TNPSC BITS

- ❖ Indian Grand Prix 4 will be held on June 21 at the National Institute of Sports in Patiala.
 - o India's star sprinters Dutee Chand & Hima Das are expected to participate in the fourth Indian GP of 2021.
- ❖ According to World Giving Index 2021 report, India is 14th most charitable country across the world.
 - o This report is released by Charities Aid Foundation.
- ❖ IIT, Ropar has developed a device called 'Jivan Vayu' as a substitute for CPAP (Continuous positive airway pressure) machine.
 - o This device functions even without electricity.

Global Skills Report 2021

- ❖ As per the 'Global Skills Report 2021', India has been ranked 67th overall globally.
- ❖ The report is released by Coursera.
- ❖ Indian learners have high proficiency in digital skills like Cloud Computing (83%) and Machine Learning (52%) & 54% in Mathematical skills.
- ❖ Improvement is needed in digital skills because in Data Analysis (25%) and Statistical programming (15%) skills.

- ❖ This conference was convened by President of 75th session of General Assembly, Volkan Bozkir.
- ❖ Prime Minister Narendra Modi addressed the high-level virtual conference on desertification, land degradation and drought.
- ❖ PM Modi was President of 14th session of Conference of the Parties to United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification (UNCCD).
- ❖ India aims to restore 26 million hectares of degraded land by 2030.

DBS Bank - World's Best Bank 2021

- ❖ DBS Bank has been named by Forbes in their list of World's Best Banks 2021.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

CHIME telescope results

- ❖ Scientists with the CHIME Collaboration have assembled the largest collection of fast radio bursts (FRBs) in the telescope's first FRB catalogue.
- ❖ CHIME is Canadian Hydrogen Intensity Mapping Experiment.
- ❖ It is a large stationary radio telescope in British Columbia, Canada.
- ❖ Sight of an FRB is considered a rare thing in the field of radio astronomy.
- ❖ Radio astronomers had only caught sight of around 140 bursts in their scopes since the first FRB was spotted in 2007.
- ❖ FRBs are oddly bright flashes of light which blaze for a few milliseconds before vanishing without a trace.
- ❖ They are registered in the radio band of the electromagnetic spectrum.

WISA Woodsat

- ❖ European Space Agency (ESA) will launch world's first wooden satellite in the Earth's orbit.
- It is called as WISA Woodsat.
- ❖ It will be launched to test the applicability of wooden materials such as plywood in spacecraft structures.
- ❖ Wooden satellite will be launched with a Rocket Lab Electron rocket.
- ❖ It will be launched from Mahia Peninsula launch complex in New Zealand.
- ❖ Satellite has been designed and built in Finland.

Shailesh Govind Ganpule

- ❖ Shailesh Govind Ganpule was conferred the award with the 'NSG Counter-IED and Counter-Terrorism Innovator Award 2021'
- ❖ He was conferred for developing a "blast-resistant" helmet.
- ❖ He is an assistant professor at the mechanical and industrial engineering department (MIED), IIT Roorkee.
- ❖ This was the second edition of the annual award by NSG.
- ❖ The Ceremony held at the National Security Guard (NSG) campus in Maneswar, near Gurgaon.



SPORTS

French Open 2021

- ❖ The 125th Edition of French Open 2021 took place from at Stade Roland Garros in Paris, France.
- ❖ It is the 2nd Grand Slam of 2021.
- ❖ It is a Clay-Court.
- ❖ It is organized by the International Tennis Federation.
- ❖ Novak Djokovic (Serbia) defeated Stefanos Tsitsipas (Greece) to win the Men's Singles Title.
- ❖ Barbora Krejcikova (Czech Republic) defeated Anastasia Pavylyunchenkova (Russia) to win the Women's Singles Title.





- ❖ It is her maiden Grand Slam Title.
- ❖ Barbora along with her partner Katerlina Siniakova (Czech Republic) defeated Bethanie Mattek-Sands (USA) & Iga Swiatek (Poland) to win the Women's Doubles Title.
- ❖ Barbora Krejcikova becomes first player to win women's singles and doubles title in French Open since 2000.
- ❖ French pair of Pierre-Huues Herbert & Nicola Mahut became the 1st French pair to win the men's doubles title at the French Open 2021.

ICC Hall of Fame



- ❖ The ICC has inducted 10 icons of the game, including India's Vinoo Mankad, into its illustrious Hall of Fame.
- * Two players each from five eras have been chosen.
- ❖ The announcement has been coincided with the inaugural World Test Championship final.
- ❖ The match is to be played between India and New Zealand from June 18 in Southampton at England.

Aubrey Faulkner of South Africa and Monty Noble of Australia for the early era (pre-1918), Sir Learie Constantine of West Indies and Stan McCabe of Australia for the interwar Era (1918-1945), Ted Dexter of England and Vinoo Mankad of India for the postwar Era (1946-1970).

Desmond Haynes of the West Indies and Bob Willis of England were inducted from the ODI era

Andy Flower of Zimbabwe and Kumar Sangakkara of Sri Lanka were from the modern era (1996-2016).
