- ❖ The inauguration was done virtually via video conferencing.






- ❖ The purpose of this new gallery is to provide a holistic view of the events that led up to 1947.

- ❖ After the exams are conducted, the NTA will prepare a merit list based on which admissions will be given.






❖ There will be no common counseling sessions.

- ❖ The theme is chosen for ANCIPS 2022 is 'Bridging minds ... Connecting generations'.


The Sujalam 2.0 campaign

- ❖ This campaign has been launched for greywater management.






- ❖ Under this campaign, there are plans to mobilize communities such as schools, panchayats, and anganwadis to help in greywater management.

- ❖ This trial will be monitored by Dr. Daniel Erick Furst who is a world-renowned rheumatologist from the University of California.






PERSONALITIES, AWARDS, AND EVENTS

Abel Prize for 2022

- ❖ The winner of the Abel Prize 2022 is Dennis Parnell Sullivan, an American mathematician.
- ❖ He received this award for his contributions to topology, especially its geometric, algebraic, and dynamical aspects.



Book by Richa Mishra







- ❖ A book titled "Unfilled Barrels: India's oil story" authored by Richa Mishra will be released soon.
- * Richa Mishra is a journalist with The Hindu BusinessLine.
- ❖ The book highlights the key role played by Keshav Dev Malaviya, who was the petroleum minister in the 1970s with a degree in oil technology.
- ❖ It also highlights the emergence of other stakeholders from public sector enterprises, including ONGC, to the fiercely competitive private players like Cairn Energy, and Mukesh Ambani's RIL.

Devendra Jhajharia

- ❖ Devendra Jhajharia became the first para-athlete to receive the Padma Bhushan award.
- ❖ He has won many Paralympic medals, including gold at the 2004 in Athens and 2016 Rio Games, and a silver medal at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics.
- ❖ Avani Lekhara (para-shooter) was also awarded the Padma Shri award in the Sports category.
- ❖ She is the first Indian woman to win two Paralympic medals in the same Games, as well as the first Indian woman to earn Paralympic gold.

FIFA World Cup and BYJU'S

❖ Edu-tech company BYJU'S has made history by becoming the first Indian company to ally with the FIFA World Cup in Qatar this year.





❖ The move represents a big step by FIFA to reach more participants and fans in the populous subcontinent and will see the two organizations partner together to enact positive societal change.



IPL 2022 season



- ❖ MS Dhoni has handed over the captaincy of Chennai Super Kings to all-rounder Ravindra Jadeja ahead of the start of the IPL 2022 season.
- ❖ Under Dhoni's captaincy, CSK won the IPL trophy four times in 2021, 2018, 2011, and 2010.
- ❖ CSK also won two Champions League T20 trophies and reached the IPL finals a total of 9 times.

IMPORTANT DAYS

International Day of the Unborn Child - March 25

- ❖ The International Day of the Unborn Child is an annual commemoration of unborn fetuses, observed as a day of opposition to abortion.
- It was established by Pope John Paul II.





❖ In 1993, El Salvador became the first nation to officially celebrate what was called a Day of the Right to Be Born.



International Day of Remembrance of the Victims of Slavery and the Transatlantic Slave Trade - March 25

- ❖ It is marked every year to raise awareness about the dangers of racism and prejudice.
- ❖ 2022 Theme: "Stories of Courage: Resistance to Slavery and Unity against Racism".
