COVID - 19 NEWS

In the coronavirus, SARS-CoV-2 is an enzyme called the main protease , which drives its replication once it infects the human cell. For the first time, scientists have completed a 3D map that reveals the location of every atom in the molecule of this enzyme.
Biological E, in collaboration with the Indian Council of Medical Research, has developed highly purified antisera that can be used in prevention and treatment of COVID-19.
Swedish-British drug giant AstraZeneca said it was moving an antibody combination developed for Covid-19 treatment into latestage human trials.
Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) has launched two-layered "Happy Diwali" printed face masks made of pure Muslin fabric, a high quality and ultra-fine cotton fabric handmade by traditional Khadi artisans of West Bengal.
A six year old Bangladeshi boy Anzar Mustaeen Ali won a special prize of USD 1000 for his artwork in the global art competition organised by the Indian Council of Cultural Relations (ICCR).
Indian Council of Medical Research has approved a new low-cost Covid-19 diagnostic method named COVIRAP , developed by the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Kharagpur.
A recent study suggests that the drug tocilizumab may not prevent mortality in Covid-19 patients.
The International AIDS Vaccine Initiative (IAVI) and Serum Institute of India (SII), Pune announced an agreement with Merck, a science and technology company, to develop SARS-CoV-2 neutralising monoclonal antibodies (mAbs), which will be used to address the Covid-19 pandemic.
Energy and Climate Intelligence Unit (ECIU) said that the some areas in the UK could experience greater levels of air pollution due to large numbers of people working from home due to the pandemic this winter season.

- 1) Union Health Minister said that the aim of the government is to make India **Trans Fat free by 2022**, a year ahead of target set by World Health Organization
- 2) Meri Saheli: Indian Railways has launched "Meri Saheli" initiative to provide safety and security to lady passengers travelling by trains for their entire journey from starting station to destination station.
- 3) Child Care Leave: The Union Minister of Personnel, Public Grievances, Pensions said that the male employees of the government are also now entitled to Child Care Leave.
- 4) The Gujarat High Court has become the first Court to live stream judicial proceedings on YouTube channel.
- 5) Punjab became the first State in the country to formally reject the Central government's three Farm Acts by passing three Bills to negate the Union laws.
- 6) Uttar Pradesh government has secured the first rank in central government's the PM Atmanirbhar Nidhi Scheme (SVANidhi Scheme) by approving the highest number of loans under the scheme in the country.
- 7) The Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched the world's longest temple ropeway project at Girnar in Junagadh, Gujarat
- 8) The Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment has launched the 'Ambedkar Social Innovation and Incubation Mission (ASIIM)' under Venture Capital Fund for Scheduled Castes (SCs) with a view to promoting innovation and enterprise among SC students studying in higher educational institutions.
- 9) The Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated various projects under Integrated Development of Kevadia in Gujarat. He inaugurated Arogya Van and Arogya Kutir. He also inaugurated the Ekta Mall, and Children Nutrition Park.
- 10) The Prime Minister Narendra Modi flagged-off of the **"Ekta Cruise Service to the Statue of Unity"**
- 11) The Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated Sardar Patel Zoological Park and Geodesic Aviary Dome in Kevadia, Gujarat.







- 12) India's 1st Seaplane Project: The seaplane services in Gujarat, connecting Sabarmati River in Ahmedabad to the Statue of Unity in Kevadia in Narmada district, inaugurated on October 31, the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel.
- 13) The Prime Minister Narendra Modi dedicated to the nation the World's longest Highway tunnel "Atal Tunnel"
- 14) Chemicals and Fertilizers Ministry has revised the Production Linked Incentive Schemes for promoting domestic manufacturing of bulk drugs and medical devices.
- 15) India's 1st ever multi-modal logistic park to be set up in Assam
- 16) Goa has become the 1st Har Ghar Jal State in the country by providing tap water connection to every rural household.
- 17) **Indian Oil** has started a common number **(7718955555)** 24x7 for the customers for **Indane LPG refill booking** across the country for customer convenience.
- 18) The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, CCEA approved **Mechanism** for procurement of ethanol by Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies under Ethanol Blended Petrol Programme.
- 19) The Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced the construction of 66 MW Dhaulasidh Hydro Project at Hamirpur, Himachal Pradesh.
- Amendment Related to Land in Jammu and Kashmir: The Centre notified that the 'Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation (Adaptation of Central Laws) Third Order, 2020', which states that any Indian citizen can now buy land in Jammu and Kashmir (J&K) without being a domicile.
- 21) **National Productivity Council (NPC)** has been granted accreditation conforming to ISO 17020:2012 by National Accreditation Board for Certification Body (NABCB), Quality Council of India (QCI) for undertaking inspection and audit work in the area of Food Safety Audit and Scientific Storage of Agricultural Products.
- 22) The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs has approved **the Dam Rehabilitation and Improvement Project (DRIP)** Phase II & Phase III with the financial assistance of the World Bank (WB) and Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB).

- 26) CSIR and KPIT successfully ran trials of **India's first Hydrogen Fuel Cell** (**HFC**) **prototype car** running on an indigenously developed fuel cell stack at CSIR-National Chemical Laboratory, Pune.
- 27) Union Minister for Science & Technology inaugurated the "**DBT-BIRAC** Clean **Tech Demo Park**" at Barapullah drain site in Sarai Kale Khan, New Delhi.
- 28) The National Institute of Oceanography will carry out the **translocation of 18 coral colonies from the coast of Mumbai** for the Mumbai Coastal Road Project.
- 29) The central government has extended the **Employees' State Insurance** (ESI) Scheme to Arunachal Pradesh, with effect from 1st November, 2020.
- 30) The National Green Tribunal (NGT) has declared that the environmental clearance (EC) granted to the Kaleshwaram Lift Irrigation Project in Telangana.
- 31) The **Rajasthan government** has decided to **build temporary shelters for migratory birds** near the Sambhar Lake (near Jaipur) before 2020's winter season.

- 1) Japan to Achieve Zero Carbon Emissions By 2050
- 2) India and the United States signed the Basic Exchange and Cooperation Agreement (BECA).
- 3) **Sudan** became the third Arab nation in recently to normalise relations with Israel, days after the US removed it from its State Sponsor of Terrorism list.
- 4) Chinese foreign ministry said that the not to recognize Hong Kong BNO passports as valid travel documents.
- 5) The Russian President has proposed extending by one year the New START (Strategic Arms Reduction Treaty) between the USA and Russia expiring in February 2021.
- The **Financial Action Task Force (FATF)** decided to keep **Pakistan on its** "**grey list**", saying that the country has failed to act on six key mandates. The FATF urged Pakistan to complete an internationally agreed action plan by February 2021.
- 7) Indian Ministry of Earth Sciences dedicated **Flash Flood Guidance services**, first of its kind for South Asian countries namely India, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Nepal and Sri Lanka.
- 8) **Australia has agreed to join the Malabar Exercise** on India's request. The exercise is scheduled to be held in November 2020.
- 9) Bahrain and Israel are signing a joint communique on the establishment of diplomatic, peaceful and friendly relations
