- R.Dinesh, Executive Vice-Chairman of TVS Supply Chain Solutions, has been chosen as the Confederation of Indian Industry's President Designate for the years 2022–2023.
- Former NITI Aayog CEO Amitabh Kant is set to become the country's Sherpa for the G20 months ahead of India assuming the presidency.
- India observed one day State Mourning on July 9th, throughout the country as a mark of respect for former Prime Minister of Japan Shinzo Abe.
- The Indian boxer Alfiya Pathan and Gitika won gold medals in the Elorda Cup in Kazakhstan.

- ✤ M K Stalin inaugurated 20 arts and science colleges, through video conference.
- Now all the 20 colleges will function in temporary buildings.
- ✤ After the buildings are constructed, the colleges will be shifted to permanent buildings.
- The announcement to establish 20 arts and science colleges in the State was made in the State Assembly by Higher Education Minister K Ponmudy.





- ✤ According to the announcement made in 2021-22, the State government had planned to establish 10 colleges.
- Later in the announcement made in 2022-23, the State government had planned to establish 10 more arts and sciences colleges.

## India's oldest Royal Bengal Tiger



- Raja, the oldest living tiger in the world in captivity died recently.
- ✤ It died at the South Khairbari rescue centre in Kolkata.
- ✤ Raja was 25 years and 10 months old.
- ✤ As against the normal life span of 18 years for tigers, Raja lived for 25 years.


## Augmented reality screens







- The Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus in Mumbai has become the first railway station in India to be equipped with augmented reality screens.
- Passengers at the station can now meet animals, witness snowfall, magic tricks and visit around the world virtually.
- It is aimed at generating revenue for the railways and offering commuters some fun and infotainment.
- Augmented reality (AR) is an enhanced version of the real physical world.
- It is achieved through the use of digital visual elements, sound, or other sensory stimuli delivered via technology.


## World's most populous country in 2023

- India will surpass China as the world's most populous country in 2023, with each counting more than 1.4 billion residents this year.
- ◆ The world's population is estimated to reach 8 billion by November 15 this year.
- ✤ This could grow to 8.5 billion in 2030, and 10.4 billion in 2100.
- ✤ The world's population was growing at its slowest pace since 1950.
- $\clubsuit$  It has fallen below 1% in 2020.
- In 2021, the average fertility of the world's population stood at 2.3 births per woman over a lifetime.





- ✤ It has fallen from about 5 births in 1950.
- ✤ Global fertility is projected to decline further to 2.1 births per woman by 2050.



### **International Child Sexual Exploitation Initiative**

- India's CBI has joined the Interpol's International Child Sexual Exploitation (ICSE) initiative.
- With this, it gained access to its image and video database.
- ◆ ICSE is an image and video database are an intelligence and investigative tool.
- ✤ It allows specialized investigators to share data on cases of child sexual abuse.
- ✤ It analyses Child Sex Exploitation Material and make connections between victims, abusers and place.
- ✤ India is the 68th country to have access to this database and software.
- ✤ On average, the database of the ICSE initiative helps identify 7 child victims everyday globally.

## PERSONALITIES, AWARDS, AND EVENTS

#### **P** Gopinath Nair

- ✤ Freedom fighter P. Gopinathan Nair has passed away at the age of 100.
- He was known for following Gandhian ideology in his life and was honoured with the Padma award.
- ✤ He had participated in the freedom struggle.
- ✤ He had taken part in the Quit India Movement of 1942.
- He had worked alongside Vinoba Bhave to promote Bhoodan and Gramdan movements.
- The Government of India awarded him the fourth highest civilian honour of Padma Shri in 2016 for his contributions to society.



#### Wall of former chief economists

- India-born Gita Gopinath features on the 'wall of former chief economists' of the IMF.
- She became the first woman and second Indian to get this honour.
- The first Indian to achieve the honour was Raghuram Rajan.





- ♦ He was Chief Economist and Director of Research of IMF between 2003 and 2006.
- ✤ Gopinath was appointed as IMF Chief Economist in October 2018.
- Later promoted as the IMF's First Deputy Managing Director in December last year.

Japan's longest-serving prime minister



1977 Graduates from Seikei University

1979-1982 Works at Kobe Steel before turning to politics

**1993** First time elected to parliament

2006-2007 First term as prime minister Resigns citing health problems in part

2012-2020 Second term as PM Resigns over health problems

- Born September 21, 1954 in Tokyo
- Son of a former foreign minister and grandson of a former PM
- ✤ Japan's former prime minister Shinzo Abe was passed away recently.
- He was reported shot at while delivering a campaign speech.
- Shinzo Abe was the longest-serving Prime Minister in Japanese history.





♦ He was initially serving from 2006-2007 and then again from 2012 to 2020.

### **United Kingdom Prime Minister**

- United Kingdom Prime Minister, Boris Johnson has announced his resignation as Conservative Party.
- ✤ Johnson will remain in charge until the process of electing a new leader is completed.

## **World Masters Athletics Championships**








- The 94-year-old Bhagwani Devi Dagar from Haryana won a gold and 2 bronze for India at the World Masters Athletics championships 2022.

## **MISCELLANEOUS**

### **Oldest European human fossil**

- ✤ A jawbone fragment was discovered in northern Spain recently.
- This could be the oldest known fossil of a human ancestor found to date in Europe.
- This fossil was found at an archaeological site in the Atapuerca mountain range was about 1.4m years old.
- Until now, the oldest hominid fossil found in Europe was a jawbone found at the same site in 2007.
- ✤ It was determined to be 1.2m years old.
