TNPSC BITS

- Saudi Arabia has banned the Tablighi Jamaat.
 - Tablighi Jamaat is an Islamist proselytizing movement.
- Voters in the French island territory of New Caledonia in the southwest Pacific Ocean chose to stay part of France.
 - $\circ~$ This was concluded in a referendum boycotted by pro-independence forces and closely watched around the South Pacific.
- The proposal from New Zealand's health officials would effectively ban anyone 14 years or younger from purchasing cigarettes for their entire lifetime.
 - $\circ~$ It would raise the minimum age to buy cigarettes every year beginning in 2023.
- Nicaragua breaks diplomatic ties with Taiwan in favor of China.
 - China claims Taiwan as part of its territory awaiting reunification.
- IndiGo has signed an agreement with Dehradun-based Council of Scientific and Industrial Research-Indian Institute of Petroleum.
 - This is to manufacture and deploy sustainable aviation fuel globally.

NATIONAL

Convoke 2021-22



- ✤ NITI Aayog in partnership with Bharti Foundation, the philanthropic arm of Bharti Enterprises, launched Convoke 2021-22.
- Convoke is a National research Symposium that aims at addressing challenges in imparting education and strengthening its quality with a special focus on all teachers, educationists, heads of schools across India.





- Through Convoke they can now share their micro research papers.
- These research papers will be analysed by a panel of Educationists.
- The shortlisted Research Papers will be presented during the 'National Research Symposium' scheduled in January 2022.

Surrogacy (Regulation) Bill, 2019

What is Surrogacy?

- It is an effective method to treat infertility.
- In this method another woman carries the child in her womb for nine months and gives birth to it.
- It can be called as an arrangement between the intended parents and the surrogate mother.



- ✤ The Parliament passed this bill recently.
- The bill aims to constitute a National Surrogacy Board and state surrogacy boards and appoint appropriate authorities for regulation of the practice and process of surrogacy.
- According to this, only Indian couples who have been legally married for at least five years will be allowed to opt for surrogacy.
- The bill seeks to "allow ethical altruistic surrogacy to the intending infertile Indian married couple between the age of 23-50 years and 26-55 years for female and male, respectively".

Oil & gas block auctions

- The Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas has launched the seventh bid round under the Open Acreage Licensing Programme (OALP).
- These include five on land blocks, two shallow-water blocks, and one ultra-deepwater block.





Since 2016, five rounds of OALP have been concluded for 105 Exploration and Production (E&P) blocks

India-Central Asia Dialogue



- The External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar hosted the 3rd meeting of the India-Central Asia Dialogue in New Delhi.
- The Foreign Ministers of Kazakhstan, Kyrgyz Republic, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, and Uzbekistan participated in this.
- * Their previous meeting was organized by India in October 2020 via video conference.





Three of these five, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan, and Tajikistan, share a border with Afghanistan.

LogiXtics



- The Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade has launched the Unified Logistics Interface Platform's (ULIP) hackathon – 'LogiXtics'.
- ◆ This is to crowdsource more ideas that will benefit the logistics industry.
- The Unified Logistics Interface Platform (ULIP) Hackathon LogiXtics is being organized by NITI Aayog and Atal Innovation Mission.
- ULIP has been designed to enhance efficiency and reduce logistics costs in India by creating a transparent platform that can provide real-time information to all stakeholders.
- The cost of logistics in India is about 14% which is higher than in other countries in the world.
- National Industrial Corridor Development Corporation was mandated by NITI Aayog in January 2021 to develop ULIP.

Finn's weaver bird

The Finn's weaver bird, numbering less than 500 in India is primarily found in Terai grasslands, in Uttarakhand and western Uttar Pradesh, apart from a few pockets in Assam.





The Finn's weaver (Ploceus megarhynchus), listed as "vulnerable" in the International Union for Conservation of Nature's (IUCN) Red List has been up listed to the "endangered" category.



INTERNATIONAL

Queen of Asia

- Sri Lanka's National gem and Jewellery Authority has said that the world's largest corundum, blue sapphire has been found in Ratnapura in Sri Lanka.
- ✤ It weighs around 310 kg.
- This rare gemstone had been found three months ago from a gem in Ratnapura.
- The blue sapphire which has been discovered as a single crystal has been named Queen of Asia.



Zero Covid Policy

- Hong Kong implemented its new 'Zero Covid Policy'.
- This strategy has led to the toughest quarantine and testing measures worldwide.
- ✤ This policy has kept infections low.





- Hong Kong is a city and special administrative region of China.
- ✤ It is located on the eastern Pearl River Delta in South China.

World Anti-Doping Agency Report

- The World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) published its report on "Rule Violations", recently.
- The number of offenders in India and increased in 2019, making India among the top three of the world's biggest doping violators.
- India stands behind Russia and Italy.

World Gold Council's 'Bullion Trade-in India' report

- ♦ Imports made up 86% of India's gold supply between 2016-2020.
- The inbound shipments continue to grow despite high import duty.
- ✤ In 2020, India imported 377 tonnes of gold bars from more than 30 countries.





Out of this 55% came from just two countries - Switzerland (44%) and the UAE (11%).

 Most of the coral reefs in the western Indian Ocean face a high risk of extinction in the next 50 years due to global warming and overfishing, as per a new study.

Study on coral reefs





- The study conducted by a group of researchers claims that coral reefs from Seychelles to South Africa might become functionally extinct by 2070.
- The study was published in the journal Nature Sustainability.

Punjab - state festival

- The Chief Minister of Punjab, Charanjit Singh Channi has declared Lord Krishna Balram Jagannath Rath Yatra as an annual state festival.
- The announcement for the same was made during flagging off the 25th Shri Lord Krishna Balram Jagannath Rath Yatra.

PERSONALITIES, AWARDS, AND EVENTS

Alimihan Seyiti

- China's oldest person, Alimihan Seyiti, has died at the age of 135 in Xinjiang Uygur Autonomous Region.
- Hailing from Komuxerik township of Shule County in Kashgar Prefecture, Seyiti was born on June 25, 1886.
- ✤ In 2013, she topped the list of China's oldest living persons.
- ♦ Komuxerik is known as a "longevity town," with many elderly aged above 90.



Cate Blanchett

- Oscar winner Cate Blanchett will be felicitated with French cinema's top honour, the Cesar d'Honneur.
- Blanchett will receive the Cesar d'Honneur, a lifetime achievement award, in Paris on February 25, 2022.





- Blanchett won her first Oscar for Martin Scorsese's 'The Aviator', in which she played the role of late screen icon Katharine Hepburn.
- ✤ She earned her second Oscar trophy for Woody Allen's 2013 feature film 'Blue Jasmine'.
