# **TNPSC BITS**

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched Atal Bhujal Yojana which is World Bank approved Central Sector Scheme of the Ministry of Jal Shakti.
  - The priority areas identified under the scheme are the following 7 states of Gujarat, Haryana, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh to conserve & improve ground water management.
- The Chief Minister of Delhi Arvind Kejriwal introduced a new policy to make Delhi the capital of Electric vehicles.
  - Under the policy, the government has planned to provide subsidies to electric vehicles.

# India's first Transgender University

- India's first university for transgender community will be opened at Kushinagar district in Uttar Pradesh.
- It is the first of its kind University in country, where transgender community members will be able to get education.
- The university is being built by Akhil Bhartiya Kinnar Siksha Seva Trust (All-India transgender education service trust).
- The university will facilitate its members to study right from class 1 to Post Graduate (PG) and even do research and get PhD degree.

## **Universal Postal Union**

- ✤ The Union Cabinet has given its approval to the ratification of the Tenth Additional Protocol to the Constitution of the Universal Postal Union (UPU).
- ◆ UPU also oversees the Telematics and Express Mail Service (EMS) cooperatives.
- The ratification will also enable the Department of Posts to bring out any administrative orders to implement the provisions of the UPU Convention in India.

#### About UPU

• Established by the Treaty of Bern of 1874.





- ✤ It is a specialized agency of the United Nations (UN).
- ✤ Headquarters are located in Bern, Switzerland.
- The UPU contains four bodies consisting of the Congress, the Council of Administration (CA), the Postal Operations Council (POC) and the International Bureau (IB).

#### **Good governance Index 2019**

- Latest edition of the 'Good Governance Index' has been launched on the occasion of 'Good Governance Day' – December 25, 2019.
- Good Governance Day is observed on the birth anniversary of former Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee (25th December).
- ✤ It was observed for the first time in 2014.

#### <u>GGI</u>

- Good Governance Index (GGI) is a tool to assess the status of governance and the impact of various interventions taken up by the State Government and UTs.
- ✤ GGI was released by the Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances under The Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions.
- Tamil Nadu has topped the Good Governance Index followed by Maharashtra, Karnataka, Chhattisgarh and Andhra Pradesh.
- ✤ The GGI takes into consideration 10 sectors.
- ✤ These ten Governance Sectors are measured on total 50 indicators.
- The states and UTs are divided into three groups: a). Big States, b). North-East & Hill States and c). UTs.

#### Sector-wise ranking:

- ✤ In the environment sector:
  - $\circ$   $\,$  The top three states are West Bengal, Kerala and Tamil Nadu.
  - o Jammu & Kashmir has topped among the North-East and Hill States.
- Judicial and public security ranking:
  - Tamil Nadu tops in the judicial and public security ranking. West Bengal is at the bottom of the chart here.
- Economic governance:
  - Karnataka is at the top under the economic governance category.
- ✤ Health:
  - Kerala is at the top in the public health sector followed by Tamil Nadu and Goa.
- Public Infrastructure and Utilities:
  - Tamil Nadu and Himachal Pradesh have topped their respective categories.
- Social Welfare and Development Sector:
  - Chhattisgarh has topped among big states.

#### **Creation of a Chief of Defence Staff**

- ✤ The Cabinet Committee on Security (CCS) chaired by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved the creation of a chief of defence staff (CDS).
- CDS will be the single-point military adviser to the government as suggested by the Kargil Review Committee in 1999.
- CDS oversees and coordinates the working of the three Services.
- CDS is described as 'first among equals' among service chiefs.
- ✤ A CDS would be a four-star general from either of the Indian Armed Forces- the Army, the Air Force or the Navy.



#### Composition of Cabinet Committee on Security.

- ✤ Minister of Defence

- ✤ Minister of Finance & Corporate Affairs.
- Minister of External Affairs.

#### **Digital Radio by 2024**

- The Central government is planning to revamp 'All India Radio' officially known as 'Akashvani' by introducing Digital Radio in India by 2024.
- This announcement was made by Union Information and Broadcasting (I&B) Minister Prakash Javadekar at the annual Akashvani Awards function held in New Delhi.







#### About All India Radio (AIR)

- ✤ AIR was established in 1930.
- ♦ It is officially known as Akashvani ("Voice from the Sky") since 1956.
- AIR is sister service of Prasar Bharati's Doordarshan elevision Network.
- Prasar Bharati is India's largest public broadcasting agency.

## **Digital Village Guruwara**

- Union Minister of Communication and IT Ravi Shankar Prasad inaugurated "Digital Village Guruwara".
- During the launch, it was announced that the Government has planned to offer free Wi-Fi services to all villages till March 2020.
- ◆ The free Wi-Fi services are being announced under Bharatnet project.

#### **Bharatnet Project**

- ✤ The initiative was launched in 2011.
- The aim is to increase their speed to around 2 to 20 Mbps in the future to all households in rural areas.
- ✤ The project is a National Optical Fibre Network project.
- It is seen as a major initiative in order to succeed Digital India.
- ✤ It is being implemented by the Ministry of Telecommunications.

# INTERNATIONAL

#### Pakistan - polio markers to Pakistan

- \* The Pakistan Government decided to import Polio markers from India recently.
- ✤ The Government had suspended the trade with New Delhi for months after abrogation of Article 370.





#### <u>Polio markers</u>

The polio markers are used to mark the fingers of the children after they are vaccinated with vaccines that are approved by the WHO.



#### About Polio

- ✤ The disease is caused by Poliovirus.
- In 1995, India launched Global Polio Eradication initiative of WHO that aims at 100% coverage.
- With the programme successfully implemented, India has completely eradicated Polio.
- The last case of Polio was reported in 2011 in India.
- ✤ There are three countries in the world where Polio is still endemic.
- ✤ It includes Pakistan, Nigeria and Afghanistan.

## **STATES**

#### "Run Through Files" Mechanism

- Haryana government has introduced a new provision of "Run Through Files" in the Centralised File Movement and Tracking Information System (CFMS).
- It would be personally monitored by Chief Minister of Haryana.
- ♦ A file shall be marked as Run Through Files only by the CM in the CFMS.

#### 120<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary of Shaheed Udham Singh

 Nation paid homage to great revolutionary, Shaheed Udham Singh, a well-known freedom fighter on his 120th birth anniversary being celebrated on 26 December 2019.





- ✤ He was born on this day in 1899 in Sangrur district of Punjab.
- ✤ He belonged to Ghadar party.
- He was present in Jallianwala Bagh, Amritsar on the fateful Baisakhi festival (festival of harvest) on 13 April 1919.
- General Dyer opened fire without any warning on unarmed crowd.
- ✤ Many people lost their lives in that horrific massacre.
- He was best known for avenging the Jallianwala Bagh massacre by assassinating Michael O' Dwyer in March 1940 and was hanged by British in London.
