### TNPSC BITS

- ❖ Google has relaunched its social networking platform Google+ as Google Currents.
- ❖ Maharashtra becomes the 1st State to use drones to inspect power lines and transmission towers.
- ❖ Harsimrat Kaur Badal, Union Minister of Food Processing Industries (MoFPI) inaugurated the first mega food park of Mizoram Zoram Mega Food Park.
- ❖ The Cricketer Dom Sibley of England has become the first person to violate the 'saliva ban' rule of International Cricket Council (ICC).
- ❖ The Jammu and Kashmir administration announced a life insurance cover of Rs 25 lakhs for all elected members of urban local bodies and Panchayati raj institutions.
- ❖ Ballon d'Or France Football award will not be awarded in 2020 for the first time in its history since 1956.

#### **TAMIL NADU**

#### Seshadri

- ❖ The Renowned Mathematician Conjeevaram Srirangachari (C.S.) Seshadri passed away in Chennai.
- ❖ He was the founder of the Chennai Mathematical Institute (CMI).
- ❖ He is known for his work in algebraic geometry.
- ❖ The Seshadri constant is named after him.

### **Banumathy Judge**

- ❖ Banumaty was the sixth woman judge in the Supreme Court.
- She was the first Women Judge of the Supreme Court from Tamilnadu.
- She was also the second-ever woman to be part of the Collegium.
- ❖ Justice Ruma Pal was the first woman to achieve that feat
- ❖ With the retirement of Justice Banumathi, the apex court will be left with two women judges Justices Indu Malhotra and Indira Banerjee.
- ❖ Never before in the history of the Supreme Court there had been three sitting lady judges.





#### **Backward Classes Commission of Tamilandu**

- ❖ The Tamil Nadu government has reconstituted its Backward Classes Commission.
- \* Retired Justice R Thanikachalam will head the Commission now.
- ❖ It is for examining requests of inclusion and complaints of over-inclusion or non-inclusion in the list of Other Backward Classes (OBC).

#### **Background**

- ❖ The first Backward Classes Commission in Tamil Nadu was formed on November 13, 1969 when the DMK was in power.
- It was known as Sattanathan Commission.
- ❖ Sattanathan Commission recommended the introduction of "Creamy Layer" among the OBC in the state.
- ❖ In pursuance of the direction of the Supreme Court in the Mandal Commission cases or Indira Sawhney cases in 1992, the State government had constituted a permanent Tamil Nadu Backward Classes Commission.
- ❖ It was formed under the Chairmanship of retired Justice K Shanmugam 1993.
- ❖ It is formed under Article 16(4) read with Article 340 of the Constitution of India.

# **NATIONAL**

## Railways in North East

- ❖ The Indian Railway Board has announced the connectivity of all capitals of North-Eastern states through rail network by 2023.
- ❖ As of today, the capitals of Assam, Tripura and Arunachal Pradesh are already connected.

#### The Consumer Protection Act, 2019

- ❖ It has come into force from July 20, 2020.
- ❖ This Act replaces Consumer Protection Act, 1986.
- ❖ It includes the establishment of the Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA).
- ❖ CCPA is to protect, promote, and enforce the rights of the consumers





- ❖ Under this Act the celebrities can be fined up to Rs 10 lakhs for promoting misleading products.
- ❖ Strict Actions shall be taken against advertisers for generating misleading content.
- ❖ The Act makes it mandatory for the E-Commerce entities to acknowledge the receipt of consumer complaints within 48 hours.

# **SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY**


#### **MediCAB**

- ❖ IIT-Madras supported start-up Modulus Housing has developed portable hospital unit.
- ❖ The Medicab is foldable and is composed of four zones such as a medical room, isolation room, a doctors's room and a twin bed ICU.
- ❖ India has 0.7 beds per 1000 persons.



## **Hope Probe mission**

❖ The United Arab Emirates (UAE) became the first West Asian and Arab nation to launch the first-ever Mars mission.







- ❖ Hope Probe mission was launched from Japan.
- ❖ It is expected to reach Mars's orbit by February 2021.
- ❖ It is designed to mark the 50th anniversary of the unification of the UAE, an alliance of seven emirates.

- Puducherry Chief Minister V. Narayanasamy presented the 2020-21 Budget for the Union Territory without the approval of Lt Governor Kiran Bedi and her customary address to the House.
- ❖ He announced a free breakfast scheme for poor students in government schools of Puducherry in the name of late Chief Minister and DMK President M. Karunanidhi.

#### 2020 Nelson Mandela Prize

- ❖ The President of United Nations General Assembly Tijjani Muhammad-Bande announced that Marianna Vardinoyannis, of Greece, and Doctor Morissana Kouyaté, of Guinea will receive the 2020 Nelson Mandela Prize.
- ❖ The United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) established the award in June 2014.
- ❖ It will be awarded every 5 years, to honour Nelson Mandela's life and legacy of political and social transformation.

- ❖ Formula One Champion Mercedes Lewis Hamilton (British) won the Hungarian Grand Prix 2020.
- ❖ With this victory he equalled Michael Schumacher's single-venue record, ie., winning a grand prix eight times.






## **IMPORTANT DAYS**
