TNPSC BITS

- ❖ Parliamentary Committee recently recommended increasing guaranteed days of work from 100 to 150 under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act.
 - o The Committee also asked the Rural Development Ministry to increase wage rates under the scheme.

NATIONAL

PMKSY till March 2026



- ❖ The 'Pradhan Mantri Kisan Sampada Yojana (PMKSY)' has been extended till March 2026.
- ❖ The scheme is administered by the Ministry of Food Processing Industries.
- ❖ The scheme aims for the overall growth and development of the food processing sector.
- ❖ In May 2017, the Central Government had launched SAMPADA (Scheme for Agro-Marine Processing and Development of Agro-Processing Clusters).
- ❖ The scheme was renamed PMKSY in August 2017.

SAMRIDH initiative

❖ Atal Innovation Mission, NITI Aayog, and the U.S. Agency for International Development have announced a new partnership under the Sustainable Access to Markets and Resources for Innovative Delivery of Healthcare (SAMRIDH) initiative.





❖ It aims to improve access to affordable and quality healthcare for vulnerable populations in tier-2 and tier-3 cities, and rural and tribal regions.



Amazon India signed MoU with Karnataka

- ❖ Amazon India signed an MoU with Karnataka State Rural Livelihood Promotion Society (KSRLPS) to support the growth of women entrepreneurs.
- ❖ Amazon India will launch 'Sanjeevini-KSRLPS' in its platform and extend the benefits of the 'Saheli' Program.
- ❖ The Saheli Programme offers training and skill development workshops to help women entrepreneurs.

White-cheeked macaque



- ❖ The Scientists recently found white-cheeked macaque in Arunachal Pradesh.
- ❖ The White Cheeked macaque was first discovered in southeastern Tibet.







- ❖ These macaques are different from the other macaques mainly because of their white cheeks.
- ❖ Also, they have a longer tail, long and thick hairs in the neck area.
- ❖ With the discovery of White Cheeked macaque, the total mammal count has increased to 438.

Women in Boardroom report

- ❖ The Women in the Boardroom report was recently released by Deloitte Global.
- This is the seventh edition of the report.
- ❖ According to the report, women hold only 17.1% of board seats in India.
- ❖ The report said that only 3.6% of the chairpersons are women in the country.
- ❖ Around 4.7% of the CEOs in India were women in 2021.



Parvatmala








- ❖ The National Ropeways Development Programme "Parvatmala" was announced recently.
- ❖ It was announced by the Union Finance Minister in the Union Budget for 2022-23 to improve connectivity in hilly areas.
- ❖ This will be a preferred ecologically sustainable alternative in place of conventional roads in difficult hilly areas.
- ❖ The idea is to improve connectivity and convenience for commuters, besides promoting tourism.
- ❖ This may also cover congested urban areas, where conventional mass transit systems are not feasible.
- ❖ The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MORTH) will have responsibility for its development.

PM CARES Fund



- ❖ The total corpus under the PM CARES Funds in 2020-21 was Rs 10,990.17 crore.
- ❖ It triples in FY 2020-21.
- ❖ While Rs 3,976.17 crore was spent from the fund in 2020-21, according to the latest audited statement of PM CARES Funds.
- ❖ As of March 31, 2021, the Fund had an unspent balance of Rs 7,013.99 crore.





❖ The government has used a part of the money to buy medical equipment, including ventilators, to boost the battle against the COVID-19 and has also provided relief to migrants.

Light House Tourism

- ❖ The Ministry of Ports, Shipping, and Waterways is to develop five lighthouses in the state of Odisha.
- * The Four districts have been identified.
- ❖ The Odisha Lighthouse tourism being developed is a part of Marine aids to Navigation 2021.
- Under the aid, the development was to be brought in the states of Gujarat, West Bengal, Maharashtra, Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Odisha and Andaman, and Nicobar Islands.
- ❖ The aid will help develop the lighthouses into tourism destinations.
- ❖ It will preserve the historical and traditional values of the lighthouses.

Life Insurance Corporation



- ❖ According to a brand valuation report by London-based Brand Finance, LIC is India's strongest and the largest brand in the country.
- ❖ With this, it also becomes the third-strongest insurance brand globally after Poste Italiane of Italy, and Mapfre of Spain at 1st and 2nd rank respectively.





❖ It is also the world's 10th most valuable insurance brand.

Asia's richest person

- ❖ Adani Group founder and billionaire Gautam Adani has become Asia's richest person.
- ❖ He ranks 10th among the wealthiest people in the world.
- ❖ This is as per Bloomberg Billionaires Index on February 8, 2022.

Redemption of Sovereign Gold Bonds

- ❖ The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has decided to prematurely redeem sovereign gold bonds (SGBs), which were issued in 2016 at a price of Rs 4,813 per unit of SGB.
- ❖ Under central government rules, premature redemption is permitted after the fifth year from the date of issue of such gold bonds on the date on which interest is payable.

Haryana Anti-conversion Bill

- ❖ The bill is being brought in the state of Haryana to prevent unlawful religious conversions.
- ❖ Haryana is a BJP ruled state.






❖ The other BJP ruled states that brought this bill were Uttar Pradesh, Himachal Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, and Karnataka.

Praveen Kumar Sobti

- ❖ Actor-athlete Praveen Kumar Sobti passed away.
- ❖ He was best known for playing Bheem in the TV series "Mahabharat" and for winning an Asian Games gold medal.
- ❖ He represented the country across various athletic events in hammer and discus throw.
- ❖ He won four medals at the Asian Games, including two gold medals in 1966 and 1970.
- ❖ Praveen Kumar Sobti also won a silver medal in Hammer Throw during the 1966 Commonwealth Games.




Indian documentary - Oscars 2022

- ❖ The Indian documentary 'Writing with Fire' has won an Oscar nomination in the Best Documentary Feature category
- ❖ Directed and produced by Indian filmmakers Rintu Thomas and Sushmit Ghosh, the film has made it to the 94th Academy Awards nominations.
- ❖ It is the first-ever Indian nominee in this category.
- ❖ The film documents the journey of women journalists.
