

- 3) International Labour Organization (ILO) has released its report "Working on a Warmer Planet" The Impact of Heat Stress on Labour Productivity and Decent Work".
- 4) The ancient **Mesopotamian city of Babylon** has been declared a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**.
- 5) **France** has decided to impose a green tax on plane tickets from **2020**
- 6) The French parliament approved **Gafa Tax** an acronym for Google, Apple, Facebook and Amazon the legislation will impose a 3% levy on sales generated in the count.
- 7) Italy's **Prosecco hills of Conegliano and Valdobbiadene** has been named as the UNESCO World Heritage at the 43rd Session of the UNESCO World Heritage Committee in Baku, Azerbaijan.


