## TAMIL NADU

### Statue of 'Mahakavi Subramania Bharathiyar'

- Chief Minister MK Stalin inaugurated a refurbished 'Bharathi Illam' in Varanasi.
- ✤ In the house, Bharathiyar lived in his age of 15 to 19 years.
- ♦ He also inaugurated a statue of Bharathiyar in the 'Bharathi Illam'.
- He had announced that the centenary of Bharathi's death anniversary would be observed as Mahakavi Day (11<sup>th</sup> September).
- ✤ The memorial apart from the statue has a small library.



### India Today's Best State

- ✤ For the 5th year in a row, Tamil Nadu has topped India Today's list of best performing states among India's largest states.
- At the end of every year, India Today publishes a ranking list on the performance of states.
- The agency lists the states as large and small under the categories of economy, medicine, agriculture, education, infrastructure, law and order, tourism and environment.





- ✤ In the list for 2022, Tamil Nadu is at the top with 1303.5 points.
- ✤ In the years 2018, 19, 20, 21, Tamil Nadu was at the top.
- ✤ It is followed by Himachal Pradesh and Kerala.
- ♦ Gujarat, Punjab and Maharashtra are the 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup> states.
- ✤ Gujarat is the first state in terms of economic development.
- Tamil Nadu, which was at the 4th position last year in that category, has moved up to the 2<sup>nd</sup> position this year.
- Tamil Nadu has moved up from 5th place to 3rd place last year in medicine and has also moved up from 7th place to 3rd place in health.
- ✤ It has improved from last year's 4th place to 3rd place in terms of best infrastructure.

### NATIONAL

#### Daily wage payments in India

- Daily wagers in Kerala earned way more than their counterparts in more industrialised states like Gujarat and Maharashtra.
- ◆ They also earned more than double (837.3) the national average of Rs 373.30.
- Construction workers' average daily wage in Kerala was more than three times of that in the lowest paying states Tripura and Madhya Pradesh.
- The other two top states are Jammu & Kashmir and Tamil Nadu, where the wages were Rs 519 and Rs 478, respectively.





- Kerala leads in highly paid agricultural workers with an average wage of Rs 726.8 per worker.
- In Jammu & Kashmir, farm workers get an average wage of Rs 524.6, Himachal Pradesh Rs 457.6, and Tamil Nadu Rs 445.6 per person.



### **PM VIKAS Scheme**



- Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Ko Kaam Karyakram (PMKKK) now named as Pradhan Mantri Virasat Ka Samvardhan (PM VIKAS) Scheme".
- ✤ It is a Central Sector Scheme under Ministry of Minority Affairs.
- It aims improve livelihoods of the minorities, particularly the artisan communities, using the components of skill development, education, women leadership & entrepreneurship.





The scheme combines the following five existing schemes: Seekho aur Kamao, USTTAD, Hamari Dharohar, Nai Roshni and Nai Manzil.

## Project BOLD



- Ministry of MSME, through Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC), has launched a unique pilot project named "Project BOLD".
- SOLD stands for Bamboo Oasis on Lands in Drought.
- The objective of this initiative is to scientifically harness the environmental benefits and economic potential of bamboo cultivation to protect environment and strengthen rural economy through various village industries.
- There is no budgetary provision for this project under KVIC.
- Bamboo saplings have been donated by an NGO that have been brought from Assam.
- No targets have been set for this project as it is a pilot project only.



### **Recognition for Namami Gange**





- The United Nations has recognised the Namami Gange initiative to rejuvenate India's sacred River Ganga as one of the top 10 World Restoration Flagships to revive the natural world.
- They were selected under the banner of the United Nations Decade on Ecosystem Restoration.
- It is a global movement coordinated by the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) and the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO).
- Namami Gange Programme was started in 2014 by central government after recognising the need to rejuvenate River Ganga.

## STATES

### All India Institute of Ayurveda

- The Prime Minister virtually opened the All-India Institute of Ayurveda in Goa, the National Institute of Unani Medicine in Ghaziabad, and the National Institute of Homeopathy in Delhi.
- ✤ He delivered a speech at the 9<sup>th</sup> World Ayurveda Congress (WAC) and Arogya Expo.

### 7<sup>th</sup> India Water Impact Summit

✤ 7<sup>th</sup> India Water Impact Summit is recently held in New Delhi.

### **International Universal Health Coverage Day - December 12**



- The day is marked to promote the importance of building robust, resilient, worldclass healthcare systems globally.
- It aims to raise awareness of the need for strong and resilient health systems and universal health coverage with multi-stakeholder partners.





✤ This year's theme is "Build the world we want: A healthy future for all".

#### **International Day of Neutrality - December 12**

- It is a day when people look at the possibility of a world free of armed and other types of conflicts.
- ✤ The day was adopted by the United Nations General Assembly in 2017.
- ♦ Its focus was on advocating and campaigning for intra-state peaceful relations.
- ♦ It was proposed by Turkmenistan and UNGA established this day in 2017.
- Switzerland serves as the perfect example of neutrality.



### **MISCELLANEOUS**

#### **New GI tags**







- Nine new items, including gamocha of Assam, Tandur red gram of Telangana, Raktsey Karpo apricot of Ladakh, and Alibag white onion of Maharashtra, have been given the coveted GI tag.
- ✤ Kerala has been awarded five GI tags for its agricultural produce.
- ♦ With this, the total number of GI tags in India comes to 432.
- The top five states holding the maximum number of GIs are Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh, Karnataka, and Kerala.
- ♦ Of these, 401 are Indian-origin products, 31 foreign-origin.
- Karnataka and Tamil Nadu are states with the highest number of GI tags, followed by Kerala (35), Uttar Pradesh (34), and Maharashtra (31).
