TAMIL NADU

Local Body Elections – Tamilnadu

- ✤ The local body elections in Tamil Nadu was held on 27th and 30th December.
- These elections are conducted by Tamil Nadu State Election Commission under M.Palanisamy.
- ✤ Last election was on October, 2011.
- ✤ At present, out of 37 districts, only elections for rural local bodies in 27 districts was held.
- Elections will not be held for rural local bodies in the nine districts of Kancheepuram, Chengalpattu, Vellore, Tirupattur, Ranipet, Villupuram, Kallakurichi, Tirunelveli and Tenkasi.
- ✤ The rural voters in the state will elect four members.
- It was a direct Election for Village Panchayat Ward Members, Village Panchayat President, Panchayat Union Ward Members and District Panchayat Ward Members.
- The elections for panchayat ward member and president of the Panchayat will be on non-party basis.
- The elections for district panchayat ward member and panchayat union ward member will be on party basis.
- ✤ Indirect elections to the post of district panchayat and panchayat union chairpersons and vice-chairpersons will be held on January 11.

About Tamilnadu Local bodies

- Urban local bodies include 15 Municipal corporations, 148 Municipalities and 561 Town panchayats.
- Rural local bodies include 12,524 Village Panchayats, 388 Panchayat Unions, and 33 District Councils of India/District Panchayats.


Manual Scavenging Data

As per the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, as many as 282 people have died while cleaning sewers and septic tanks in the country between 2016 and November 2019.





- Among the States, Tamil Nadu has recorded 40 deaths, the highest in number, in these four years.
- This is followed by Haryana with 31 deaths, and Gujarat and Delhi with 30 deaths each.
- There has been rapid and unplanned urbanization in the above states.
- There are about 60,440 manual scavengers identified across the country, in 17 States.
- More than half of them about 35,472, have been identified from Uttar Pradesh alone.
- The Parliament had enacted the Prohibition of Employment as Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Act, 2013 which came in force from December 6, 2013.
- Sanitation is a State subject and the people for cleaning of sewers and septic tanks are employed by local bodies.
- Genrobotics is an Indian robotics company headquartered in Trivandrum, Kerala.
- ✤ In 2018, GenRobotics released the Bandicoot robot for cleaning sewers.



Eat Right Mela

The Union Minister of Health & Family Welfare Harsh Vardhan inaugurated the 2nd edition of Eat Right Mela in New Delhi.





- The Union Minister launched 'The PURPLE Book' a handbook on diets for diseases
- He also launched NetSCoFAN (Network for Scientific Co-operation for Food Safety and Applied Nutrition).
- ✤ Eat Right India movement was launched by the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) in 2018 under the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.

New Railway Recruitments

- The Railway board has now decided that all new recruits in railways will be inducted through UPSC (Union Public Service Commission) Civil Services Exams under five specialities.
- The Government has merged its eight cadres and departments services into one single entity the Indian Railway Management Service (IRMS).
- Moreover, the Chairman of Railway Board, who will also be CEO of national transporter, will be an officer of Indian Railway Service and not from any other service.
- ✤ Also, officers from Indian Railways who have experience of 35 yrs will only be posted as Chairman/CEO.

Railway Board Composition

- With new changes, the Chairman along with 4 members responsible for infrastructure, operations & business development, finance and rolling stock respectively will form Railway Board.
- ✤ The Board will also have some independent non-executive members.


INTERNATIONAL

Afghan presidential election

- Afghanistan's President Ashraf Ghani appeared to have won a second term as per the preliminary election result.
- He defeated the runner up Abdullah Abdullah.
- The current elections are the fourth Presidential poll since the Taliban's fall in 2001.







ECONOMY

Aadhar for PMVVY

- The Central government has made Aadhaar (the unique 12-digit biometric identity number) mandatory for subscribers of Pradhan Mantri Vaya Vandana Yojana (PMVVY).
- ✤ It is a pension scheme for senior citizens aged 60 or above.
- ◆ It is being implemented through Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC).
- PMVVY was announced in Union Budgets of 2017-18 and 2018-19, and in Budget.

NTPC in Solar Energy

- The State-owned power giant NTPC is planning to add 10 GW (gigawatt) of solar energy generation capacity by 2022.
- It assumes significance in view of country's ambitious target of having 175GW of clean energy by 2022.
- It will be funded mainly by green bonds.
- ✤ Green Bonds are offered for pure clean energy projects.





SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Ink to stop fake passports and currency notes

- The Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) and National Physical Laboratory (NPL) developed an ink to combat the problem of fake printing of passports and counterfeiting of currency notes.
- The ink was produced based on single excitable dual emissive luminescent pigment.
- It was developed based on the concept of fluorescence and phosphorescence phenomena.
- Currently, the currency notes display only one color with the emission of wavelength.
- However, in the ink developed by the scientists features changes in pigment color after the notes are printed.
- ✤ In ambient light the ink shows white color.
- When the ink is exposed to UV light, it turns red and when the UV source is switched OFF it turns green.

Fluorescence and Phosphorescence

- Both in phosphorescence and fluorescence the radiation is electromagnetic and is spontaneous.
- ✤ In case of fluorescence, the radiation stops after the source is switched off.
- On the other hand, in phosphorescence, the glow continues for few hours.

ENVIRONMENT

Gujarat locust invasion

- Gujarat and Rajasthan are under attack from hoppers new born locusts or known as tiddis locally.
- ✤ Banaskantha is the worst affected district in Gujarat.
- * The insects were flying from Pakistan Sindh province.
- ✤ The locusts emerged from Sudan and Eritrea in the coast of Red Sea.
- The insects fly in during the day and settle on the farms at night making it difficult to ward off the swarms.
- The Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) operates the DLIS (Desert Locust Information Service) headquartered in Rome, Italy.





- The invasion was also predicted by Locust Warning Organization (LWO) in Jodhpur.
- ✤ It operates under ICAR (Indian Council of Agricultural Research).
- The LWO monitors 2 lakh square kilometres of desert area in parts of Gujarat, Rajasthan and Haryana.

STATES

National Tribal Dance Festival

- The 2019 edition of National Tribal Dance Festival held in Raipur, the capital of Chhattisgarh.
- This is for the first time that National Tribal Dance Festival is being organized in Chhattisgarh.
- This Tribal Dance Festival is held annually during the month of December and is organized by Union Ministry of Tribal Affairs.
- The festival was inaugurated by Congress leader Rahul Gandhi.



Losar Festival

- The Union Territory of Ladakh celebrated Losar Festival to mark the Ladakhi or Tibetan New Year.
- Losar festival, which has its origin in 15th century, is also observed in all Himalayan states of country but in different times.
