## TNPSC BITS

- ❖ Self-Injury Awareness Day is observed globally on March 1st.
  - o This is to raise awareness about self-harming behaviours such as "cutting" and other intentional methods of self-injury.
- ❖ The President of India, Ram Nath Kovind has inaugurated a newly developed 'Arogya Vanam' at the Rashtrapati Bhavan in New Delhi.
  - The objective of this Arogya Vanam is to promote the importance of Ayurvedic plants and their effects on the human body.
- ❖ The Cabinet, chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, made the decision to approve 20% FDI via the automatic method in the Life Insurance Corporation.
  - The government hopes that doing so, will make it easier for India's largest insurer to be disinvested.

## **TAMIL NADU**

### Ambulance for street animals



- ❖ India's first ambulance for street animals has been launched in Chennai, Tamil Nadu.
- ❖ It has been started by the Blue Cross of India in collaboration with the international animal welfare organization "Four Paw".





❖ The Stray Animal Care programme will be a "hospital on wheels" with an onboard veterinarian to provide on-site treatment to injured and sick street animals.

### **National Gender Index**



- ❖ The NITI Aayog is in the process to develop a National Gender Index.
- ❖ The objective of the National Gender Index is to measure the progress and identify the persisting gaps in gender equality to make informed policy decisions.
- ❖ It will serve as a tool to map the progress of India's States and UTs on defined gender metrics and build the foundation for positive change.
- ❖ The information was released in the Annual Report 2021-22 of NITI Aayog.

- ❖ The Women and Child Development Ministry celebrates the International Women's Day week from the 1st of March as an Iconic Week as a part of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav.
- ❖ This will mark an occasion to celebrate the progress made towards achieving gender equity and women's empowerment.
- On 3rd March 2022, the theme for the celebration was 'Women of Tomorrow'.
- ❖ On 8th March, Nari Shakti Puraskaar will be given.
- ❖ And the International Women's Day Conference for Women Police Delegates from all States and UTs will also be organized.

### Sloth bear

- ❖ The sloth bear, tiger, and dhole are among 36 apex predators worldwide affected the most due to road construction.
- ❖ The sloth bear was the most affected predator as its habitat was in the Indian subcontinent.
- ❖ From 2012 to 2017, 15 sloth bear roadkills were recorded in India.
- ❖ The sloth bear is followed by the dhole or Asiatic Wild Dog, the tiger, Asiatic black bear, clouded leopard, sun bear, and Sunda clouded leopard.
- ❖ Eight of the top 10 apex predators most affected due to roads running through their habitat are from Asia.



# PERSONALITIES, AWARDS, AND EVENTS


### **Book by Deepam Chatterjee**

- ❖ He is only the second Bangladeshi to be chosen to such a high position in the bank's history.




### **Boltzmann Medal**

- ❖ The Commission on Statistical Physics of the International Union of Pure and Applied Physics (IUPAP) presents this medal once in three years for contributions in the field of statistical physics.
- ❖ The medal presentation ceremony will be held during the StatPhys28 conference scheduled to be held in Tokyo in August this year.
- ❖ He shares the medal with John J Hoefield of Princeton University.
- ❖ Prof Dhar is presently the emeritus faculty at the Indian Institute of Science Education and Research (IISER), Pune.

❖ Dabang Delhi KC defeated Patna Pirates in the final of the Pro Kabaddi League Season 8 in Bengaluru, Karnataka.






- ❖ Dabang Delhi beat three-time champion Patna Pirates.

# World Wildlife Day - March 03




- ❖ The day is observed to raise awareness about the world's wild fauna and flora.
