## **NATIONAL**

- The Ministry of Human Resource Development has been renamed as the Ministry of Education. In 1985, the Ministry of Education was renamed as the HRD ministry when Rajiv Gandhi was prime minister. P V Narasimha Rao was appointed the first HRD minister by PM Rajiv Gandhi.
- 2) Indian Railways is constructing the world's tallest pier bridge (114m) in Manipur across river Ijai near Noney
- 3) HINDU WOMEN'S INHERITANCE RIGHTS: The Supreme Court has expanded a Hindu woman's right to be a joint legal heir and inherit ancestral property on terms equal to male heirs.
- 4) **Female Pedestrians on Traffic Signals:** *Mumbai's* Dadar becomes the first city to have female icons on traffic signals
- 5) **Project Dolphin and Project Lion:** PM Modi announced that on the lines of the successful conservation programme Project Tiger and Project Elephant, India will now have two more similar missions, **Project Dolphin and Project Lion, to protect these species in their natural habitat in a holistic manner.**

### 6) **Project Cheetah:**

- The Indian Armed Forces have decided to revive "Project Cheetah" amidst tensions with China.
- Project Cheetah is to upgrade the drones to carry out offensive operations against the enemy. Under this project, 90 Heron drones of the three services would be upgraded to be armed with laser-guided bombs, air to ground and air-launched anti-tank guided missiles.
- 7) Demand for 6<sup>th</sup> Schedule Status: Arunachal Pradesh
  - The recent revival of the demand for two autonomous councils in Arunachal Pradesh has led to the call for bringing the entire Arunachal Pradesh under the ambit of the 6<sup>th</sup> Schedule or Article 371 (A) of the Constitution.
- 8) Minimum Age of Marriage for Girls: The Prime Minister, during his address to the nation on the 74<sup>th</sup> Independence Day, announced that the central government has set up a committee to reconsider the minimum age of marriage for women, which is currently 18.

## 9) A massive landslide crushed a settlement of 83 tea estate workers in Munnar in Idukki, Kerala.

10) Tabletop Airport: On 7 August 2020, a Boeing 737 aircraft of Air India Express (the low cost subsidiary of national carrier Air India) overshot the runway while landing at Calicut International Airport. The crash killed 18 people and over 100 were injured. The accident has once again turned the spotlight on operations to what are called 'tabletop airports' in India.

### 11) SUBMARINE OPTICAL FIBRE CABLE (OFC):

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated and dedicate to the Nation the submarine Optical Fibre Cable (OFC) of nearly 2300 KM length connecting Chennai and Port Blair on 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2020.
- The submarine cable will also connect Port Blair to Swaraj Dweep (Havelock), Little Andaman, Car Nicobar, Kamorta, Great Nicobar, Long Island, and Rangat.
- The submarine OFC link will deliver bandwidth of 2 x 200 Gigabits per second (Gbps) between Chennai and Port Blair, and 2 x 100 Gbps between Port Blair and the other islands.
- 12) **PM Modi announced the Optic Fibre Linking of Lakshadweep Islands with the mainland during** his address at the 74<sup>th</sup> celebrations of Independence Day.

### 13) National Council for Transgender Persons constituted:

- The Council has been formed under Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Act, 2019.
- > The Council is to be headed by the Union Social Justice Minister.
- > The Council will also have joint secretary level members from ministries of health, minority affairs, education, labour, rural development.
- Apart from the ministries, the council will also have members from Human Rights Commissions, NITI Aayog and National Commission for women.
- 14) One Sun, One World, One Grid (OSOWOG) Plan: Prime Minister Narendra Modi has announced the plan there will be a trans-national electricity grid, for supplying solar power across the globe.
- 15) Kerala Goverment commissioned 1st Marine Ambulance 'PRATHEEKSHA'
- 16) Fit India Youth Club: A part of the Fit India Movement envisioned by Prime Minister, endeavours to harness the power of youth to create mass awareness about the importance of fitness, across the country.





- 17) Kisan Rail: The country's first Kisan Special Parcel Train or Kisan Rail will start from August 7, 2020 to provide seamless supply of perishable produce. The train will transport material between Maharashtra's Devlali and Bihar's Danapur Railway station. It will be covering a distance of 1,519 kilometres in around 32 hours.
- 18) Andhra Pradesh on the eve of Raksha Bandhan launched 'E-Raksha Bandhan', an online training programme on cybersecurity. The programme is aimed at creating awareness among the public on cybercrimes across the State.

## 19) The Union Home Ministry notified new rules for administration in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir (J&K):

- \* Functions of the L-G: Police, Public order, All India Services and anti-corruptions
- Functions of the Council of Ministers led by CM: Service matters of non-All India Services officers, proposal to impose new tax, land revenue, sale grant or lease of government property, reconstituting departments or offices and draft legislation.

### 20) NATIONAL DIGITAL HEALTH MISSION (NDHM):

- The National Digital Health Mission (NDHM), which was unveiled by PM Modi in his Independence Day address, has now been rolled out on a pilot mode in six Union territories (Chandigarh, Ladakh, Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu, Puducherry, Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep.)
- > The vision of National Digital Health Mission is to create a national digital health ecosystem which provides timely and efficient access to inclusive, affordable, and safe healthcare to all citizens.
- 21) **24 States under One Nation-One Ration Card:** *Manipur, Nagaland and Uttarakhand, along with the Union Territory (UT) of Jammu and Kashmir* have been integrated with the One Nation-One Ration Card (ONORC) Scheme.
- 22) **IIM Sirmaur: In Himachal Pradesh**, Union Education Minister, Ramesh Pokhriyal Nishank has laid the foundation stone of Indian Institute of Management (IIM) at Dhaula Kuan in Sirmour district.
- 23) Union Education Minister has informed that indigenous toy-making will be introduced as a theme in **Kala Utsav to encourage students to explore and develop a variety of local toys**. He also called for initiating puppet show in Kala Utsav for secondary and higher secondary students.
- 24) **IIT-Indore** has introduced a one-of-its-kind course **to teach classical sciesntific texts to students in Sanskrit**, starting with Bhaskaracharya's mathematical treatise 'Lilavati' of almost a thousand years ago.

- 25) **India's first International Women Trade Centre** to be set up in **Kerala** in terms of the United Nations Sustainable Development goals.
- 26) **Delhi Government** has launched the Fitness Campaign **"Healthy Body, Healthy Mind" fitness campaign** for the students
- 27) The Prime Minister's Office held a meeting with representatives of the Election Commission and the Law Ministry to discuss the possibility of having a common electoral roll for elections to the panchayat, municipality, state assembly and the Lok Sabha.
- 28) Minister of Development of North Eastern Region (DoNER) Jitendra Singh has said that **three Bamboo Clusters will be developed in Jammu, Katra and Samba** areas for making of Bamboo basketry, Agarbatti and Bamboo Charcol.
- 29) The Union Minister for Electronics and Information Technology has launched "Chunauti"- Next Generation Startup Challenge Contest to further boost startups and software products with special focus on Tier-II towns of the country.
- With the ambitious plan of achieving 100% electrification for Railways by the year 2023, Indian Railways energy consumption is set to become more than 33 billion units by 2030 from its current annual requirement of about 21 billion units.
- 31) The Bureau of Police Research and Development is celebrating its Golden Jubilee Anniversary on 28th August, 2020.
- 32) UDAN 4.0: The 4<sup>th</sup> round of UDAN was launched in December 2019 with a special focus on North-Eastern Regions, Hilly States, and Islands. Under UDAN 4, the operation of helicopter and seaplanes is also been incorporated.
- 33) The National Health Authority (NHA) has released the Draft Health Data Management Policy of the National Digital Health Mission (NDHM) in the public domain.
- 34) The **Assam** government has inaugurated a **1.8-km ropeway across the Brahmaputra River (Guwahati)**, and described it as India's longest river ropeway.





- 35) Nine people were killed after a massive fire swept through the **Srisailam** hydroelectric plant, Andhra Pradesh (2<sup>nd</sup> largest capacity working hydroelectric station in the country)
- 36) The Union Cabinet has approved the proposal for leasing out three airports namely Jaipur, Guwahati and Thiruvananthapuram airports of Airports Authority of India (AAI) through Public Private Partnership (PPP).
- 37) Digha Gopalpur coastal highway is under construction in Odisha and West Bengal.
- 38) Prime Minister Narendra Modi shall inaugurate Rashtriya Swachhata Kendra, an interactive experience centre on the Swachh Bharat Mission, on 8<sup>th</sup> August 2020.
- 39) 'Roll On Roll Off' (RORO) Train: Karnataka CM B S Yediyurappa flagged off first RORO train from Bengaluru to Solapur in Maharashtra.
- 40) **Vyapar Mala Express Train:** Northern Railway runs first-ever Vyapar Mala Express train. **It will help small traders in moving their cargo through Railways,** in a short time, cost effective, convenient and environment-friendly mode of transportation.
- 41) The southern bench of the **National Green Tribunal (NGT)** has granted an interim stay on **felling of coconut trees on Agatti Island in Lakshadweep**.
- 42) The Ministry of Defence has formulated a draft Defence Production and Export Promotion Policy 2020 (DPEPP 2020).
- 43) Maritime and startup hub: The Prime Minister Narendra Modi has declared that the Andaman and Nicobar islands will be developed as a "maritime and startup hub"
- 44) **The Kerala State government** is carrying out a unique programme called "Namath Basai" of teaching tribal children in their mother tongue.





## **INTERNATIONAL**

- 1) Apple surpasses Saudi Aramco to become world's most valuable company
- 2) Lebanon trembles with devastating blast:
  - **In Beirut, the capital of Lebanon** a huge blast triggered off in a port warehouse where highly explosive material was stored.
  - **Ammonium nitrate** has involved in the explosion.
- 3) **Barakah Nuclear Plant: The United Arab Emirates** became the first Arab country to open a nuclear power plant, when the Unit 1 of the Barakah Nuclear Plant in Abu Dhabi, got operational on 31 July 2020.
- 4) **Senkaku-Diaoyu Islands Dispute:** Japan and China claim the uninhabited islands, known as the Senkaku in Japan and Tiaoyu in China
- 5) Mali President Ibrahim Boubacar Keita has announced his resignation amid a military coup. The development comes after more than two months of regular demonstrations calling for him to step down three years before his final term was due to end.
- 6) Mauritius declared a national emergency over an oil spill near its coast.
- 7) Pakistan's New Map:
  - Pakistan has released a new political map that includes all of Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Sir Creek and Junagadh.
  - The map has been released on the eve of the first anniversary of the abrogation of special status to Jammu and Kashmir under Article 370.
- 8) US President Donald Trump announced that the United Arab Emirates (UAE) and Israel have agreed to establish full diplomatic relations as part of a new peace deal.
- 9) **Pratihara Style of architecture:** A rare late **ninth century stone statue of Lord Shiva, which was stolen from a temple in Rajasthan** and smuggled to the UK, will be returned to the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI).
- 10) **Bangladesh's Power plant: Reliance Power and Japanese energy major JERA** have signed an agreement with a group of banks for their new gasfired thermal power generation project in Bangladesh.





- 11) Foreign Minister of Nepal has said that the 1947 agreement among India, Nepal and the United Kingdom that deals with the military service of Gurkha soldiers has become redundant.
- 12) World Health Organization has declared **Africa free of polio**, a landmark in a decades-long campaign to eradicate the notorious disease around the world.
- 13) Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan ordered another ancient Orthodox church that became a mosque and then a popular **KARIYE Istanbul museum to be turned back into a place of Muslim worship.**
- 14) Clean Plates Campaign: Chinese President Xi Jinping called on his country's citizens to drastically cut down on food waste in a new initiative called the 'Clean Plates Campaign'.
- 15) Sri Lankan government has granted approval to abolish the 19<sup>th</sup> amendment to the constitution and replace it with the 20<sup>th</sup> amendment.
- 16) **The Mount Sinabung of Indonesia has erupted again.** The volcano was dormant for 400 years and erupted recently in the year 2010 and in 2014.
- 17) **The Turkish President reconverted the Chora museum into a mosque**. This is the second museum after Hagia Sophia to be converted into a mosque.
