1) Prime Minister's Ladakh Visit:

- ❖ For reviewing the security situations amid continues claims of China for sovereignty over India's territory at the Galwan Valley.

2) New Education Policy 2020:

- ❖ Ministry of Human Resource Development to be renamed Minister of Education.
- ❖ The NEP proposes changing the existing 10+2 Curricular and Pedagogical Structure with 5+3+3+4 design covering the children in the age group 3-18 years. Phil degree will be abolished.

3) Gas leak in Vizag pharma plant:

- ❖ A gas leak at Sainor Life Sciences Pvt Ltd, Jawaharlal Nehru Pharma City, in Visakhapatnam has claimed two lives and injured four people.
- **❖ Hydrogen sulphide vapours** leaked from the reactor of a pharmaceutical company's plant.
- 4) **As per the Tigers Report 2018,** an increasing rate of 6% per annum of Tiger population in India from the year 2006 to 2018 was observed





- 5) PM Modi inaugurates Asia's largest solar energy 750 MW project in Madhya Pradesh's Rewa district.
- 6) The Ministry of Human Resource and Development has been renamed as Ministry of Education.
- 7) The Government of India unveiled three schemes with an outlay of about Rs. 48,000 crore to promote electronics manufacturing in India. These schemes are:
 - ❖ Production Linked Incentive (PLI) Scheme
 - ❖ Scheme for Promotion of Manufacturing of Electronic Components and Semiconductors (SPECS)
 - ❖ Modified Electronics Manufacturing Clusters (EMC 2.0) Scheme
- 8) India's First State-Level 'E-Lok Adalat' conducted by Chhattisgarh High Court
- 9) Siddi Community has got its first representative in Karnataka State Legislative
- 10) 3 day India Global Week 2020:
 - ❖ Inaugurated by the Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi on 9th July 2020.
 - **❖ THEME:** "Be The Revival: India and a Better New World"
- 11) The Railways Minister Piyush Goyal has announced, India's first cable-stayed Railways Bridge "Anji Khad Bridge" to connect Katra and Reasi in Jammu and Kashmir (J&K).
- 12) World's Largest Camera Trapping Wildlife Survey:
 - ❖ Fourth Cycle of All India Tiger Estimation 2018 enters Guinness Book of World Records.
 - ❖ The fourth cycle of the All India Tiger Estimation 2018 counted 2,967 tigers, which is about 75% of the global tiger population.
- 13) Free food grain scheme till November: The Prime Minister has announced that the free grain distribution scheme under the **Pradhan Mantri Garib**Kalyan Anna Yojana (PMGKAY) will be extended by five months till the end of November 2020





- 14) **Privatisation of Railways:** The Ministry of Railways has taken the first step towards privatisation of railways by inviting Request for Qualifications (RFQ) to private players for operation of passenger train services.
- **5 Rafale multi-role combat jets:** Fleet of 5 Rafale multi-role combat jets arrived in Ambala Air Force base, Haryana. Would be inducted into the IAF as part of its Ambala-based No 17 Squadron, also known as the 'Golden Arrows'.
- 16) Indian Railways will be the largest Railway in world to have 100 per cent electrification by 2030 replacing diesel.
- 17) The Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology celebrates **5 years of Digital India**. It was launched on 1st July 2015.
- 18) 1.7 Megawatt solar power plant at Madhya Pradesh: Indian Railway in collaboration with Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (BHEL) has set up a 1.7 Megawatt solar power plant at Bina, Madhya Pradesh.
- 19) Gujarat government has decided to form a five-member commission to identify members of Rabari, Bharvad and Charan communities, who are eligible for benefits of Schedule Tribe (ST) status.
- 20) **Karnataka** Forest Department has decided to put in place a traffic monitoring mechanism along the roads adjacent to Nagarahole National Park.
- 21) **Himachal Pradesh** Plans to Provide 100 % Functional Household Tap Connection (FHTC) to all Rural Households by August 2022
- 22) Himachal Pradesh becomes First State in India to have LPG Gas Connection in Every Household
- 23) Nagaland declared as disturbed area till December 2020
- 24) India's first trans-shipment hub in Cochin port, Kerala
- 25) Assam government has decided to Give Preference to Plasma Donors in Government Jobs.
- Odisha has decided to introduce locally produced millets for the first time into Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) Scheme and Public Distribution System (PDS).







- 27) Largest Solar Power Plant at Indian Naval Academy, Ezhimala, Kerala has been commissioned by the Vice Admiral Anil Kumar Chawla. It is a 3 MW Solar Power Plant
- 28) Kakrapar Atomic Power Plant, Unit-3 (KAPP-3), Gujarat has attained criticality at around 09:36 Hrs on 22 July 2020. It is India's first 700 MWe (megawatt electric) Pressurized Heavy Water Reactor (PHWR) with innovative features.
- 29) According to Kaziranga National Park authorities around **80% of its area** has been inundated due to floods.
- 30) Intzaar Aap Ka: To attract tourists in the state, the Madhya Pradesh Tourism Board has started a social media campaign.
- 31) Assam Government has decided for the upgradation of the status of the Dehing Patkai Wildlife Sanctuary to National Park.
- 32) Uttarakhand government has decided to convert waste generated in the state to electricity under an initiative titled 'Waste to Energy'.
- 33) The Union Cabinet approves extension of **Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Yojana till November 2020**
- 34) **The Uttar Pradesh 'Startup Policy'** was prepared by the State Government with the help of NITI Aayog back in 2018. The Policy got the approval of the State Cabinet on 8th July 2020.
- Odisha becomes First State in India to Use Space Technology & Artificial Intelligence for Safeguarding Government Lands.
- 36) **Nadaun Police Station in Himachal Pradesh** has been ranked as one of the best Police Stations of the country
- 37) A passenger bus service was started for the first time after India's Independence in Swabhiman Anchal region (formerly known as the cut-off area) in Odisha's Malkangiri district.
- 38) The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) has approved the Zonal Master Plan for the Bhagirathi Eco-Sensitive Zone to pave the way for faster execution of Char Dham Road Project
- 39) Maharashtra has become the first State in the country to get the goahead to use drones for aerial surveillance and inspection of extra high voltage power transmission lines and towers





- 40) Union Food Processing Minister, Harsimrat Kaur Badal has inaugurated the "Zoram Mega Food Park" in Mizoram.

- ❖ Iran has issued an arrest warrant for US President Donald Trump over the killing of top Iranian general in January, Qasem Soleimani.
- ❖ Iran has asked Interpol to issue a "red notice" for Trump and the other individuals involved in the killing of Soleimani.
- 2) Russia has conducted a successful flight test of an MGTD-20 gas turbine 3D-printed aircraft engine. The flight tests were held at Kazanbash aviation centre in Tatarstan. I
- 3) United States submits notice to U.N Secretary-General to withdraw from WHO by 6th July 2021
- 4) Pakistan and China have signed an agreement for the 700 MW Azad Pattan hydel power project on the Jhelum River in Sudhnoti district of Pakistan occupied Kashmir (PoK).





- 5) Earthquake of 7.8 magnitude hits Alaska; Tsunami Warnings issued
- 6) Maldives & Sri Lanka eliminate measles & rubella, ahead of 2023 target
- 7) India and Bhutan opened a new trade route between Jaigon in West Bengal and Pasakha in Bhutan
- 8) First trial container ship flagged off from Kolkata to Agartala through Chattogram Port of Bangladesh
- 9) A herdsman in China's northern Inner Mongolia region has been confirmed to have the bubonic plague.

 - According to the bill, Indians should not exceed 15% of the population and if it is enacted into law, over 8 lakh Indians could be forced out of Kuwait.

- 19) New Bhutanese Territory Claimed by China: China has made new territorial claims in the eastern sector of Bhutan's Trashigang district.
- 20) North America Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) 2.0: A new free trade agreement between the United States, Mexico, and Canada comes into effect from 1st July 2020 onwards.

- 4) **HDFC Bank** offers **instant car loans** to existing customers through an initiative called **"ZipDrive"**
- 5) The Central government has clarified that it has no proposal to merge the Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT) and Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC).
- 6) **RBI** cut **repo rate by 250 basis points** till onset of COVID-19







- 7) Finance Minister Nirmala Sitaraman participated in third **G20 Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors meet.** The meet was presided by Saudi Arabia.
- 8) Jammu and Kashmir administration announced life insurance cover of Rs 25 lakhs to all elected members of urban local bodies and panchayati raj institutions.
- 9) **Punjab National Bank** has launched a nation-wide campaign to distribute face masks and sanitizers to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
- 10) The Consumer Protection Act, 2019 has been implemented in India since 20th July 2020. It has replaced Consumer Protection Act, 1986.
- 11) **India's first Neobank for teenagers,** FamPay has launched India's first numberless card, "FamCard".
