TNPSC BITS

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi confers Prime Minister's Awards for Excellence in Public Administration at Vigyan Bhawan in New Delhi.
 - o It was awarded on the occasion of Civil Services Day (April 21).
- ✤ The Tamil Nadu government has decided to set up four Olympic training academies in the four zones of the state.
 - \circ $\,$ The announcement had been made under Rule 110 in the Assembly.
- The much-anticipated Women Cricket's Indian Premier League (IPL) is all set to get underway in 2023.
 - Franchise-based model is likely to have 6 teams in the inaugural season.

TANUVAS







- The Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (TANUVAS) has been ranked first among the 15 State veterinary universities in India.
- It was ranked by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) in its recent (2020) rank list.
- TANUVAS has taken 12th place on the list of agriculture, veterinary, horticulture, and fisheries universities across the country.
- It is a significant achievement because it has moved from the 41st rank in 2017 to the 12th rank in 2020.

Hello Payment system

- Russian Central Bank has included a new payment system called HELLO into the national register of credit institutions.
- Russian commercial bank TransKapitalBank will be the operator of the system's payment infrastructure services.
- The payment system HELLO is a set of payment services and institutions that facilitates money transfer transactions.



Sarmat intercontinental ballistic missile

- It is an intercontinental ballistic missile recently successfully test-launched by Russia.
- The new missile complex has the highest tactical and technical characteristics and is able to overcome all modern means of anti-missile defense.
- The name Sarmat is based upon the nomadic Sarmatian tribes





They used to live between the 6th and 4th century BC in the current territories of Russia, Ukraine, and Kazakhstan.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Space Bricks

- Researchers from the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) and the Indian Institute of Science (IISc) have developed a way to make 'space bricks'.
- The team has demonstrated that the slurry-casting method is used to make 'space bricks' from Martian soil with the help of bacteria and urea.
- These 'space bricks' can be used to construct building-like structures on Mars that could facilitate human settlement on the red planet.

Electric three-wheeler plant



✤ Telangana is to host the world's largest electric three-wheeler plant with the California-based Biliti Electric Inc.





- It plans to set up a factory, in phases, to produce 2.40 lakh EVs a year in the State.
- ✤ It will be the world's largest electric three-wheeler factory.

Social Awareness and Action to Neutralise Pneumonia



- Health and Medical Education Minister of Karnataka, K. Sudhakar launched the 'Social Awareness and Action to Neutralise Pneumonia Successfully' (SAANS).
- SAANS is a campaign that has been launched to ensure early detection and greater awareness of pneumonia in children under the age of five.
- Pneumonia is a lung infection that is caused due to viral, bacterial, or fungal infection.
- ♦ As per SRS 2018, Karnataka's under-five mortality is at 28 per 1000 live births.
- ✤ To achieve the National Health Policy goals, pneumonia mortality has to be reduced to less than 3 deaths per 1,000 live births.





 In India, childhood pneumonia contributes to 15 percent of the nation's underfive deaths.

Invictus Games



- ✤ The 2022 edition of the Invictus Games opened in The Hague, Netherlands.
- The Invictus Games' first edition was held in London in the year 2014.
- The games have been held in Orlando, the US in 2016, Toronto, Canada in 2017, and Sydney, Australia in 2018.
- Dusseldorf, Germany will be hosting the 2023 edition of the games.





- It is an international sporting competition that is similar to the Paralympics but is meant for the injured, wounded, and sick military war veterans and service personnel.
- ✤ The Games has drawn inspiration from poet William Ernest Henley's poem 'Invictus'.
