- 2) Jal Jeevan Mission: The Prime Minister Narendra Modi released the new logo for the Jal Jeevan Mission. He also unveiled the 'Margadarshika for Gram Panchayats and Paani Samitis under Jal Jeevan Mission' (Guidelines for the Village Panchayats and Water Committees)
- 3) Mission Karmayogi: The Union Cabinet has approved launching of "Mission Karmayogi"- National Programme for Civil Services Capacity Building (NPCSCB).
- 4) India's first toy manufacturing cluster to come up at Koppal, Karnataka
- 5) Karnataka Chief Minister launched the India's 1st Integrated Air Ambulance Services at Jakkur Aerodrome, Bangalore.
- 6) India's 1st Coast Guard academy to come up at Mangaluru, Karnataka.
- 7) Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated 6 mega development projects in Uttarakhand under the Namami Gange Mission.

- 38) The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has provided Y-plus category of CRPF security to an actress.
- 39) The Ministry of Chemicals & Fertilizers has approved setting up of 10 Plastic Parks in the country. The Plastic Parks are being set up in the states of Assam, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Jharkhand, Uttarakhand and Chhattisgarh.

INTERNATIONAL

- 1) The government of Bangladesh has announced national mourning to honour the memory of the former President of India Pranab Mukherjee who passed away.
- 2) In Somalia, a cargo plane crashed at Aden Adde International Airport in capital Mogadishu.
- 3) India and Japan signed a logistics agreement that will allow armed forces of both sides to coordinate closely in services and supplies. The agreement is known as Acquisition and Cross-Servicing Agreement (ACSA).
- 4) Sonamura-Daudkandi inland waterway route between India and Bangladesh was operationalised. Daudkandi is in Bangladesh, while Sonamura is in Tripura, India.
- 5) **Pakistan** has decided to **elevate Gilgit-Baltistan's status** to that of a full-fledged province.





- 6) The **Indus Water Treaty** (IWT) between **India and Pakistan** marks its 60th anniversary on 19th September 2020.
- 7) The territorial dispute between Armenia and Azerbaijan over the Nagorno-Karabakh region has re-erupted with heavy clashes.

ECONOMICS

- 1) CHIEF COMPLIANCE OFFICER (CCO): Reserve Bank of India has issued guidelines for appointment of Chief Compliance Officer (CCO) in banks to ensure uniform approach with regard to compliance and risk management culture across the banking industry.
- 2) Titan and SBI launched Titan Pay, India's 1st Contactless Payment Watches
- 3) The **Reserve Bank of India** has roped Amitabh Bachchan **for the customer awareness campaign** to prevent gullible account holders from being duped by fraudsters.
- 4) **GDP Contracted by 23.9% in First Quarter:** National Statistical Office (NSO) data, **India's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) growth contracted by 23.9%** in the first (April-June) quarter of 2020 compared to the April-June in 2019.
- 5) The Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation has released the report of a survey titled **'Health in India'**, whose main objective was to gather basic quantitative information on India's health sector.
- Union Health Minister Harsh Vardhan said that government is committed to increase the public healthcare spending from the existing 1.15 % of the GDP to 2.5 % by 2025.
- 7) **EASE Banking Reforms Index:** *Bank of Baroda*, State Bank of India, and erstwhile Oriental Bank of Commerce were felicitated for being the top three in the 'Top Performing Banks' category according to the EASE 2.0 Index Results.
