- ❖ The government of India will be promoting the 'Heal by India' initiative to improve India's educational institutions in the health sector.

Meri Policy Mere Hath



- ❖ The Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare will launch 'Meri Policy Mere Hath'.
- ❖ It is a doorstep distribution drive to deliver crop insurance policies to farmers under the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY).





- ❖ The campaign aims to ensure all farmers are aware of all information on their policies, land records, the process of claim, and grievance redressal under PMFBY.
- ❖ PMFBY aims to provide financial support to farmers suffering crop loss/damage arising out of natural calamities.
- ❖ PMFBY has completed 6 years of its implementation.
- ❖ It was launched by PM Modi on 18th February 2016 at Sehore, Madhya Pradesh.

- ❖ The Indian businesses rank 5th in their concern for climate change
- ❖ This is as per the 'Deloitte 2022 CxO Sustainability Report: The Disconnect Between Ambition and Impact'.

- ❖ The report examines business leaders' and companies' concerns and actions related to climate change and sustainability.

RUSA scheme



❖ The Ministry of Education approved the continuation of the 'Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) Scheme' till 2026.






- * RUSA is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS).
- ❖ It was launched to fund state government universities and colleges for achieving the aims of equity, excellence, and access.

Star Campaigners

- ❖ The Election Commission of India restored the maximum limit on the number of star campaigners a party can field in the ongoing Assembly elections in 5 States.
- ❖ In 2020, the commission had reduced the number of star campaigners for recognized national and State parties from 40 to 30 and unrecognized parties from 20 to 15.
- ❖ This reduction was done in order to prevent large crowds from gathering during campaigning.
- ❖ The commission said it had decided to restore the maximum limit of star campaigners, citing the fall in COVID-19 cases in the country.

RCS UDAN - First flight between Delhi-Khajuraho



❖ The Union Minister of Civil Aviation Jyotiraditya M.Scindia recently flagged off the first direct flight between Delhi and the heritage city of Khajuraho, Madhya Pradesh.





- ❖ With the start of this flight, a total of 405 routes would be operationalized under the UDAN-RCS scheme.
- ❖ under the RCS-UDAN 3.0, SpiceJet was awarded the Delhi-Khajuraho-Delhi route.
- ❖ SpiceJet is the largest regional carrier and strongest supporter of the scheme.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Recent Study on Pollination of Moths

- ❖ A study has revealed that moths are essential for pollination in northeast India's Himalayan environment.
- ❖ The study established that 91 species of moths are pollinators of 21 different species of plants in Arunachal Pradesh and Sikkim in the north-eastern Himalayas.
- ❖ Erebidae (tiger moths, erebid moths, lichen moths, etc) and Geometridae (geometer moths) were found to be the Himalayan region's most important families of moths for pollen transportation.
- ❖ The results are significant as most pollination research focused on daytime pollinators such as butterflies and bees.
- ❖ While the contribution of nocturnal pollinators received less scientific attention.

Khajuraho Dance Festival

- ❖ The Madhya Pradesh Kala Parishad organizes the Khajuraho Dance Festival.
- ❖ It is a one-week classical dance festival held annually beside the Khajuraho temples located in the Chhatarpur district of Madhya Pradesh.
- This year's Khajuraho Dance Festival is the 48th edition of this festival.






❖ In this festival, the Madhya Pradesh State Rupankar Kala Award and National Kalidas Award for dance will be presented to the various artists.

International Olympic Committee session 2023





- ❖ Mumbai, India will host the International Olympic Committee session in 2023.
- ❖ The IOC Session for 2023 will be held at Jio World Convention Centre, Mumbai.
- ❖ The last such session was hosted by India in the year 1983 in New Delhi.





- ❖ In 2022, the IOC session was held in Beijing, China.
- ❖ Nita Ambani is the representative of India on this committee.

Beijing Winter Olympic Games



- ❖ The 2022 Winter Olympics in Beijing, China, was held from 4 to 20 February 2022.
- ❖ The Games featured a record 109 events across 15 disciplines in 7 sports.
- ❖ The venues of the Games were distributed across three zones- Beijing, Yanqing, and Zhangjiakou.
- ❖ The Presidency of the Games was formally handed over to Milan and Cortina d'Ampezzo, in Italy, to host the 2026 Winter Olympics.
- Norway has topped the medal table for the second successive Winter Olympics, winning a total of 37 medals.
- ❖ This is a new record for the most amount of gold medals won at a single Winter Olympics.
- Germany finished second.
- China finished third.
- ❖ The Indian team at the game was represented by one male alpine skier, Arif Khan.
- ❖ India could not win any medal at the games.
