





TNPSC BITS

- ❖ The Supreme Court has initiated steps towards inclusive infrastructure and sexuality sensitisation for LGBTQIA+ community within the premises to ensure a dignified work environment at the apex court.
 - Senior advocate Menaka Guruswamy had been inducted as a member of Gender Sensitisation and Internal Complaints Committee (GSICC).
- ❖ The Union Home ministry announced the examinations to recruit constables in Central Armed Police Force (CAPF) will be conducted in 13 regional languages.
 - The question paper will be set in Assamese, Bengali, Gujarati, Marathi, Malayalam, Kannada, Tamil, Telugu, Odia, Urdu, Punjabi, Manipuri and Konkani languages.
- ❖ The G20 Meeting of Agricultural Chief Scientists (MACS) is being organized at Varanasi by the Department of Agricultural Research and Education.
- ❖ The World Voice Day is an annual event celebrated on April 16th to raise awareness about the importance of voice in our daily lives.

TAMIL NADU

TANGEDCO Domestic coal receipt



❖ Tamil Nadu Generation and Distribution Corporation Ltd. (TANGEDCO) received 192.67 lakh tonnes of domestic coal during 2022-23.





- ❖ This is the highest quantum in the last 10 years.
- During 2022-23, the receipt of coal from Mahanadi Coalfields Ltd mines is 178.64 lakh tonnes.
- ❖ The receipt from Singareni Collieries Company Limited is about 14.03 lakh tonnes.

Justice K. Chandru committee



- ❖ The Tamil Nadu government has constituted a single member committee headed by retired Madras High Court judge K. Chandru.
- ❖ It is tasked to recommend the measures for effective administration of the homes functioning as per the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act of 2015.
- ❖ He will study and make recommendations regarding infrastructure, health, nutrition, staff requirement, after care issues and stakeholder participation.


Tamilnadu Backward Classes Commission extension

❖ The state's backward classes commission headed by Justice Thiru V. Bharathidasan has sought six months to submit a report regarding the contentious 10.5% reservation for the Vanniyar community within the quota for most backward classes.






- Now, based on the commission's request, the time to submit a report has been extended.
- ❖ This 10.5% internal reservation in Tamil Nadu was introduced by the AIADMK on 26 February 2021.
- ❖ The 10.5% internal quota was applicable in public education and employment.
- ❖ In November 2021, the Madras HC held the quota for Vanniyars as unconstitutional and later, Supreme Court also upheld the same.



Ancient rock art site Nilgiris




- ❖ An ancient rock art site near Jackanarai village in Kotagiri Block, was discovered recently.
- ❖ This has depiction around 40 abstract rock paintings.
- ❖ The red-ochre art, comprise abstract geometrical images, mostly lines, anthropomorphic figures and what could be depictions of weaponry.





- ❖ This could be the 16th such site recorded in the district.
- ❖ It may have cultural link with local Kurumba tribe.

New 'carbon-neutral' hubs



- ❖ The Tamil Nadu government has selected Rajapalayam and Rameswaram to be made 'carbon-neutral hubs'.
- * Rajapalayam is strategically situated at the foothills of the pristine Western Ghats, with reserved forests.
- ❖ It is also part of an important catchment for the upper Vaippar river basin.
- * Rameswaram, a spiritual destination, attracts thousands of tourists every day.
- ❖ To achieve carbon-neutrality, the government has planned to take following steps:
 - o Establishing bio-CNG plants for wet waste processing,
 - o Promoting a low-emission lifestyle through land use planning,
 - o Removal of accumulated waste through biomining, and
 - Increasing low-emission transport systems.
- It will also work for increasing the carbon sink through afforestation.
- It establishing material recovery facilities to reduce ocean-bound plastic.

NATIONAL

Constitution Bench for same-sex marriage case

The Supreme Court formed a new Constitution Bench headed by Chief Justice of India DY Chandrachud to hear a series of petitions seeking legal recognition of same sex marriages.






- ❖ The other four Associate Judges on the Bench are Justices Sanjay Kishan Kaul, S. Ravindra Bhat, Hima Kohli and P.S. Narasimha.
- ❖ Article 145(3) mandates that cases involving substantial questions and interpretation of the Constitution should be heard by a Bench of at least five judges.



5th investor in AI



❖ India ranked fifth in terms of investments received by startups offering artificial intelligence (AI)-based products and services last year.





- ❖ Total investments in AI startups in India stood at \$3.24 billion in 2022.
- Thus, India is ahead of South Korea, Germany, Canada and Australia, among others.
- ❖ Those ahead of India in the list are the US, China, the UK and Israel.

RAPIDX Rail Service



- ❖ India's first semi-high-speed regional rail services have been named as 'RAPIDX' by the NCRTC.
- ❖ The trains will run on the Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS) corridors.
- ❖ It will be implemented to connect key urban nodes across the National Capital Region.
- ❖ The National Capital Region Transport Corporation (NCRTC) is a joint venture company of the Union government and states of Delhi, Haryana, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh.

INTERNATIONAL

Joint working group meet on Chabahar port







- ❖ The first meeting of the India-Central Asia Joint Working Group on Chabahar Port held in Mumbai.
- ❖ The two-day meeting was attended by Kazakhstan, Kyrgyz Republic, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, and Uzbekistan.
- ❖ The special invitees were the country representative of the UNWFP, the deputy foreign minister of Iran and the consul general of Afghanistan.

India's biggest trading partner

- ❖ US emerges as India's biggest trading partner in FY23 at USD 128.55 bn.
- ❖ The bilateral trade between India and the US has increased by 7.65% in 2022-23.
- ❖ It was USD 80.51 billion in 2020-21.

Miniratna Category-I for SECI

- ❖ State-owned Solar Energy Corporation of India Ltd (SECI) has got the status of Miniratna Category-I Central Public Sector Enterprise.
- ❖ It was Incorporated in 2011.
- ❖ SECI is the primary implementing agency for renewable energy schemes/projects of the Ministry of New and Renewable Energy.





- Criteria for Miniratna- I status
 - The CPSEs have made a profit in the last three years continuously,
 - With a pre-tax profit is 30 crores or more in at least one of the three years and
 - o Need to have a positive net worth.



New Logo of SEBI



- ❖ The Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) unveiled its new logo.
- ❖ This is released during its 35th Foundation Day.





- ❖ The new logo represents SEBI's commitment to facilitating economic growth through capital formation.
- ❖ It is also incorporating the power of technology and data into policy-making.
- ❖ SEBI was granted statutory powers in 1992.

STATES

India's 1st 3D printed post office



- ❖ Bengaluru will soon have India's first post office built out of 3D printing technology.
- ❖ The 1,000-square-feet building will cost 25 lakh rupees to set up, reducing the final cost by 25%.
- This will function the same as normal post offices.


New GI tag of Madhya Pradesh Products

- ❖ Madhya Pradesh's Products such as Gond Painting, Sharbati Wheat get GI Tag.
- ❖ Gond painting is traditional art of Madhya Pradesh and belong to the Gond tribe.
- ❖ Patangarh village of Dindori district is famous for gond paintings.
- ❖ Shabarti wheat is a regional variety of wheat grown in Sehore and vidisha districts.

IMPORTANT DAYS

Thirunangaiyar Day - April 15



- ❖ Tamilnadu government observes thirunangaiyar day on April 15.
- ❖ On this day, Tamil Nadu established the country's first welfare Board in 2008.
- ❖ In 2006, the Chief Minister M. Karunanidhi replaced the former title of 'aravani' and replaced it with the more dignified 'Thirunangai'
- ❖ A welfare Board set up with this name under the Social Welfare department.
- ❖ During this year observation, Chief Minister handed over the State-level award for 'Thirunangaiyar' to transperson P. Aishwarya from Vellore district.
- ❖ She has served the transperson community for the past 22 years and has been creating awareness about them through folklore and drama.
- ❖ Grace Banu and Marlima Muralitharan received this award in 2021 and 2022 respectively.


75th foundation of Himachal Pradesh - April 15

❖ The province of Himachal Pradesh was organised on 15 April 1948 as a Chief Commissioner's State.





- ❖ This time the State level function was held at Kaza in the tribal Lahul-Spiti district.
- ❖ Later on, the 25th of January 1950, Himachal was made a 'C' category State.
- ❖ On 1st of November, 1956, Himachal Pradesh was declared a Union Territory.
- ❖ In 1966, the hilly areas of Punjab were included in Himachal Pradesh.
- ❖ On the 18th of December 1970, Parliament passed the Himachal Pradesh Act.
- ❖ On the 25th of January 1971, Himachal Pradesh came into existence as a full-fledged State and became the 18th State of the country.




World Art Day - April 15
