## TNPSC BITS

- ❖ The Bhabha Atomic Research Centre developed a new bullet proof jacket called Bhabha Kayach.
  - The jackets are to be used by the Central Industrial Security Force (CISF).
- ♦ Bottled drinking water has come under a price cap in Kerala, with the State fixing a ceiling of ₹13 per litre.
  - o Including bottled water in the list of essential commodities enables price control.
- ❖ The Government of India has launched a School Health Ambassador Programme under Ayushman Bharat-Health & Wellness Centres.
  - This initiative has been jointly rolled out by the Ministries of Health & Family Welfare and Human Resource Development.
- ❖ The Pravasi Bharatiya Kendra and the Foreign Service Institute are renamed as Sushma Swaraj Bhavan and Sushma Swaraj Institute of Foreign Service respectively.

# Digital literacy training by Facebook

- ❖ Facebook launched "We Think Digital" Programme to provide digital literacy training to 1 lakh women across 7 states, including Uttar Pradesh (UP), West Bengal & Bihar.
- ❖ It has been launched in partnership with National Commission for Women (NCW) and Cyber Peace Foundation.
- ❖ The training program aims to equip women with skills & provide equal access to economic opportunities, education & social connection through the internet.
- ❖ We Think Digital, Facebook's global digital literacy programme, was announced in 2019 during the 2nd edition of South Asia Safety Summit.

### Voting rights for prisoners

- ❖ The Delhi High Court has rejected a petition seeking voting rights for prisoners.
- ❖ The right to cast vote is neither a fundamental right nor a common law right and is only provided by a statute.





- ❖ Section 62(5) of the Representation of the People Act,1951 says that no person shall vote at any election if he is confined in a prison.
- ❖ In Europe, Switzerland, Finland, Norway, Denmark, Ireland, the Baltic States, and Spain already allow prisoner voting.

## BIMSTEC conference on drug trafficking

- ❖ India is hosting the first-ever BIMSTEC nations conference on combating drug trafficking in New Delhi.
- ❖ The conference has been organised by the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB).
- ❖ Aim of the conference is to provide an opportunity to all the member nations to deliberate contribution of preventing the increased threats posed by drug trafficking.

#### About Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB):

- ❖ NCB was constituted in 1986 under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act,1985.
- ❖ It is the apex coordinating agency under the Ministry of Home Affairs.

#### **About BIMSTEC:**

- ❖ The Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation (BIMSTEC) is an international organization founded in 1997.
- ❖ It is headquartered in Dhaka, Bangladesh.

### INS Jamuna - Hydrographic survey

- ❖ The Indian Naval Ship (INS) Jamuna has been deployed in the shores of Sri Lanka to carry out a joint Hydrographic survey.
- ❖ The Hydrographic survey is the measurement and study of features that affect maritime navigation.
- ❖ It also includes offshore oil exploration, dredging, oil drilling and other related activities.
- ❖ The standards and specifications to conduct the survey is released by International Hydrographic Organization (IHO).
- ❖ It was established in 1921.
- ❖ India is also a member in IHO.

#### Indian Naval Hydrographic Department

- ❖ The office of the department is located in Dehradun.
- Currently 8 Indian Naval Ships are deployed in the hydrographic surveys.





❖ It includes INS Nirupak, INS Jamuna, INS Investigator, INS Sutlej, INS Sandhayak, INS Darshak, INS Sarvekshak

## **Apiary on Wheels**

- Union minister of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises Nitin Gadkari has flagged off the Apiary on Wheels.
- ❖ Apiary on Wheels is a unique concept designed by the Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC).
- ❖ It aims to address the challenges faced by the beekeepers by easy upkeep and migration of Bee Boxes having live Bee colonies.
- ❖ This initiative was launched as a part of the National Honey Mission.

#### **About National Honey mission:**

- ❖ The Honey Mission was launched in 2017 by the Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC).
- ❖ Aim is to provide sustainable employment and income to rural and urban unemployed youth by conserving the honeybee habitat.

#### **About KVIC:**

- ❖ Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) is a statutory body.
- ❖ It was established under the Khadi and Village Industries Commission Act, 1956.
- ❖ It functions under the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises.

# International fund for Agricultural Development

- ❖ The International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) of the United Nations works to address hunger and poverty in developing countries.
- ❖ The 43rd session of the governing council of IFAD was held at Rome.
- ❖ It was announced at the council meet that with the current progress rate, it is not possible to achieve United Nations Sustainable Development Goal 2030.
- ❖ The Council met at the FAO (Food and Agriculture Organization) of United Nations in Rome.
- ❖ In 2015 the world leaders under the SDG aimed to eliminated hunger by 2030.
- ❖ IFAD was established at the World Food Conference in 1974.

## **Customary laws of Tribes - Tripura**

- ❖ The Tripura Tribal Areas Autonomous District Council (TTAADC) has passed resolutions to codify the customary laws of three tribal clans
  - o Mizo
  - o Kaipeng and
  - o Malsom.
- ❖ As per the Sixth Schedule, the four states viz. Assam, Meghalaya, Tripura and Mizoram contain the Tribal Areas which are technically different from the Scheduled Areas.
- ❖ Provision has been made for the creation of the District Councils and regional councils for the exercise of the certain legislative and judicial powers.
- ❖ Each district is an autonomous district and Governor can modify / divide the boundaries of the said Tribal areas by notification.

- ❖ The award was presented to the Indian Naval Station at Lonavala.






- ❖ The station was commissioned as HMIS (Her Majesty's Indian Ship) in 1945.

## National Women's Day- February 13

- ❖ To commemorate the birth anniversary of Sarojini Naidu (also named Nightingale of India), every year India observes February 13 as it's National Women's Day.
- ❖ In 1925 Sarojini Naidu became the president of the Indian National Congress.
- ❖ She served as the 1st Governor of United Provinces from 15 August 1947 2 March 1949.
- ❖ The International Women's Day is observed on 8th March annually.

### **Global Futures Report**

- \* Recently, the Global Futures report has been released jointly by
  - World Wide Fund for Nature,
  - o Global Trade Analysis Project and
  - o Natural Capital Project.





- ❖ According to the report, Nature has provided humanity with six ecosystem services namely
  - 1. Pollination of crops
  - 2. Protection of coasts from flooding and erosion
  - 3. Supply of water
  - 4. Timber production
  - 5. Marine fisheries and
  - 6. Carbon storage.
- ❖ The reduced supply of the six ecosystem services would lead to a 0.67% drop in the annual global GDP by 2050.
