

NATIONAL

- 1) India- China violent face-off in Galwan Valley, Ladakh: A violent face-off reportedly took place between Indian and Chinese troops at Galwan Valley in Ladakh on the night of June 15 during de-escalation process. Many of the Indian Soldiers are martyred.
- 2) Double stack container Train: Indian Railways has commissioned the first high rise Over Head Equipment (OHE) and successfully ran a double stack containers in electrified territory on Western Railway (1st Double Stack Container train).
- 3) **Assam Gas Leak:** A gas leak has occurred at Baghjan well in Tinsukia district of Assam
- 4) **Kerala:** 1st state to **provide free internet for the poor.** The state govt of Kerala has declared that their ambitious broadband project: Kerala Fibre Optic Network (K-FON) project.
- 5) **Andhra Pradesh Government:** India's first Online Waste Exchange launched
- 6) Odisha cabinet gives state anthem status to "Bande Utkala Janani"
- 7) One India, One Agriculture Market: The Union Cabinet clears ordinance to create the ecosystem where farmers and traders will have the freedom of choice of sale and purchase of the agricultural produce.
- 8) **Uttar Pradesh** has become the **top state in India** to provide employment to the workers under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme **(MGNREGA).**
- 9) **Green Field Expressway Project:** The Government of India agreed to convert the **Delhi-Amristar-Katra Expressway** into a green field project. The highway will **connect five historic towns** in the states. They include Goindwal Sahib, Sultanpur Lodhi, Khadoor Sahib and Tarn Taran.
- 10) **Chhattisgarh Police** have launched **a special campaign "Spandan".** To check mental stress and depression among their personnel by conducting interactive programmes and arranging counselling sessions, music and yoga therapies for them





- 11) Kerala government has approved the proposed Athirapally Hydro Electric Project (AHEP) on the Chalakudy River in Thrissur district. The project will have an installed capacity of 163 MW.
- 12) **The Bharatmala Pariyojana** that was scheduled to be completed in 2021-22 is **to be completed by 2025-26.**
- 13) The Jal Jeevan Mission envisages providing piped drinking water to all rural households by 2024.
- 14) The Supreme Court of India has said that reservation of seats provided to certain communities is not a fundamental right.
- 15) Prevalence of diabetes among women high in southern India:
 - ❖ The number of people with diabetes in India increased from 26 million in 1990 to 65 million in 2016. The prevalence of diabetes in adults aged 20 years or older in India increased from 5.5% in 1990 to 7.7% in 2016.
 - ❖ The prevalence in 2016 was highest in Tamil Nadu and Kerala, according to the Global Burden of Disease Study, 2018
- 16) Gairsain declared Summer Capital of Uttarakhand
- 17) Jaya Jaitly Task Force Constituted: The Government of India has constituted Jaya Jaitly Task Force that will work on the issues of women and child development.
- 18) A Video Blogging Contest titled "My Life My Yoga" (also called "Jeevan Yoga") has been launched by the Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi.
- 19) Different Colour bands for BS VI vehicles:
 - ❖ The order makes it mandatory for the BS VI vehicles to carry a green strip of 1 cm width on the top of the existing sticker.
 - ❖ The sticker should carry details of registration of BS-VI vehicle and its fuel type.
 - ❖ The petrol fuel vehicles should hold orange colour and diesel fuel vehicles should carry a blue colour.

- 21) PM Narendra Modi reiterated on the need to manufacture products that are 'Made in India' but are 'Made for the World'.






