TNPSC BITS

- ❖ Vayana Network and Federal Bank have been awarded the 'Most Effective Bank-Fintech Partnership: Agile and Adaptable' at the IBSi-Global Fintech Innovation Awards 2021.
 - o The award was conferred for automating and simplifying Supply Chain Finance.
- ❖ India's two-time Olympic medallist shuttler PV Sindhu was appointed as a member of the Badminton World Federation's (BWF) Athletes' Commission.
 - The 26-year-old former world champion was named alongside five others who will serve as members till 2025.

- ❖ The compensations will be paid from the State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF).
- * Those involved in relief and preparedness activities will also be covered in this.
- ❖ It is constituted under the Disaster Management Act, 2005.

CRPF women commandos



- ❖ In a first, a maiden contingent of CRPF (Central Reserve Police Force) women commandos who have been trained in VIP security will soon be deployed with Z-Plus personalities.
- CRPF raised its first-ever contingent of 32 women commandos in its VIP Security wing.
- ❖ The women commandos will now be tasked to guard its protectees who are based in New Delhi and who receive the top Z+ Cover.


ATMs across the country

- ❖ The number of ATMs across the country stood at over 2.13 lakh by the end of September this year.
- Over 47 percent of these are in rural and semi-urban areas.





- ❖ According to the RBI data, scheduled commercial banks have installed 2,13,145 ATMs up to September 2021.
- ❖ In addition to this, 27,837 White Label ATMs (WLA) were also installed by WLA operators up to September 2021.


- ❖ India was predicted to become the 6th largest economy (by overtaking France) in 2022 and become the 3rd largest economy in 2031.
- ❖ This is as per the Centre for Economics and Business Research's (CEBR) World Economic League Table 2022.
- ❖ The annual league table also predicted that China will overtake the US to be the largest economy in 2030.
- ❖ The world economy is set to surpass \$100 trillion for the first time in 2022.
- ❖ Under COVID-19, India has the third-highest death toll worldwide, ranking behind the United States and Brazil.





❖ India's population is expected to overtake China's at some point between 2024 and 2028.

Spices Statistics at a Glance 2021



- ❖ Agriculture Minister Narendra Singh Tomar has released the book titled Spices Statistics at a Glance 2021.
- ❖ The book is a compendium of all the spices statistics like area, production, productivity, export, import, price, and value of the output of various spices produced in the country.
- ❖ The book has been published by the Directorate of Arecanut and Spices Development.
- ❖ The book highlights the growth achieved in the spices sector during the last seven years.
- ❖ Spices production in the Country has grown from over 67 lakh tonnes in 2014-15 to over 106 lakh tonnes in 2020-21 with an annual growth rate of 7.9 percent.

Vaccines and pill against Covid

- ❖ The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has approved Corbevax and Covovax Covid vaccines and anti-viral drug Molnupiravir for restricted use on adults in emergency situations.
- ❖ CORBEVAX vaccine is India's 1st indigenously developed RBD protein subunit vaccine.





- ❖ It is made by Hyderabad-based firm Biological-E.
- ❖ The Nanoparticle Vaccine, COVOVAX, will be manufactured by Pune-based firm Serum Institute of India.
- ❖ Molnupiravir, an antiviral drug, will now be manufactured in the country by 13 companies for restricted use under emergency situation for adults.

- ❖ The charitable and relief organisation has undertaken relief work in countries after natural disasters such as earthquakes as well as assisting people in wartorn countries.




Edward, O. Wilson

- ❖ He has died at age of 92.
- ❖ He is a U.S. scientist, professor, and author whose study of insects and clarion call to protect Earth earned him the nickname "Darwin's natural heir".





- ❖ He has been called "the father of socio-biology" and "the father of biodiversity".
- ❖ He has won Pulitzer Prizes for nonfiction: 1978's On Human Nature, and The Ants in 1990.

Alpine Skiing Competition



- ❖ Indian skier Aanchal Thakur has bagged a bronze medal at the International Ski Federation (FIS) Alpine Skiing Competition in Montenegro.
- ❖ With this, Aanchal has become the first Indian Ski athlete to win two medals at the international level.
- ❖ She has previously won the bronze medal in 2018.

International Day of Epidemic Preparedness - 27 December
