Laws that came during, India Coronavirus Lockdown

Section 188 IPC	Deals with those disobeying an order passed by a public servant, and provides for imprisonment ranging from one to six months. For those violating orders passed under the Epidemic Diseases Act, Section 188 IPC is the provision under which punishment is awarded
Section 505 IPC	Provides for imprisonment of three years or fine, or both, for those who publish or circulate anything which is likely to cause fear or alarm. Section 54 of the Disaster Management Act provides for imprisonment, extending to one year, of those who make or circulate a false alarm or warning regarding a disaster or its severity or magnitude
Section 51 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005	Provides for punishment for two kinds of offences: obstructing any officer or employee of the government or person authorised by any disaster management authority for discharge of a function; and refusing to comply with any direction given by the authorities under the Act. Punishment can extend to one year on conviction, or two years if the refusal leads to loss of lives or any imminent danger.
Section 52, Disaster Management Act	Under Section 52, Disaster Management Act, whoever makes a false claim for obtaining "any relief, assistance, repair, reconstruction or other benefits" from any official authority can be sentenced to a maximum of two years imprisonment and a fine will be imposed on the person.

TAMIL NADU

- 1) **Cauvery Water Management Authority brought under Jal Shakti Ministry** which was earlier under the Ministry of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation.
- 2) **38th District:** On 7th April 2020, **Mayiladuthurai** becomes Tamil Nadu's 38th district after bifurcation of Nagapattinam
- 3) **Arogyam Scheme:** Chief minister Edappadi launched the Arogyam scheme to boost immunity against CORONA infections

KABASURA KUDINEER: The Ministry of AYUSH has approved the "Kabasura Kudineer" and the "Nilavembu Kudineer" to boost the immunity.

- 4) **www.ethottam.com:** Tamil Nadu government has launched the portal for the online shopping of the Fruits and Vegetables. Products will be delivered within 72 hrs.



- 5) **Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease:** The Chief Minister has launched the Mobile X-Ray Van for identified the “Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease”
- 6) **Amma Unavagam: Free of Cost of Foods** has been distributed by the “Amma Unavagam” for the needy people due to COVID-19
- 7) According to the Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana, **Tamil Nadu has been the Topmost state at the all-India level for micro-irrigation**
- 8) **Disaster management data analytics centre:** The centre is expected to **strengthen the state’s disaster management efforts against the outbreak of COVID 19 pandemic**
- 9) **3 New Robots:** The Health Minister has launched the 3 New Robots to help the Corona infected patients in Stanley Hospital, Chennai
- 10) **Pon. Kalaiyarasan Committee:** To Review the **Reservation for Tamil Nadu Government School Students in Medical seats.**
- 11) **Helpline Number 181, 1091, 112:** The Tamil Nadu government has launched the Helpline Numbers for the **Women against the domestic Violence.**

NATIONAL

- 1) **Kerala** has got the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) approval for the clinical protocol exploring the feasibility of **convalescent plasma transfusion which may be administered to severe Covid-19 patients.**
- 2) The National Highway Authority of India **completed the construction of 3,979 km of national highways in the financial year 2019-20** (*Highest in Indian History*)
- 3) **Floor Test is Governor’s Discretion:** The Supreme Court of India has held that a Governor can call for a floor test any time he/she objectively feels a government in power has lost the confidence of the House and is on shaky ground (**Article 163 talks about the discretionary power of the governor**)
- 4) **Covid-19 Affects Odisha’s Art and Festival:** Odisha’s government banned the **Meru Jatra festival** on the occasion of Mahavishub Sankranti (13th



April, 2020), due to Covid-19. **Covid-19 has also affected the sale of Pattachitra paintings.**

- 5) **Mo Prativa:** The **Odisha Government** launched the “Mo Prativa” programme in collaboration with UNICEF for the children to participate in online competitions such as writing slogans, drawings, short story writing, paintings, etc.
- 6) **Krishi Vigyan Kendra:** The **Kerala government** launched the **Door Delivery of fish Scheme**
- 7) The Government of India marked the anniversary of Jallianwala Bagh Massacre on April 13, 2020.
- 8) **A group of Nihangs** attacked a Punjab police party and chopped off the hand of an assistant sub-inspector when stopped for a curfew pass. **Nihang is an order of Sikh warriors.**
- 9) The **Odisha government** has promulgated an ordinance to deal with COVID 19 spread by amending Section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897.
- 10) The Central government appealed in the Supreme Court that media outlets, in the “**larger interest of justice**”, should only publish or telecast anything on Covid-19 after ascertaining the factual position from the government.
- 11) **The Centre Defines J&K Domicile Rules:**

The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has issued the Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation (Adaptation of State Laws) Order, 2020.

On 6th August 2019, the Centre revoked J&K’s special status under Article 370 and Article 35A of the Constitution and bifurcated it into the UTs of J&K and Ladakh.

The two revoked constitutional provisions let the state legislature decide the ‘permanent residents’ prohibiting a non-J&K resident from buying property there and ensuring job reservation for its residents

There are 12 States, including Himachal Pradesh, where provisions of special status under Article 371 apply.

The provisions pertain to regulation of ownership and transfer of land in order to conserve the limited resources available for development and to ensure that the State preserves its unique identity



INTERNATIONAL

- 1) **India and China mark 1st April 2020 as the 70th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations** between them starting from 1950 till now.
- 2) **Japan** declared emergency to combat the Covid-19 pandemic.
- 3) World Health Organization (WHO), **the Democratic Republic of Congo recorded a second Ebola death** in days following more than seven weeks without a new case
- 4) According to the United Nations (UN), due to the Covid-19 pandemic, **measles immunisation campaigns have been delayed in 24 countries and will be cancelled in 13 other countries**
- 5) The World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) has highlighted that **China has become the biggest source of applications for international patents in the world.**
- 6) Global Health 50/50 suggested that the gender-split of Covid-19 cases in all countries is roughly 50-50, barring two exceptions: India and Pakistan.
- 7) Yanomami Tribal boy died in Brazil after contracting Covid-19, raising fears for the Amazon tribes.
- 8) **ANAK KRAKATAU:** It is a volcanic island in the **Sunda Strait between the Java and Sumatra islands in Indonesia.**

ECONOMICS

- 1) **Helicopter Money:**
 - ❖ With the **increasing economic crisis**, Helicopter Money is a solution being suggested by economic specialists all over the world.
 - ❖ Helicopter Money was the term framed by an American Economist Milton Friedman.
 - ❖ Helicopter Money is the monetary policy tool used for Quantitative Easing. It aims to dump money into a struggling economy.



2) **Operation Twist:**

- ❖ RBI to Restart Operation Twist
- ❖ RBI has decided to conduct simultaneous purchase and sale of government securities under Open Market Operations (OMO) for ₹10,000 crore each on April 27, 2020 considering the current and evolving liquidity and market conditions.
- ❖ Such **Open Market Operations are known as 'Operation Twist,'** which was used by the RBI in December, 2019 for the first time.

3) **Why oil prices fell below zero?**

Prices of West Texas Intermediate (WTI) in the US, recently fell to “minus” \$40.32 a barrel.

- ❖ This the lowest crude oil price ever recorded (the previous lowest was immediately after World War - II).
 - ❖ At this price, **the seller of crude oil would be paying the buyer \$40 for each barrel that is bought.**
- 4) The **Rupee slipped 17 paise against the dollar on 15th April 2020**, amid heightened uncertainty over the economy as the Covid-19 pandemic continues to spread.
 - 5) According to the data released by the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, the eight core sector industries **recorded a growth of 5.5% in February, 2020 which is highest in 11-months.**
 - 6) The **Asian Development Bank (ADB)** has assured the Ministry of Finance of **USD 2.2 billion (about Rs 16,500 crore)** support to India in its fight against the Covid-19 pandemic
 - 7) The Government of India (GoI), in consultation with the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), has decided to issue **Sovereign Gold Bonds (SGBs) in six instalments, from April 2020 to September 2020.**
 - 8) **The International Monetary Fund (IMF) approved a \$500 million** grant to cancel six months of debt payments for 25 of the world's most impoverished countries.
 - 9) The World Bank has released the South Asia Economic Focus report. The report saw **India's growth at 1.5 - 2.8% in 2020-21** which is the slowest since 1991 economic reforms.



10) **Impact of Economic Slowdown Due to Covid-19:**

Amid the ongoing economic slowdown due to Covid-19 pandemic, the government is facing several challenges like:

- ❖ Fall in tax collections.
- ❖ Foreign investors sold over ₹1 lakh-crore securities in a month (March), for the first time in history.
- ❖ Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has decided to shorten trading hours for foreign exchange and money markets products.
