TNPSC BITS

- Telangana has unveiled the world's first 3D-printed temple, in Burugupally, Siddipet district.
- Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) has been ranked number 1 in service delivery quality and commercial competitiveness in Spain.
- The Global Digital Public Infrastructure Repository and a Social Impact Fund aimed at promoting the development of Social Impact Fund to advance Digital Public Infrastructure (DPI) in the Global South was launched during the G20 Leaders' Summit.
- An Army Medical Corps Officer Col Sunita BS becomes the first woman to assume the role of Commanding Officer at Armed Forces Transfusion Centre, Delhi Cantt.
- The Nepal Army and Indian army is participating in the 17th edition of Joint Military Exercise SURYA KIRAN at Pithoragarh, Uttarakhand.
- ✤ The 9th National Level Pollution Response Exercise (NATPOLREX-IX) was conducted by the Indian Coast Guard in Gujarat.
- REC Limited received the "Best Employer for Policies in Diversity & Inclusion" Award at the 4th Diversity & Inclusion Excellence Awards and Conclave organized by Assocham.

- Indian shooter Anish Bhanwala won the bronze medal in the men's 25m rapid fire pistol event at the ISSF World Cup Final 2023 in Doha, Qatar.
 - $\circ~$ It was also the first medal for India in the men's 25m rapid fire pistol event in the ISSF World Cup Final history.

NATIONAL

PM Vishwakarma under PIDF scheme

 Reserve Bank has been decided to include PM Vishwakarma under the Payments Infrastructure Development Fund (PIDF) Scheme.





- It also extends the tenure of the scheme by another two years.
- The PIDF Scheme aims at incentivising the deployment of payment acceptance infrastructure such as physical Point of Sale (PoS), Quick Response (QR) codes in tier-3 to tier-6 centres, north-eastern states and Union Territories of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh.
- PM Vishwakarma scheme proposed to offer up to 8% subsidy for loans given to artisans.



Compulsory Blending Obligation (CBO) of CBG

- The Centre announced a roadmap for mandatory blending of compressed biogas (CBG) in the transportation and domestic segments of the city gas distribution (CGD) sector in a phased manner.
- The government expects this decision will push manufacturing and consumption of CBG.
- The compulsory blending obligation will be 1 per cent of total CNG and domestic PNG consumption for FY26, 3 per cent for FY27, and 4 per cent for FY28.





✤ The obligation mandates 5 per cent blending from FY29.



Indian Ocean Tuna Commission



- The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, is organizing the 19th Working Party on Data Collection and Statistics (WPDCS19) of the Indian Ocean Tuna Commission (IOTC).
- This is an important meeting organized by the IOTC and hosted by Department of Fisheries, India.





- It will bring together the renowned Scientists and Experts in the field of Tuna fisheries from all around the world.
- The IOTC currently has 31 contracting parties and two cooperating noncontracting parties, Liberia and Senegal.
- Tunas alone contributing an estimated annual value of trade of US\$41 billion (in 2018).

INTERNATIONAL

AI's secure by design



- The United States, Britain and some other countries unveiled the first detailed international agreement regarding AI Security.
- It deals points related to, how to keep artificial intelligence safe from rogue actors, pushing for companies to create AI systems that are "secure by design."
- The 18 countries agreed that companies designing and using AI need to develop and deploy it in a way that keeps customers and the wider public safe from misuse.





The agreement is non-binding and carries mostly general recommendations such as monitoring AI systems for abuse, protecting data from tampering and vetting software suppliers.

ECONOMY

Fresh formal jobs

- The Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) payroll data showed that cumulatively 4.92 million new subscribers joined the social security organisation between April-August this year.
- \clubsuit This was 5.51 million in the same period in the previous year.
- ✤ It is reflecting a 10.7 per cent decline in the number of new payrolls created.



SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Dust Devil on Mars

- ✤ NASA's 'six-wheeled geologist,' the Perseverance rover has captured a Martian dust devil on camera.
- $\boldsymbol{\diamondsuit}$ A dust devil is a dust tornado, similar to the tornadoes we see on Earth.
- ✤ Generally, Martian tornadoes are smaller than the one we see on our planet.
- But as per calculations based on the tornado's shadow, was about two kilometres (1.2 miles) in height.





- This is much taller than the average tornado the US experiences every year, and about five times the height of the US Empire State Building.
- The rover spotted the dust devil on a location nicknamed "Thorofare Ridge."
- ◆ It was about four kilometres or 2.5 miles away from the Perseverance Rover.
- It was moving at a speed of about 19 kilometres per hour or 12mph.
- ✤ As per estimates, its width was about 200 feet (or 60 metres).



Mabella' vaccine



 Vaccine maker Indian Immunologicals (IIL) has launched measles and rubella vaccine Mabella for children.





- ✤ A live-attenuated MR vaccine developed in an exclusive partnership with Polyvac Institute of Vietnam.
- The launch addresses the urgent need for control of deadly measles and rubella that claim about one lakh lives of children globally.

National Cadet Corps (NCC) 2023 - 75th Anniversary

- The National Cadet Corps (NCC) celebrated its 75th anniversary on November 27, 2023.
- It is serving as the youth wing of the Indian Armed Forces; it operates from its headquarters in New Delhi.





- The NCC is a voluntary military cadet corps under the Union Ministry of Defence and is open to school and college students.
- The origin of NCC can be traced to the 'University Corps', which was created under the Indian Defence Act, 1917.
- In 1920, when the Indian Territorial Act was passed, the 'University Corps' was replaced by the University Training Corps (UTC).
- Subsequently, the National Cadet Corps Act was accepted by the Governor General and the NCC came into existence on 15 July, 1948.
