TNPSC BITS

- India's P.V. Sindhu won the women's singles title at the Swiss Open Super 300 badminton tournament.
 - She defeated Busanan Ongbamrungphan of Thailand to claim the title.
- India's Defence Research and Development Organisation has successfully carried out the test firing of the Medium Range Surface to Air Missile air defense system.
 - The test fire was carried out off the coast of Odisha's Balasore.
- The Governments of Delhi, Haryana, Rajasthan, and Uttar Pradesh have signed Combined Reciprocal Common Transport Agreements.
 - \circ $\,$ This helps in unrestricted movement of buses, taxis, and auto-rickshaws.

TAMIL NADU

Foreign direct investment - Tamil Nadu

- ◆ The foreign direct investment (FDI) in Tamil Nadu grew about 41.5% to ₹17,696 crores (about \$2.4 billion) in April-December 2021.
- This has improved from ₹12,504 crores (about \$1.7 billion) in the same period of 2020 (when the first wave of COVID-19 started).
- ♦ Of this, 53% or ₹9,332 crores came in the October-December 2021, the third quarter of the financial year 2021-22.
- According to data from the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade, under the Union Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Tamil Nadu's share in the total FDI in the country increased to 5% from 4%.
- Tamil Nadu has the fifth-highest share, after Maharashtra, Karnataka, Gujarat, and Delhi.
- April-September 2021, the State attracted ₹8,364 crores.

NATIONAL

Resilient Crops

Scientists at the Indian Agricultural Research Institute, in collaboration with several other research institutions, have identified about 15,000 selected germplasms of rice and wheat.





- These are identified for developing varieties that are tolerant to floods, droughts, heatwaves, and diseases to mitigate the adverse impact of climate change on food production.
- ✤ Agricultural scientists have sourced rice and wheat genetic resources from a gene bank run by the National Bureau of Plant Genetic Resources (NBPGR) in Delhi.

International Geological Congress

- The 36th International Geological Congress (IGC) was held in New Delhi with the topic 'Geosciences: The Basic Science for a Sustainable Future'.
- The 36th International Geophysical Congress is a collaboration between the Ministries of Mines and Earth Sciences, the Indian National Science Academy, and the Science Academies of Bangladesh, Nepal, and Sri Lanka.
- The event would provide a one-of-a-kind forum for Geoscience knowledge and experience sharing, as well as professional networking.
- India held the 22nd session of the IGC, which was the first IGC on Asian land, 58 years ago in 1964.




Rashtriya Sanskriti Mahotsav 2022

- The first Rashtriya Sanskriti Mahotsav was held in 2015.



Price hike of 800 essential drugs



The National Pharmaceutical Pricing Authority has announced a hike in prices of around 800 essential drugs from 1 April.





- These drugs are included in the National Essential List of Medicine.
- The rise in drug prices works out at around 10.76% based on the Wholesale Price Index.

C40 Cities Network



URBAN NATURE DECLARATION

- Maharashtra has launched the Mumbai Climate Action Plan in partnership with the C40 Cities Network.
- Mumbai Climate Action Plan is essentially designed to reduce emissions and meet the climate goals outlined in the Paris Agreement to limit global warming to 1.5 °C.
- Found in 2005, the C40 Cities Climate Leadership Group is an association of 97 cities from around the world C40.
- It is a global network of mayors aimed at fighting climate change and reducing greenhouse gas emissions, thus mitigating climate risks.
- The goal of the C40's initiative is to reduce the emissions of its member cities to half within a decade.
- Five Indian cities are currently a part of the C40 network.
- These are Delhi, Kolkata, Chennai, Bengaluru, and Mumbai.


UNEP 'Annual Frontier Report, 2022' - Highlights
