# **TNPSC BITS**

- The UN Capital Development Fund has appointed Indian-origin investment and development banker Preeti Sinha as its Executive Secretary.
- Tata Group firm Tata Electronics signed a MoU with the Tamil Nadu government to set up a facility for manufacturing mobile components.

# TAMIL NADU

#### New industrial and MSME policies

- ✤ The Tamil Nadu government on February 16 announced a new industrial policy.
- ✤ It aims to achieve four key objectives
  - o Attract investments worth over ₹10-lakh crore (\$135 billion) by 2025,
  - Achieve annual growth rate of 15 per cent in the manufacturing sector during the policy period,
  - Increase contribution of manufacturing sector to 30 per cent of the state's economy by 2030 from 25 per cent now and
  - Create over 20 lakh jobs by 2025.

#### **MSME Policy**

- The Chief Minister also unveiled a new MSME Policy to offer a vibrant ecosystem for MSMEs/Start-ups.
- ✤ It set a target to
  - o Attract new investments worth ₹2-lakh crore by 2025 and
  - Create additional employment opportunities for 20 lakh people.
- New MSMEs and start-ups will be exempted from approvals for establishment and operation for a period of three years based on self-certification.
- These unit shall have mandatory approval within a period of one year from the expiry of the 3-year period.
- The new policy has also enhanced ceiling for various subsidies provided to MSMEs.
- Also plug & play facilities, plots and sheds will be developed and made available to them on short term lease.





# NATIONAL

#### **Amendments for Privatization**

- The Amendments will be made in the following two acts in order to facilitate the privatisation of public sector banks (PSBs).
  - o Banking Companies (Acquisition and Transfer of Undertakings) Act1970 and,
  - Banking Companies (Acquisition and Transfer of Undertakings) Act, 1980.
- These two acts had facilitated for the nationalisation of banks in two phases.
- Now, in order to privatise the PSU Banks, provisions of these Acts have to be changed.

#### Pey Jal Survekshan

- The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has launched a Pilot Pey Jal Survekshan.
- This was launched under the Jal Jeevan Mission Urban (JJM-U).
- It will be conducted in cities to ensure the equitable distribution of water and reusing the wastewater.
- It will also help in mapping the water bodies.
- This sarvekshan will be launched across 10 cities including Badlapur, Agra, Churu, Bhubaneswar, Madurai, Kochi, Patiala, Surat, Rohtak, and Tumkur.

## **INTERNATIONAL**

#### Comprehensive economic cooperation and partnership agreement

- The Union Cabinet has approved the signing of a comprehensive economic cooperation and partnership agreement (CECPA) between India and Mauritius.
- It is a kind of a free trade agreement between India and Mauritius.
- ✤ It aims to liberalising the norms to boost a two-way commerce.

#### New Low-Carbon range of Concrete

- ✤ ACC Ready Mix Concrete has introduced its new low carbon range of concrete named ECOPact.
- It is a Green Concrete for high-performing, sustainable and circular construction.
- It was launched in Mumbai and Hyderabad in the first phase.





## **ECONOMY**

### India contribution to pulses

- India is contributing nearly 24 per cent of pulses to the global output.
- ✤ Also, India is the largest producer and consumer of pulses in the world.
- The country's pulses production has grown to 24 million tonnes (240 lakh tonne) from 14 million tonne (140 lakh tonne) in the last five-six years.

# SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

#### India's new instant messaging platform

- ✤ The National Informatics Centre (NIC) has launched an app called Sandes.
- ✤ This instant messaging platform is similar to WhatsApp.
- It can be used for any type of communications by anyone.
- It requires a mobile number or an email id to get registered with the app.

### TIGER X-1

- The Hyundai Motor Group have designed a walking car concept robot.
- ✤ It is being called as TIGER which stands for transforming intelligent ground excursion robot.
- The robot comprises of the wheels having capability to adapt to navigate in the challenging terrain.



- The ultimate mobility vehicle (UMV) uses its ability to walk when it gets stuck or when required to travel in the difficult terrain.
- ✤ It can connect with the drones.





- It can be used to carry goods for the delivery or aid packages in emergency situations.
- ✤ It can be used not only on Earth but on other planets as well.

## **ENVIRONMENT**

#### **1st Elevated Wildlife Corridor**

- The Delhi-Dehradun Expressway will have the country's first Elevated Wildlife Corridor.
- ◆ The project will have a six-lane elevated wildlife corridor spanning 12 kilometres.
- It is focused on preservation of the wildlife as the expressway alignment crosses wildlife areas.



#### **Nesting of Olive Ridley**

- ✤ The mass nesting of the Olive Ridley turtles has begun in Puducherry coastline.
- Puducherry coastline is among the migratory route to Odisha which are used by these turtles.
- ✤ The coastline is listed under Schedule I of the Wildlife Protection Act, 1972.
- These turtles commonly known as Pacific ridely sea turtle.
- ✤ Its IUCN status is vulnerable.
- ✤ It is also listed in Appendix I of CITES.







### **STATES**

#### 'Maa' canteens

- The West Bengal government launched a new scheme to provide a cheap cooked meal to the poor across the state.
- ✤ It is called "Maa" canteens.
- ✤ It provides state-subsidised daily meals at lunchtime to the poor.
