AGRICULTURE BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS – 2023

DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS' WELFARE

- 1. Kalaignarin All Village Integrated Agricultural Development Programme
 - a. Convergence with the "Anaithu Grama Anna Marumalarchi Thittam"
 - b. Implemented in 2,504 village panchayats

2. Tamil Nadu Millet Mission:

- a. International Year of Millets 2023
- b. Implemented for a period of five year.
- c. Two millet zones encompassing 20 districts were declared in the last Agriculture

Budget. Five new districts were added namely

- a. Namakkal,
- b. Tirupur,
- c. Coimbatore
- d. Erode and
- e. Pudukottai
- d. Distribution of 2 kilograms of Ragi to family card holders in Nilgiris and

Dharmapuri districts on a pilot.

e. *Millet Festivals* – To increase the awareness and consumption

3. State Agriculture Development Schemes:

a. Village Agricultural Development Group

- i. It consists of 25 to 50 farmers
- ii. Implemented in 2504 villages under KAVIADP
- iii. To increase the income from the cultivation
- iv. Training will be provided to the group

b. Nel Jeyaraman Traditional Paddy Varieties:

- i. To conserve and propagate Tamil Nadu's traditional Rice varieties
- ii. Seeds will be produced in an area of **200** *acres* in Government seed farms and distributed to farmers at subsidized rates.

c. Rewards for Best Performing Farmer

- i. Cash award of five lakh rupees to the farmer with the highest yield in a crop at State level.
- ii. Awards to officers Filed, Block and District Level for Highest production and productivity





- d. *Alternative Crop cultivation during Kuruvai season:* To increase the soil fertility and enhance the production
- e. Making Youth into Agri Entrepreneurs: Financial assistance at the rate of 2 lakh Rupees will be extended to 200 young Agricultural and Horticulture graduates
- f. Distribution of Farm Implement kits
 - i. To help and improve the efficiency of farmers in the traditional agricultural operations
 - ii. Kits will be distributed to
 - 1. small and marginal farmers and
 - 2. landless agricultural labourers

4. Promotion of Organic Farming:

- a. Tamil Nadu Organic Farming Policy 2023 released recently
- b. To encourage organic farming, 725 clusters will be formed covering an area of 14,500 hectare in 32 districts.
- c. Awards will be given to District Collectors completing this task in a timely manner to benefit more farmers
- d. Promotion of Organic farming in Nilgiris
- e. To provide fifty percent subsidy to organic farmers for undertaking pesticide residue analysis
- f. Awareness creation
- g. Identification potential areas to bring under organic farming
- 5. **Nammazhvar Award** for **Best Organic Farmer**. To the farmers who practice and promote organic farming Rs. 5 Lakh on Republic Day
- 6. *Green Cover through agroforestry:* Financial assistance to set up new nurseries to increase forest cover under Agroforestry Scheme
- 7. Additional 20% subsidy for SC/ST Farmers or high value components
- 8. **DIGITAL AGRICULTURE**
 - a. *Agricultural e-Service centres* will be established To get all services electronically
 - b. Information Dissemination Group WhatsApp groups of farmers at block levels will be formed for Disseminating Information.





 c. GRAINS-One Platform-Multiple Benefits (Grower Online Registration of Agriculture Input System) - enable the farmers to avail various benefits from a single source – One Stop Solution

TAMIL NADU AGRICULTURAL UNIVERSITY

- 1. Corpus fund of **Rs.100 Cr** provided for Tamil Nadu Agricultural University for carrying out research projects, implementing schemes
- Insects' museum has been created in Coimbatore (TN agricultural University) digitize the museum
- 3. Nanotechnology Centre is established at Tamil Nadu Agricultural University
- 4. *Millet cafes* will be set up *one each* in *every District Collector's office* and in *Mathi-Poomalai complex* to promote consumption of millet products produced by *SHGs*.
- 5. Selling of honey under 'MATHI' brand.
- Special committee under the Chairmanship of the *Principal Chief Conservator of Forests* to review and provide solution for crop damage caused by wild animals
- 7. *Tamil Nadu Food Processing and Agri Export Promotion Corporation*, (TN-ApEx) has been formed
- 8. The *Agro Industrial corridor* in the *Cauvery delta Zone* in the area between Tiruchirappalli and Nagapattinam
- 9. *Regional Startup Hub* will be created in *Thanjavur* by the *TANSIM* to promote agrotechnological innovations in Cauvery Delta Region.
- 10. Integrated Micro Irrigation system in Lower Bhavani in Erode.
- 11. Introducing a system of *e-Negotiable Warehouse Receipt*.
- 12. One Agricultural Scientist at Block level to provide information to farmers.
