TNPSC BITS

- The 1st G20 Trade and Investment Working Group (TIWG) Meeting took place in Mumbai.
- The 1st Disaster Risk Reduction Working Group (DRRWG) meeting under India's G20 Presidency was held in Gandhinagar, Gujarat.
- The Second G20 Sherpas meeting under India's G20 Presidency, chaired by India's G20 Sherpa Amitabh Kant took take place Kumarakom, Kerala.
- The two-day Science-20 conference under India's G20 presidency held at the Hapania International Fair Ground in Agartala, Tripura.
- India's top men's doubles badminton pair of Satwiksairaj Ranki Reddy and Chirag Shetty won Swiss Open Super 300 Badminton doubles title in Basel, Switzerland.
- Indian weightlifters Dhanush Loganathan and Jyoshna Sabar won bronze medals in their respective categories in the IWF World Youth Championships, held at Albania.

New Vande Bharat Express

✤ Indian Railways' eleventh Vande Bharat Express was launched recently.





- It will operate from Rani Kamalapati station in Bhopal and Hazrat Nizamuddin in the national capital.
- ✤ This is the Madhya Pradesh's first Vande Bharat Express.
- It is also the second fastest Vande Bharat Express after the New Delhi-Varanasi Vande Bharat Express.

INTERNATIONAL

Marburg virus disease – Tanzania

- Tanzania has announced its first outbreak of the deadly Marburg virus disease (MVD).
- The MVD was first discovered in 1967 in Marburg and Frankfurt in Germany and Belgrade, Serbia.
- ✤ It is from the same "virus family" as Ebola.
- It causes a severe haemorrhagic fever, while fatality rates have varied from 24% to 88%.
- ✤ There have been several outbreaks since its discovery, with the worst being Angola in 2004-2005 with 227 deaths.
- The virus is initially transmitted to people from fruit bats, and then from person to person through body fluids or contaminated objects.




Britain on trans-Pacific pact

The United Kingdom has agreed to join an 11-country Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership (CPTPP).





- UK looks to deepen ties in the region and build its global trade links after leaving the European Union.
- ✤ The CPTPP is the successor to a previous trans-Pacific trade pact.
- ✤ Its members include fellow G7 members Canada and Japan, and historic UK allies Australia and New Zealand.
- The remaining members are Mexico, Chile and Peru, along with Malaysia, Singapore, Vietnam and Brunei.



ECONOMY

Committee to strengthening MDBs



Under the aegis of India's G20 Presidency, a 11-member expert group has been set up to explore measures to strengthen the multilateral development banks (MDBs).





- Professor Lawrence Summers, President Emeritus, Harvard University and N K Singh, are co-convenors of the G20 Expert Group.
- The panel would work on making a road map for an updated MDB ecosystem for the 21st century.
- It would develop Mechanisms for coordination among MDBs for them to address and finance global development and other challenges more effectively.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Reusable Launch Vehicle Mission



- The ISRO in collaboration with the IAF and DRDO successfully conducted the RLV autonomous landing mission (RLV LEX) at Chitradurga, Karnataka.
- This test was the second of five tests that are a part of ISRO's efforts to develop RLVs, or spaceplanes/shuttles.
- It can travel to low earth orbits to deliver payloads and return to earth for use again.
- The first test with RLV-TD (HEX1) involved the vehicle landing on a hypothetical runway over the Bay of Bengal.
- While the 2nd LEX experiment involved a precise landing on a runway.
- Three more experiments return flight experiment (REX), powered cruise flight, and Scramjet Propulsion Experiment (SPEX) have to be conducted.


Monster black hole

✤ Astronomers have discovered one of the biggest black holes inside a galaxy.






- ✤ The giant black hole has a mass of 30 billion suns.
- ✤ It could consume billions of suns like the one in our Solar System.
- ✤ The black hole is located in one of the galaxies of the Abell 1201 galaxy cluster.
- ✤ It is located hundreds of millions of light-years from Earth.
- ✤ This is discovered through gravitational lensing method for the first time.
- Gravitational lensing is where a foreground galaxy bends the light coming from a more distant object and magnifies it.
- ♦ When a star collapses at the end of its life, it gives birth to black hole.



ENVIRONMENT



Cyrtopodion Vindhya

- ✤ A new species of naked-toed gecko (Cyrtopodion) has been discovered in Dahod and Panchmahals districts in Gujarat.
- It has been named after Vindhya hills as 'Cyrtopodion Vindhya'.
- It is the fifth endemic species of reptile described in the last fifteen years from the state of Gujarat.





- These gekkonid lizards distributed across the arid regions of north Africa, Arabia, and Central Asia to north western India.
- ✤ There are 23 known species of genus Cyrtopodion genus of the Gecko family.
- ✤ This is the twenty-fourth one.

50 years of Bandipur Tiger Reserve

- Sandipur in Karnataka completed 50 years as a Project Tiger Reserve.
- On April 1, 1973, the then Prime Minister Indira Gandhi launched the flagship conservation programme to arrest the big cat's dwindling population.
- ◆ There were 12 tigers in Bandipur when Project Tiger was launched.
- ✤ Today, the number of tigers utilizing the park is 173.
- Bandipur was among the first nine reserves to be brought under the flagship programme.
- The Bandipur Tiger Reserve is an important component of the country's first biosphere reserve, Nilgiri Biosphere Reserve.



SPORTS

Women's Boxing World Championships

- Indian women boxers recreated history and brought home four gold medals at the IBA Women's World Boxing Championship.
- Nitu Ghanghas (48kg), Nikhat Zareen (50kg), Lovlina Borgohain (75) and Saweety Boora (81kg) won gold for the country.
- $\boldsymbol{\diamond}$ India stood on the top in the gold medal tally at the championship
- This was India's second time in history to win four gold medals at the Women's World Boxing Championships.






In 2006, Mary Kom, Sarita Devi, Jenny Lalremliani and Lekha K.C won gold for the country.

Prevention of Blindness Week 2023 - April 1/7




 The Government of India organises the Prevention of Blindness Week from April 1-7 every year to raise awareness about the causes and prevention of blindness.





- The annual event aims to support individuals with visual impairments, and to promote access to eye care services.
- Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru and Raj Kumari Amrit Kaur, the first health minister of India, established the National Society for the Prevention of Blindness.
- \clubsuit The observance of the week was started in 1960.



International Day of Mine Awareness - April 04

- It aims to raise awareness against explosive mines and gather assistance towards their eradication.
- The mine action community plays a significant role towards achieving the mine action goals.
- ✤ And it is led by the United Nations Mine Action Service (UNMAS).
- Theme of the year is "Mine Action Cannot Wait".
- ✤ In 1997, the Anti-Personnel Mine Ban Convention was established for signature.
- ✤ It led the first campaign against mines.
- ✤ And 164 countries have ratified it since then.
