# **MARCH - 2020**

### TAMIL NADU

- 1) CoBuddy App: Tiruvallur Police have launched an app to provide a platform between people on home quarantine for Covid-19 and the state government.
- 2) **Chalo App:** The bus passengers in Chennai can now 'live' track government buses using 'Chalo' app
- 3) The Tamil Nadu government has announced a complete lockdown of the state from 6 pm on 24<sup>th</sup> March to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020 to prevent the spread of COVID 19
- 4) The Chief Minister announced the creation of a **new 38<sup>th</sup> district** of **Mayiladuthurai on 24<sup>th</sup> March 2020**
- 5) The Chief Minister announced the creation of an Information Centre Park, Nemili and Mannur villages in Sriperumbudur taluk
- 6) Greater Chennai Corporation launched the "massive containment plan" to ensure that the virus doesn't spread within the city
- 7) The State has constituted **an expert committee comprising 19 members** to track the spread of the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) in the state
- 8) The excavation works at archaeological sites at **Adichannallur and Sivakalai in Tuticorin district and Kodumanal in Erode district** will commence soon said by minister for Tamil culture and archaeology Ma Foi K Pandiarajan
- 9) **C. Ponnaiyan** assumed office as the **Vice-Chairman of the State Planning Commission**
- 10) The Tamil Nadu government is planning to set up *a new solar park project in Kamuthi*, 30km from Kadaladi, in Ramanathapuram district
- 11) The Tamil Nadu Food Safety and Drug Administration has made it mandatory for the temple administrators to obtain BHOG certificate from FSSAI (Food Safety and Standards Authority of India).
- 12) The Chief Minister launched the Tamil Nadu Health System Reform Programme in Chennai on 4th March 2020



### **CORONA VIRUS**



The first case of a coronavirus in India was identified from Thrissur, Kerala, on 30th January 2020

The name "coronavirus" is derived from Latin word meaning "crown" or "wreath"

World Health Organization (WHO) declared **COVID -19 an official name for Co**rona **VI**rus **D**isease.

WHO declared it is a "PANDEMIC DISEASE"

The scientific name for coronavirus is Orthocoronavirinae or Coronavirinae

Coronavirus belongs to the family of Coronavirida

The morphology of coronaviruses is the club - shaped viral spike peplomers, colored red, create the look of a corona surrounding the virion

They are enveloped viruses with a positive - sense single - stranded RNA genome and a nucleocapsid of helical symmetry.

It is a single stranded RNA Virus

The diameter of the virus particles is around 120 nm

The genome size of coronaviruses ranges from approximately 27 to 34 kilobases

The viral envelope consists of a lipid bilayer where the membrane, envelope and spike structural proteins are anchored.

Coronaviruses have a shorter spike-like surface protein called hemagglutinin esterase (HE)





### It Spreads mainly through:

- ✓ Droplets of saliva or discharge from the nose when an infected person coughs or sneezes
- ✓ Close personal contact, such as touching or shaking hands

### To prevent infection and to slow transmission of COVID-19, do the following:

- ✓ Wash your hands regularly with soap and water, or clean them with alcohol-based hand rub.
- ✓ Maintain at least 1 meter distance between you and people coughing or sneezing.
- ✓ Avoid touching your face.
- ✓ Cover your mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing.
- ✓ Stay home if you feel unwell.
- ✓ Refrain from smoking and other activities that weaken the lungs.
- ✓ Practice physical distancing by avoiding unnecessary travel and staying away from large groups of people.

### **NATIONAL**

- 1) The Prime Minister called on citizens to observe a "Janata Curfew" by staying indoors on 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2020 between 7am and 9pm to express their resolve in avoiding public interaction to the bare minimum
- 2) The 6th International Day of Yoga will be held in Leh, capital of Ladakh on 21st June 2020
- 3) **Beary language** is set to be introduced as an optional third language across state schools from the 2020-21 academic years in the state of **Karnataka**
- 4) **Uttarakhand** Chief minister Trivendra Singh Rawat announced in the state assembly that his government will make "Gairsain" the summer capital of Uttarakhand
- 5) The Union Cabinet approved the proposal to set up major port at Vadhvan in Maharashtra
- 6) Internet has been restored in Jammu and Kashmir, but the connectivity will be made available "with **mac binding**".
- 7) **Kishori shakti karyakram:** Campaign started by 14 teenage girls from **Odisha**'s Berhampur *to empower young girls living in slums of the city*.
- 8) The Ministry of AYUSH released digital platform called AYUSH GRID
- 9) Women Transforming India Awards are NITI Aayog's initiative to highlight the commendable and ground-breaking endeavours of India's women leaders and changemakers.
- 10) Women in Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics and Medicine (WISTEMM) program is implemented by the Department of Science and Technology (DST).
- 11) Union Home Minister launched Crime Multi Agency Centre (Cri-MAC) to share information between various police forces on heinous crimes.
- 12) **Restaurant for vultures:** a feeding station for vultures in the Pong Dam Lake Wild Life sanctuary in Kangra district of Himachal Pradesh.
- 13) The Supreme Court has upheld the right of serving Short Service Commission (SSC) women officers of the Navy to be granted permanent commission (PC) on a par with their male counterparts.





- 14) Google announced the launching of *India's next cloud region in Delhi by* 2021.
- The Haryana cabinet has approved the draft bill "The Haryana Scheduled Castes (Reservation in Admission in Educational Institutions) bill, 2020". This bill provides quota within quota for SCs in the state
- 16) IIT Guwahati is setting up a research centre for analysing the coronavirus disease in its campus.
- 17) Odisha Chief Minister launched "Mo Jeeban Programme" to contain the spread of COVID-19 in the state
- 18) **Indian Railways re-introduced special parcel service**, discontinued in 1974, to ensure supply of commodities across India
- 19) Finance Minister instructed the state governments to utilise DMF (District Mineral Foundation) funds to fight against COVID-19.
- 20) The Union government set up "Prime Minister's Citizen Assistance and Relief in Emergency Situations Fund" (PM CARES Fund) seeking contributions from public to combat situations like Covid-19 pandemic
- 21) The Indian Institute of Technology, Gandhinagar (IITGN) has launched **"Project Isaac"** to engage students in creative projects during the COVID-19 lockdown.
- 22) India has decided to conduct antibody tests to confirm whether a person has previously been infected with the COVID 19 virus.
- 23) **Uttar Pradesh Government** banned the manufacture and sale of pan masala from 26<sup>th</sup> March 2020
- 24) The Health ministry has issued the **telemedicine guidelines on 25**<sup>th</sup> **March 2020**
- 25) **The Election Commission** allowed usage of **indelible ink** for stamping persons for home quarantine by the health authorities
- 26) The Election Commission decided to postpone the Rajya Sabha Elections, which were scheduled to be conducted on 26th March 2020.
- 27) The **Telangana legislative assembly** adopted a resolution **against** the Citizenship Amendment Act **(CAA)** National Population Register **(NPR)** and the National Register of Citizens **(NRC)** on **16<sup>th</sup> March 2020**





- 28) The Maharashtra Cabinet approved the proposal to **rename Mumbai**Central Station to Nana Shankarsheth.
- 29) The Rajya Sabha passed two Bills the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (Amendment) Bill, 2020 and the Mineral Laws (Amendment) Bill, 2020 on 12th March 2020.
- 30) The Government is planning to provide a unique disability ID (UDID) to over three lakh persons with disabilities.
- 31) The Gujarat has topped solar roof top plant installations across the country
- 32) Defence Minister of India Rajnath Singh inaugurated the **production** facility of Light Combat Helicopter at the HAL campus in Bengaluru
- 33) The **Maharashtra government** has approved the implementation of the "happy hour" for the *autorickshaws in the state*.
- 34) The Centre government is planning to issue *private driving licences to* those with colour blindness
- 35) The Andhra Pradesh has been ranked 1st for the overall implementation of Poshan Abhiyan, as per a report by NITI Aayog
- 36) The Union government declared the National Chambal Sanctuary in Madhya Pradesh an eco-sensitive zone on 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2020
- 37) Indian Railways started its first railway restaurant "**Restaurant on Wheels**" at Asansol railway station for the usage of its passengers and common people.
- 38) **Realme and Xiaomi** have announced that they are going to launch a new range of smartphones with **ISRO's NavIC**





### INTERNATIONAL

- 1) India is ranked as the world's second-largest arms importer after Saudi Arabia
- 2) The *first case of Hantavirus* was reported in China's Yunnan Province on **23<sup>rd</sup> March 2020**
- 3) World Health Organisation announced the threat of coronavirus can be characterized as a **"Global Pandemic"** as the killer disease has already spread across more than 100 countries
- 4) Bangladesh celebrated 100th birth anniversary of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman on 17th March 2020
- 5) The **Scottish Parliament** passed the Period Products (Free Provision) (Scotland) Bill that aims to make sanitary products free for women of all age groups.
- 6) **Bangladesh and India** share a **4,156-kilometre-long international border**, the fifth-longest land border in the world.
- 7) The Indian government has suspended visas for foreign nationals from all across the globe owing to the novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19) outbreak. The decision will come into effect from 13th March 2020.
- 8) Luxembourg in Europe has become the first country to make all forms of "public transport free"
- 9) China has assumed the Presidency of the United Nations Security Council for March 2020
- 10) Pakistan's Peshawar historic Sunehri Masjid has opened its doors to female worshippers for the first time since 1996







### **ECONOMICS**

- 1) **India's thermal coal imports** rose 12.6 percent to nearly 200 million tonnes in 2019. This is the second straight year of growth in shipments of the fuel.
- 2) The Finance Bill 2020 was passed by Lok Sabha in a record 29 minutes on 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2020 without any discussion or debate.
- 3) The Lok Sabha passed the Appropriation Bill 2020 21 on 16th March 2020
- 4) The Lok Sabha passed the bill to implement the "Direct Tax Vivaad se Vishwas" scheme on 4th March 2020
- 5) The Parliament was adjourned sine die on 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2020 in view of the drastic nationwide measures to encourage social distancing to combat the coronavirus.
- 6) Reliance Industries Limited (RIL) has announced to setting up the India's first dedicated COVID -19 hospital in Mumbai
- 7) The Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI) has announced the launch of 'Swavalamban Express' on 5<sup>th</sup> June 2020, to promote aspiring and budding business entrepreneurs.
- 8) TRIFED, the Tribal Cooperative Marketing Development Federation of India launched "Tech for Tribal" aims at providing entrepreneurship skills to around 3 lakh tribal people
- 9) The **39<sup>th</sup> GST Council meeting**, chaired by the Finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman was held in New Delhi on 14<sup>th</sup> March 2020

- 1) The **32<sup>nd</sup> Olympic Games** will be postponed to **next year (2021)**
- 2) The Manipur government has announced two new schemes (CMAST & CMAT) to provide benefits to the exemplary sportspersons and artistes in the state
