TNPSC BITS

- The United Nations proclaimed June 1 to be the Global Day of Parents.
 - The UN General Assembly declared Global Day of Parents on June 1 since 2012.
- ✤ "My Life My Yoga" contest is a Video Blogging Contest.
 - $\circ~$ It is a joint effort by the Ministry of AYUSH and the Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR).
- COVID-19 is the first pan India biological disaster being handled by the legal and constitutional institutions of the country.
 - Under the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the States and district authorities can frame their own rules on the basis of broad guidelines issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs.
- The Ministry of Electronics and IT and IT Industry body NASSCOM has jointly developed India's national Artificial Intelligence Portal.
 - The portal aims to aid the development of solutions based on Artificial Intelligence (AI).
- The Prime Minister's Office (PMO) is stating that PM CARES FUNDS is not a 'public authority' under the Right to Information Act, 2005.
 - $\circ~$ So it has refused to divulge any information about that fund under the RTI Act.

Black Lives Movement

- The Black Lives Movement is an African-American movement that campaigns against violence and racism towards black people.
- The movement campaigns against killings of black people, police brutality, racial profiling and racial inequality in the United States.
- ✤ The movement began in 2013.
- ✤ The movement spread to Canada, Australia and Germany as well.
- The United States is facing nationwide protests over the death of an African American George Floyd.

MSP rate for Kharif crops

- The Union Cabinet approved an increase in Minimum Support Price (MSP) for 14 Kharif crops.
- ✤ It was based on the recommendation of the Commission for Agricultural Costs and Prices (CACP).

PM SwaNidhi scheme

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Scorpion Fish - Scorpaenospsis neglecta

- The Researchers at the Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute have found a rare fish from the Gulf of Mannar.
- The specimen was deposited at the National Marine Biodiversity Museum of Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI).
- It is a leading tropical marine fisheries research institute in the world, headquartered in Kochi, Kerala.
- ✤ The fish is locally called Scorpion Fish for its venomous tail.
- \clubsuit This is the first time, the species has been found alive in the Indian waters.



2019 LD2

- ✤ Astronauts have recently discovered a rare space object.
- ✤ The object looks like both asteroid and comet.
- The new space object is called Active Asteroid.
- ✤ The asteroid has been named 2019 LD2.
- It has an orbit like an asteroid and a tail like a comet.
- The 2019 LD2 shares the orbit of Jupiter and is a part of the asteroid swarm called Jupiter Trojans.
- ✤ The space object found is the first that emits gas just like a comet.
- The asteroid was discovered by the Asteroid Terrestrial-impact Last Alert System (ATLAS).





SpaceX

- The SpaceX has become the first private rocket company to send astronauts to space.
- The SpaceX astronaut mission completed its first journey as the astronauts in the Crew Dragon Capsule entered the International Space Station (ISS).
- The SpaceX Company sent Doug Hurley and Bob Behnken to space through a Falcon 9 rocket.
- ✤ The mission will end the reliance of NASA on Russian space rockets.
- SpaceX was the first private company in the world to return rockets back to the earth.
- The astronauts have named the commercial spacecraft after one of the retired winged orbiters, 'Endeavour'.
- ✤ The International Space Station (ISS) is a modular space station (habitable artificial satellite) in low Earth orbit.
- It is the largest artificial object in space and the largest satellite in low Earth orbit, regularly visible to the naked eye from Earth's surface.
- The ISS circles the Earth in roughly 93 minutes, completing 15.5 orbits per day.
- ✤ The ISS programme is a multi-national collaborative project between five participating space agencies:
 - o NASA (United States),
 - o Roscosmos (Russia),
 - o JAXA (Japan),
 - ESA (Europe),
 - o CSA (Canada).

- ✤ It is celebrated by the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations.
- ✤ Theme: The 20th Anniversary of World Milk Day
- India is the largest producer of milk.
- India celebrates National Milk Day on November 26.
- ✤ It is the birth anniversary of Verghese Kurien.
- He is known as Father of Milk Revolution in India.
- ✤ It was his idea to launch Operation Flood in India in 1970.
