## TNPSC BITS

- ❖ Bengaluru airport is to be first in India to phase out gadgets-in-tray security check system.
  - Kempegowda International Airport begin passenger trials of CTX machines, integrated with Automatic Tray Retrieval System and full-body scanners.
- ❖ The Hamfest India 2023, was inaugurated by Devusinh Chauhan, the Minister of State for Communications at Ahmedabad, Gujarat.
  - It serves as a comprehensive platform for amateur radio enthusiasts.
- ❖ OneWeb India, backed by Bharti Group, has received authorizations from IN-SPACe to launch commercial satellite broadband services in India.
  - It is the first company in India to receive these approvals, making it the sole satellite broadband services provider.
- ❖ The lower house of the Indian Parliament has successfully passed the Central Universities (Amendment) Bill, 2023.
  - The primary focus of this bill is the establishment of the 'Sammakka Sarakka Central Tribal University' in Telangana
- ❖ Punjab-origin writer Meira Chand (81) was among the three Singaporeans conferred the Cultural Medallion, the city-state's most prestigious arts accolade.
  - She shared this with novelist Suchen Christine Lim and Malay dance veteran Osman Abdul Hamid.

## NATIONAL

### First-Ever Auction of Critical Mineral Blocks

- ❖ The process of auction of Critical and strategic Minerals have been initiated by the Central Government for the first time in India.
- ❖ The Central Government has amended the MMDR Act, 1957 through the MMDR Amendment Act, 2023.
- ❖ Under this, 24 critical and strategic minerals have been inserted in the MMDR Act, 1957.
- ❖ Further, the amended Act has also empowered Central Government to auction blocks of these minerals.
- ❖ Revenue from auction of these blocks will accrue to the concerned State Governments.

- ❖ They are located across Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Jharkhand, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh and Jammu & Kashmir.
- ❖ There are two lithium blocks — one in Jammu & Kashmir and the other in Chhattisgarh.
- ❖ It is marking for the first time, the rights for mining lithium ore are auctioned to private parties.
- ❖ Before commencing operations, the licensee must obtain 15 approvals and clearances, including forest and environmental clearances, Gram Sabha consent, and others.
- ❖ As of now, India heavily depends on imports for lithium, nickel, and copper.

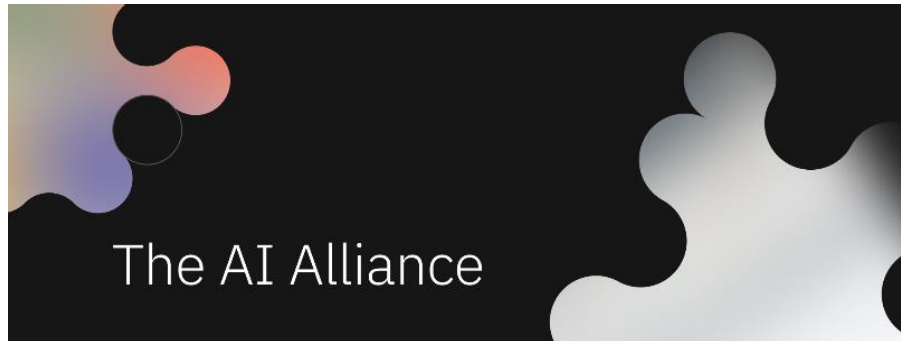

### AI Alliance

- ❖ Meta and IBM have joined forces to establish the AI Alliance.

- ❖ This aims to promote an “open-science” approach to AI development.
- ❖ It is setting them apart from competitors such as Google, Microsoft and Open AI.
- ❖ It emphasizes the importance of open scientific exchange, open innovation and the use of open-source technologies in shaping the future of AI.
- ❖ The term “open-source” has its roots in the decades-old practice of building software with freely accessible code.
- ❖ OpenAI, despite its name, primarily develops closed AI systems.

**The WHO Commission on Social Connection** aims to catalyse global leadership in the area.

It will do so by increasing the priority of social connection as a public health issue, setting the agenda, and scaling up effective solutions.

- ❖ The World Health Organization (WHO) has launched a Commission on Social Connection.

- ❖ It is co-chaired by U.S. Surgeon General Dr. Vivek Murthy and African Union Youth Envoy Chido Mpemba.
- ❖ It is a 3-year initiative to address loneliness as a global health threat.
- ❖ It aims to analyse the role of social connection in health, well-being, economic progress, social development, and innovation.

### **Investor Risk Reduction Access (IRRA) platform**



- ❖ It was launched by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI).
- ❖ It has been jointly developed by all the stock exchanges – BSE (Bombay Stock Exchange), NSE (National Stock Exchange), NCDEX (National Commodity and Derivatives Exchange), MCX (Multi Commodity Exchange) and Metropolitan Stock Exchange of India (MSE)
- ❖ It aims to provide a ‘safety net’ for investors in case of technical glitches faced by a trading member or a stock broker.
- ❖ Its purpose is to provide investors with an opportunity to square off/close their open positions and cancel pending orders using this platform in case of technical glitches or unforeseen outages.

- ❖ Anahat Singh (15) of Delhi becomes the second youngest to win the national squash championship title 2023 (women).
- ❖ Velevan Senthilkumar from Tamil Nadu won the Senior National Squash Championships 2023 in men's category.



- ❖ Joshna Chinappa from Chennai holds the record for being the youngest champion in India.
- ❖ She bagged the first of her record 19 national titles at the age of 14 in 2000.



### **Inter Command Ocean Sailing Race 2023**



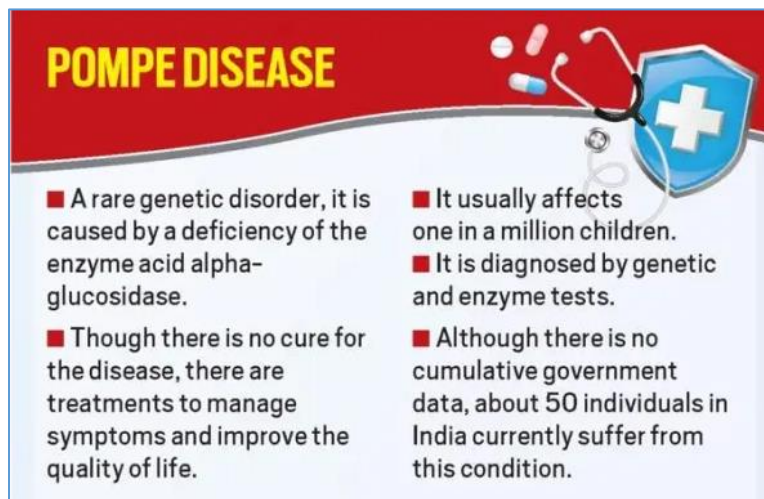
- ❖ The Indian Navy kicked off the second edition of the Inter Command Ocean Sailing Race 2023 at Naval Base, Kochi.
- ❖ The race is to be held from Kochi to Goa.
- ❖ It is organized by the Southern Naval Command under the aegis of the Indian Naval Sailing Association (INSA) based at Naval Headquarters, New Delhi.

- ❖ The race features four 40-footer Indian Naval Sailing Vessels (INSVs) named Bulbul, Neelkanth, Kadalpur, and Hariyal.
- ❖ This edition of the race is distinct as it includes a mixed crew comprising both men and women officers and sailors.
- ❖ It symbolizing gender neutrality and providing equal opportunity to all.

## MISCELLANEOUS

### Pompe Disease

- ❖ India's first patient diagnosed with the Pompe disease died after spending nearly six years in a semi-comatose state.
- ❖ Pompe disease is a rare inherited disorder that affects one child per million.
- ❖ In 2010, Prasanna Shirol, father of a child with Pompe disease, initiated the Organisation for Rare Diseases India (ORDI).
- ❖ ORDI is the first NGO in the country dedicated to rare diseases.
- ❖ Pompe Disease is also known as Glycogen Storage Disease Type II.
- ❖ It is a rare genetic disorder resulting from a deficiency of the enzyme acid alpha-glucosidase (GAA).
- ❖ This enzyme plays a crucial role in breaking down glycogen into glucose within cell lysosomes.
- ❖ While there is currently no cure for Pompe disease, Enzyme Replacement Therapy (ERT) serves as a standard treatment.



**POMPE DISEASE**

- A rare genetic disorder, it is caused by a deficiency of the enzyme acid alpha-glucosidase.
- It usually affects one in a million children.
- Though there is no cure for the disease, there are treatments to manage symptoms and improve the quality of life.
- It is diagnosed by genetic and enzyme tests.
- Although there is no cumulative government data, about 50 individuals in India currently suffer from this condition.
