# **TNPSC BITS**

- United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) has launched a global campaign calling on people all over the world to cover the distance travelled by refugees each year.
  - This Campaign is known as 2 Billion Kilometres to Safety Campaign.
- ✤ The Reserve Bank of India extended the deadline for one-time restructuring of GST-registered MSME borrower account, by further one year to March 31, 2021.
  - The restructuring was to be implemented before March 31, 2020, as per the RBI's earlier guidelines.
- The Puducherry Legislative Assembly has passed a resolution against the Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA) 2019, the National Register of Citizens (NRC) and the National Population Register (NPR).
- Indian captain Virat Kohli has retained his top position in ICC Men's test ranking 2020.

# SPICe+

- The Ministry of Corporate Affairs deployed a new Web Form christened 'SPICe+', replacing the existing SPICe form.
- ◆ The initiative is a part of India's effort to improve Ease of Doing Business.
- SPICe+ would be an integrated Web Form.
- SPICe+ would offer 10 services by 3 Central Govt Ministries & Departments such as
  - Ministry of Corporate Affairs,
  - Ministry of Labour & Employment
  - Department of Revenue in the Ministry of Finance
  - One State Govt. (Maharashtra), thereby saving as many procedures, time and cost for Starting a Business in India.
- It would be applicable for all new company incorporations.





# SC verdict on demolishing the Construction around Hampi site

- The Supreme Court confirmed the Karnataka government authorities' decision to demolish the commercial buildings around the Hampi, a World Heritage site.
- The court concluded that the constructions were in violation of the Mysore Ancient and Historical Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains Act of 1961.
- The entire village of Virupapura Gaddi where the Heritage site is located, as a protected zone in a verdict of 1988.

#### <u>Hampi</u>

- It is the 14th century capital of one of the greatest empires of medieval India called the Vijayanagar Empire
- ✤ It is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- ◆ The Vitthala temple in Hampi is an excellent example of Vijayanagar style.
- \* 'Kishkindha Kaand' in Ramayana has special significance concerning Hampi.
- ✤ It is located near the Tungabhadra river.
- ✤ By 1500 CE, Hampi-Vijayanagara was the world's second-largest medieval-era city after Beijing, and probably India's richest at that time.

# Indian nationals living abroad

- ✤ There are over 1.36 crore Indian nationals living abroad, as per the latest data.
- ✤ The highest number of Indians abroad are living in the United Arab Emirates, where the 34,20,000 Indians comprise about one-fourth of all Indians abroad.

# **National Water Conference**

- The Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh Kamal Nath has inaugurated the National water conference at Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh.
- The conference is being held to finalize the guidelines of "Right to Water Act" or "Water Rights Act".
- Madhya Pradesh government has announced that it will implement the Right to water act soon, then it will be First state in the country to implement such an Act.

# Medical devices under Drugs and Cosmetics Act

- From 1st April 2020, all medical devices sold in the country would be treated as drugs and would be regulated under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act of 1940.
- This notification was announced by the Ministry of health and family welfare.
- The decision was taken after consultation with the Drugs Technical Advisory Board (DTAB).
- The Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 regulates the import, manufacture, and distribution of drugs in India.

#### **Top 500 Banking Brands 2020**

- ✤ As per the Banker's 'Top 500 Banking Brands 2020' report, India's IndusInd Bank has topped the list of 'Highest increase in brand value' among global banks.
- ✤ As a part of the report, the list "Top 50 By Total Brand Value by Country" has been topped by China, followed by United States, Canada, UK and Japan.
- ✤ India ranked 8<sup>th</sup> in this list in comparison to 10<sup>th</sup> place in 2019.

#### **Gagarin Research and Test Cosmonaut Training Centre**

- ✤ 4 Indian pilots chosen as candidate-astronauts for Gaganyaan mission began their training at the Gagarin Research and Test Cosmonaut Training Centre (GCTC).
- The Gagarin Research and Test Cosmonaut Training Centre (GCTC) is a training facility responsible for training cosmonauts for their space missions.
- ✤ It is located in Moscow, Russia.





 Gaganyaan is India's first Human Space Flight Programme to be launched by the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) by 2022.

# Ground water Act 2020

- The Uttar Pradesh state Cabinet chaired by its Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath has approved the Ground Water Act 2020.
- ✤ Its aim is to improve the falling level of ground water.
- ✤ The act makes the registration of submersible pumps mandatory.
- The farmers and domestic users need not pay fees to use the pumps.
- ◆ The Act makes rain water harvesting mandatory in all private schools, colleges.
- The Act has also made provision for punishment and fine against the person who contaminate ground water.

- He defeated multiple time world champion Pankaj Advani.

- ✤ In 2020, it was held in Guwahati, Assam.

# World Unani Day - February 11

- Every year, on February 11, the birth Anniversary of Hakim Ajmal Khan is celebrated as World Unani Day.
- ✤ He was an Indian Unani Physician and a social reformer.
- The main aim of this day is to spread awareness about Unani medical system, its preventive and curative philosophies.
- ✤ The AYUSH Ministry organized a function to commemorate the day and it was attended by Defence Minister Rajnath Singh.
- The Unani Medicinal system originated in Greece.
- It was introduced in India by the Arabs and Persians around the eleventh century.
- Grandfather of Hakim Ajmal Khan was Hakim Sharif Khan and he was a physician to Mughal Emperor Shah Alam II.



# **International Darwin Day - February 12**

- This day was celebrated to commemorate the birth anniversary of the father of evolutionary biology, Charles Darwin.
- ♦ He was born 12 February, 1809 at Shrewsbury, Shropshire, England.
- This day highlights Darwin's contribution to evolutionary and plant science.

# World Radio Day - February 13

- World Radio Day is celebrated on February 13 every year to raise awareness among the public and the media of the importance of radio.
- ✤ The theme of this year's World Radio Day 2020 is 'Radio and Diversity'.





- In 2011, UNESCO's General Conference, at its 36th session, proclaimed February 13 as World Radio Day.
