-year-old **Brihadeeswarar Temple** or the Big Temple is being held at Thanjavur.
- 9) **Coimbatore** based social entrepreneur, **Arunachalam Muruganantham** has obtained the patent rights for the low-cost sanitary pad-making machine
- 10) **Poompuhar, a port city in Tamil Nadu**, submerged under Sea 1000 years ago is being digitally reconstructed under Indian Digital Heritage project.





- 11) **Tamil Nadu and Puducherry have strongly objected to Karnataka's bid** to seek approval for the Mekedatu dam project at the 5th Cauvery Water Management Authority (CWMA) meeting in New Delhi.
- 12) **Tamil Nadu government** has won **four SKOCH awards** for its excellence in implementing various agricultural programmes in the State.
- 13) Tamil Nadu has launched the Central government's "ONE NATION, ONE RATION CARD" scheme in Tuticorin and Tirunelveli districts of the State on 1st February 2020 as a pilot project.
- 14) Chief Minister inaugurated a new cricket stadium in Kariveppilapatti near Thalaivasal in Salem district on 9th February 2020.
- 15) Chief Minister laid the foundation stone for the **Advanced Institute for Integrated Research on Livestock and Animal Sciences** on 9th February 2020 at **Thalaivasal** in Salem district.
- Chief Minister laid the foundation of the **new centralised kitchen of Akshaya Patra** Foundation's **"BREAKFAST SCHEME" (KAALAI UNAVU THITTAM)**for Chennai Corporation Schools on 15th February 2020





NATIONAL

- 1) **Donald Trump visited India** becoming first US President to come to India on a stand-alone visit in the seven decades of Indo-US diplomatic ties. 'Namaste Trump' event was organised on the lines of 'Howdy, Modi!' held in Houston last year.
- 2) Kerala has declared the novel coronavirus (nCoV) infection a State calamity
- 3) The **Kashi Mahakal Express** is the India's third corporate train after the two Tejas Express trains between Delhi-Lucknow and Mumbai-Ahmedabad
- 4) **Manipur** has launched an online portal for the *travellers to seek Inner Line Permits.*
- 5) The Union government has constituted the **Delimitation Commission for** the purpose of delimitation of Assembly and Parliamentary constituencies in the Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir and the States of Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur and Nagaland.
- 6) Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, approved scheme "Formation and Promotion of Farmer Produce Organizations (FPOs)".
- 7) Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs launched two Assessment Frameworks, viz. Ease of Living Index (EoLI) and Municipal Performance Index (MPI) 2019.
- 8) The Union Cabinet has given its approval for setting up a **Major Port at Vadhavan**, located about 190 km north of JNPT in Maharashtra.
- 9) The Government of India has placed the draft "Visionary Perspective Plan (2020-2030) for the conservation of avian diversity, their ecosystems, habitats and landscapes in the country" in public domain
- 10) **Arunachal Pradesh** government is planning to build a highway named East-**West Industrial Corridor** which includes a 40-km elevated stretch through the core areas of Pakke Tiger Reserve (PTR).
- 11) The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) aims to set up Ultra **Mega** Renewable Energy (RE) Parks with a capacity of a total of **50 GW** in Gujarat and Rajasthan.





- 12) **Facebook** launched the 'We Think Digital' programme in partnership with the National Commission for Women (NCW) and Cyber Peace Foundation to provide digital literacy training to 1,00,000 women across seven states.
- 13) **Kerala** plans to set up a **Mahatma Gandhi Smriti Museum at Payyanur**, situated on the banks of the Perumba River in Kerala's Kannur district.
- 14) **Demand to put reservation provisions** for schedule caste, schedule tribe and other backward classes under 9th schedule of constitution.
- 15) **Himachal Pradesh** became the first stsate in the country to have **100% LPG** gas coverage
- 16) The Election Commission of India has been awarded 'Silver' for Excellence in Government Process re-engineering for digital transformation for the year 2019-20. The award was given in recognition of ERONET.
- 17) Assam's Welfare of Minorities and Development Department has announced plans to hold a census of four communities broadly known as "Assamese Muslims" Goriya, Moriya, Deshi, and Julha.
- 18) Maharashtra government has announced *five day working week* for its officers and employees from **29**th February **2020**.
- 19) A 'fruit train', said to be the first of its kind in the country, was recently flagged off from *Tadipatri Railway Station in Andhra Pradesh*.
- 20) Kerala will impose a ban on the sale of compact fluorescent lamps (CFL) and incandescent (filament) bulbs from November 2020.
- 21) **Kerala government** has proposed to set up a **Vigilance Wing in the Health Department** to monitor private practice by doctors and crackdown on quackery.
- 22) **Odisha government** has recently launched *a virtual police station* to provide more comfort and ease to its citizens in registering complaints
- 23) **Karnataka government** announced the launch of *a new doorstep delivery* scheme "Janasevaka scheme"
- 24) Andhra Pradesh government inaugurated the first Disha Police Station in Rajamahendravaram





25) The India's *first intercity electric bus service between Mumbai and Pune* was started on 14th February 2020.

INTERNATIONAL

- 1) **Britain** has officially left the European Union (EU) on 31st January 2020 and has **become the first country to leave the 28-member bloc**.
- 2) **India and Myanmar** signed number of agreements with a focus on **socio-economic development** of Myanmar during the State Visit of the President of Myanmar to India.
- 3) Kangaroo Mother Care (KMC):
 - It is the intervention where babies are placed in skin-to-skin contact with their mothers and exclusively breast fed.
 - It has been recommended worldwide for stable low-birth weight new borns.
 - **WHO** recommends that it be continued till baby attains a weight of 2.5 kg or till babies wriggle out
- 4) The US has approved the sale of an *Integrated Air Defence Weapon System* (IADWS) to India
- 5) The major **locust attacks** have been observed in several countries in western and southern Asia and in eastern Africa.
- 6) Pakistan Prime Minister Imran Khan has declared **a national emergency in the country because of the massive locusts** attack damaging the entire crops in the Punjab province of Pakistan
- 7) India and Maldives signed MoUs for establishing the Addu Tourism zone in five islands of Addu atoll.
- 8) **UK** has launched the **new points-based immigration system**, which intends to change the way migrants will come to the UK to work, study, visit or join their family.





ECONOMICS

- 1) The finance minister has introduced "THE DIRECT TAX VIVAD SE VISHWAS BILL, 2020" in the Lok Sabha to give effect to the Budget announcement to resolve direct tax disputes.
- 2) The International Monetary Fund (IMF) released the World Economic Outlook report depicting India as the 5th largest economy in the world.
- 3) The Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) allowed 100% FDI in insurance intermediaries through the automatic route.
- 4) A Dutch government's proposal to build two mega dams to separate the North Sea from the Atlantic Sea
- 5) Ease (Enhanced Access and Service Excellence) 3.0 reform agenda aims at providing smart, tech-enabled public sector banking for aspiring India
- 6) NITI Aayog will launch National Data and Analytics Platform (NDAP) in 2021
- 7) The Reserve Bank of India announced that it will create a Digital Payment Index by July 2020.

SPORTS

- 1) After **Srinivas Gowda** created a storm by covering **100 metres in 9.55 seconds**, another Kambala runner Nishant Shetty has now overtaken the former by completing the same distance in 9.51 seconds.
- 2) The *flame-throated bulbul*, also called the Rubigula, was chosen as the mascot of the 36th National Games to be held in Goa because it is the State bird
- 3) P.V. Sindhu and Mary Kom are among the 5 nominees for the inaugural BBC Indian Sportswoman of the Year award
