1) Beed Model of Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana:

- 2) Kerala Knowledge Mission: Kerala government has announced the launch of 'Kerala Knowledge Mission' to provide employment to the educated 'knowledge workers'
- 3) **NATRAX the High Speed Track:** The Minister of Heavy Industries and Public Enterprises inaugurated NATRAX - the High Speed Track in Pithampur, Indore (Madhya Pradesh)
- 4) Odisha government has planned to grow the mangrove forests along its coast
- 5) Goa has become the *first state in the country to be free of Rabies*
- Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen) Phase II is making steady progress amidst Covid-19 with 1249 villages declared ODF Plus (Open Defecation Free)
- 7) Weyan village in Bandipora district in Jammu and Kashmir had become the first village in the country to vaccinate all its adult population against Covid-19.
- 8) Gujarat Chief Minister launched the Agricultural Diversification Scheme-2021
- 9) The Union government has announced a special **"PM-CARES** for Children" scheme for all those orphaned due to Covid-19.
- 10) The Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare has launched the **Horticulture Cluster Development Programme (CDP)** in order to promote the export of horticultural produce.
