





#### TNPSC BITS

- ❖ The Geographical Indications Registry under the Central Ministry of Commerce has accepted the petition to rename Bihar Makhana as Mithila Makhana.
  - o This is done for the welfare of fox nut growers in the Mithila region.
- ❖ India and Vietnam signed a letter of intent for enhanced cooperation in the postal sector.
  - o It was signed in line with the comprehensive strategic & economic ties between both countries.

## 8th Indian Ocean Dialogue



- ❖ The eighth Indian Ocean Dialogue was held recently.
- ❖ The dialogue was jointly hosted by the External Affairs Ministry and the Indian Council of World Affairs.





- ❖ The dialogue was hosted under the theme "Leveraging Digital Technologies for Health, Education, Development, and Trade in Indian Ocean Rim Association Member States".
- ❖ The Indian Ocean Rim Association is an international organisation comprising of 23 states which share borders with the Indian Ocean.

#### **SANT Missile**



- ❖ The Defence Research and Development Organisation and Indian Air Force, flight tested the indigenously developed and designed Stand-Off Anti-tank (SANT) Missile from Pokhran Range.
- ❖ SANT missiles can neutralize targets in a range up to 10 km.
- ❖ SANT Missile for the armed forces has been designed and developed by the Research Centre Imarat in Hyderabad in coordination with the other labs of DRDO and other industries.

#### 100th year of Public Accounts Committee

- ❖ The Public Accounts Committee (PAC) of the Parliament celebrates the 100th year of its establishment.
- ❖ Public Accounts Committee was introduced in 1921 after its first mention in the Government of India Act, 1919 also called Montford Reforms.
- ❖ PAC is one of the parliamentary committees that examine the annual audit reports of CAG which the President lays before the Parliament of India.
- ❖ Those three reports submitted by CAG are,
  - o Audit report on appropriation accounts
  - o Audit report on finance accounts

# INTRODUCTION

- Public Accountability has been regarded as an important pre-requisite for the proper and effective delivery of public service by the Governments.
- The Public Accounts Committee (PAC) examines the report of Accounts of the union government submitted by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India, to the President.
- The Public Accounts Committee in India ensures Parliamentary control over government expenditure.
- It is also responsible for scrutinizing the accounts of autonomous and semi-autonomous bodies.

# Best Practices in Municipal Solid Waste Management



- ❖ It is a comprehensive knowledge repository of how Indian cities are managing their solid waste.
- It was by NITI Aayog.
- ❖ India's solid waste management sector has witnessed unparalleled growth in the last few years.
- ❖ The Swachh Bharat Mission Phase 2 is launched to further strengthen the efforts for a clean India.
- ❖ The report, titled "Waste-Wise Cities: Best Practices in Municipal Solid Waste Management", documents best practices from 28 cities in 15 states of India.





❖ The new report is the result of a country-wide study and survey jointly conducted by NITI Aayog and CSE.

## **Animal exchange Programme**

- ❖ The Indira Gandhi Zoological Park (IGZP) of Visakhapatnam in Andhra Pradesh welcomed three new animals as part of its animal exchange programme with National Zoological Park (NZP) in New Delhi.
- ❖ The Himalayan goral, the Bengal fox a couple of nilgai deer (Indian antelope) are the new species that have arrived.
- ❖ This animal exchange programme was approved by Central Zoo Authority in April 2021.
- ❖ This exchange is being executed in two phases.
- ❖ IGZP will be getting one more hippopotamus from NZP, New Delhi.

#### Covovax vaccine for Children



- ❖ The World Health Organisation gave approval for emergency use of Covovax vaccine for Children.
- ❖ WHO listed the Covovax as the ninth COVID-19 vaccine for emergency use.
- This move is aimed at increasing access to vaccination across lower-income countries.





- ❖ The Serum Institute of India (SII) produces Covovax, under the license from Novavax of USA.
- ❖ The vaccine is administered in two doses, 21 days apart.

## Young Geospatial Scientist award

- \* Ropesh Goyal from IIT-Kanpur won the Young Geospatial Scientist award.
- ❖ It was awarded in recognition of his unique contribution to developing the Indian Geoid Model and computation software.
- ❖ The Young Geospatial Scientist award and a gold medal have been presented every year since 2011 to promising scientists below 35 years of age.
- ❖ It is awarded in memory of Rachapudi Kamakshi.
- \* Rachapudi Kamakshi is a strategic analyst with a strong inclination towards geography and geospatial studies.



## **International Maritime Organization Award**

- ❖ The International Maritime Organization council has awarded Certificate of Commendation to Indian Navy, Indian Coast Guard, and Master along with crew members of tugboat Ocean Bliss.
- ❖ The award has been given for exceptional and courageous efforts towards the rescue operation of M/T New Diamond.
- ❖ The rescue team members of the Indian Navy, Indian Coast Guard, and the master and crew of tugboat Ocean Bliss carried out sustained and effective fire-fighting operations.





❖ They skilfully towed the vessel away from the coast, thereby preventing loss of life at sea and averting a serious marine pollution incident.

# Commonwealth Weightlifting Championships



- ❖ Ajay Singh clinched India's third gold of the Commonwealth Weightlifting Championships held at Tashkent of Uzbekistan by winning the men's 81kg category.
- ❖ Ajay Singh lifted a total of 322kg and also set a national record in snatch (147kg).
- ❖ He became the third Indian weightlifter to directly qualify for next year's Common wealth Games in Birmingham.





❖ Jeremy Lalrinnunga (67kg) and Achinta Sheuli (73kg) have already qualified for the 2022 CWG after winning gold in their respective competitions.

## **International Migrants Day - December 18**

- ❖ The day is marked by the United Nations, through the UN-related agency International Organization for Migration.
- ❖ The day is observed to highlight the contributions made by the 272 million migrants.
- ❖ It includes more than 41 million people who are internally displaced persons, and the challenges they face.
- ❖ The theme of International Migrants Day 2021 is Harnessing the potential of human mobility.



## **National Minorities Rights Day - December 18**







- ❖ It is observed to uphold the right to freedom and equal opportunities for the ethnic minorities in India and create awareness about the respect and dignity of the minorities.
- ❖ 18<sup>th</sup> December was declared as the Minorities Rights Day back in 1992 by the United Nations.
- ❖ In India, it is the responsibility of the National Commission for Minorities (NCM).
- ❖ The NCM in India was established by the Union Government under the National Commission for Minorities Act, in 1992.

- ❖ It is one of the most widely used languages in the world.
