TNPSC BITS

- ❖ The book “Mahatma: A Great Communicator”, written by Dhiraj Kakadia, Additional Director General of Akashvani, was released in New Delhi.
- ❖ The Echinus Geyser in Yellowstone National Park, United States, erupted again after six years of inactivity.
 - It is the world’s largest acidic geyser, located in the Norris Geyser Basin, the hottest geothermal area in Yellowstone.
- ❖ Janaushadhi Saptah 2026 is being celebrated from 1–5 March 2026 with health camps held across India by the Pharmaceuticals and Medical Devices Bureau of India (PMBI).
- ❖ The United States Court of International Trade ordered the government to refund about \$130 billion in tariffs collected illegally during the administration of Donald Trump, following a ruling by the Supreme Court of the United States.
- ❖ Mobile World Congress 2026, the world’s largest event for the mobile and technology industry, is being held in Barcelona, Spain.
 - The theme of the year 2026 is “The IQ Era.”
- ❖ The Karnataka government announced a ban on social media access for children under 16 years in the 2026–27 state budget.
 - The restriction will apply to platforms such as Facebook, Instagram, Twitter and TikTok.
- ❖ International Women's Day 2026 is observed worldwide on 8 March 2026 to promote gender equality and women’s empowerment around the world.
 - The theme for the year 2026 is “Rights. Justice. Action. For ALL Women and Girls”.

TAMIL NADU NEWS

TWEES - Scheme

- ❖ Tamil Nadu Women Entrepreneur Empowerment Scheme (TWEES) was launched by CM of Tamil Nadu to promote women-led businesses.
- ❖ The scheme aims to encourage 1 lakh women to become entrepreneurs over the next five years.
- ❖ It is implemented by the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) Department of Tamil Nadu.

- ❖ The programme will provide training, financial assistance and institutional support to women entrepreneurs.
- ❖ The scheme aims to increase women's participation in the MSME sector and create more employment opportunities in the state.

Rules for Cosmetology Clinics

The Government of Tamil Nadu has recently issued a **Government Order (GO)** regulating aesthetic and hair transplantation clinics, explicitly mandating that such establishments must be operated by a **qualified Dermatologist or Plastic Surgeon.**

- ❖ The Tamil Nadu government issued a Government Order (G.O.) to regulate cosmetology, aesthetics and hair transplant clinics in the state.
- ❖ All such clinics must register under the Tamil Nadu Clinical Establishments Act for their operation.

- ❖ The order is based on guidelines issued by the National Medical Commission (NMC).
- ❖ Hair transplant and aesthetic procedures can be performed only by qualified dermatologists or plastic surgeons.
- ❖ The Tamil Nadu Private Clinical Establishments (Regulation) Act, 1997 regulates private clinical establishments in the state.

NATIONAL NEWS

Census 2027 Mascots



- ❖ The Government of India launched the mascots Pragati and Vikas for Census 2027 to increase public awareness and participation.
- ❖ Pragati represents a female enumerator, and Vikas represents a male enumerator.
- ❖ The mascots symbolise equal participation of women and men in nation-building.
- ❖ Census 2027 will be India's first fully digital census using mobile applications and digital platforms for data collection.
- ❖ The census will be conducted in two phases: HLO (House listing and Housing Census) and PE (Population Enumeration).

NITI Aayog–UNICEF Partnership

- ❖ NITI Aayog and UNICEF India signed a Statement of Intent (SOI) to improve nutrition and health outcomes in Aspirational Districts and Aspirational Blocks.

- ❖ The partnership focuses on maternal and child nutrition services in underserved regions.
- ❖ IMPAct4Nutrition (I4N) platform will mobilize Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) funds for nutrition programmes.
- ❖ The initiative aims to improve the implementation and monitoring of nutrition schemes in Aspirational Districts.



INTERNATIONAL NEWS

Restriction of Social Media for Children – Indonesia



- ❖ Indonesia announced restrictions on social media access for children under 16 years through a new regulation.
- ❖ The rule was issued to reduce cyberbullying, addiction and online risks for minors.



- ❖ Accounts of children under 16 on platforms such as TikTok, Facebook, Instagram and Roblox will be gradually deactivated starting March 28, 2026.
- ❖ Countries like Australia and Spain have also introduced similar restrictions for minors.
- ❖ Malaysia has announced a social media ban for users under 16 from 2026.

ECONOMY NEWS

Sudarshan AI System

- ❖ SEBI used the Sudarshan Artificial Intelligence (AI) system to remove over 1.2 lakh misleading posts by financial influencers on social media.
- ❖ Sudarshan AI System is an Artificial Intelligence (AI) based decision-support system used in the banking and financial sector in India.
- ❖ It uses machine learning and data analytics to process large financial datasets and generate predictive insights.
- ❖ The system helps banks in credit risk assessment, loan appraisal and early warning detection of stressed assets.
- ❖ It is also used for fraud detection, transaction monitoring and regulatory compliance in financial institutions.

SUDARSHAN

SEBI has aggressively escalated its digital surveillance, deploying an advanced in-house AI tool named **Sudarshan** to crack down on market misinformation.

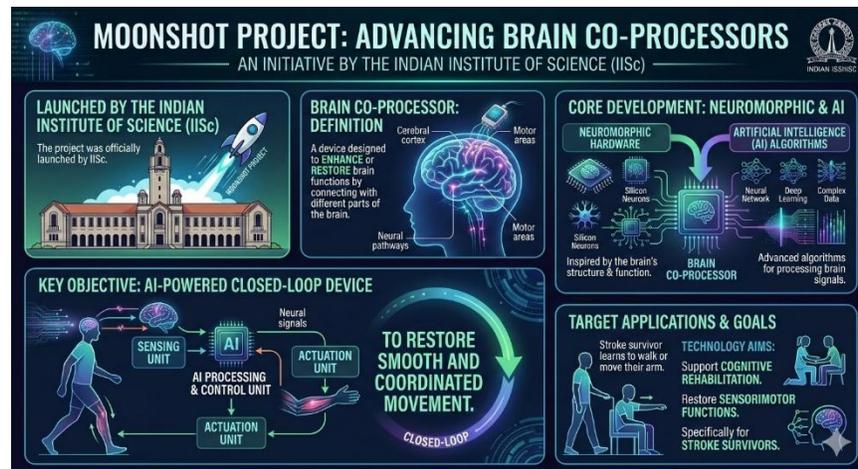
The regulator has successfully taken down over **1.2 lakh misleading posts** by unregistered finfluencers. The system actively tracks multilingual audio and video content to protect retail investors from illegal advisory and high-risk options traps.

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY NEWS

Moonshot Project

- ❖ Moonshot Project was launched by the IISc.

- ❖ The project aims to develop brain co-processors combining neuromorphic hardware and Artificial Intelligence (AI) algorithms.
- ❖ Brain co-processors are devices designed to enhance or restore brain functions by connecting with different parts of the brain.
- ❖ The project will create an Artificial Intelligence (AI) powered closed-loop device to restore smooth and coordinated movement.
- ❖ The technology aims to support cognitive rehabilitation and restore sensorimotor functions in stroke survivors.



Vikram 1 - Private Orbital Rocket

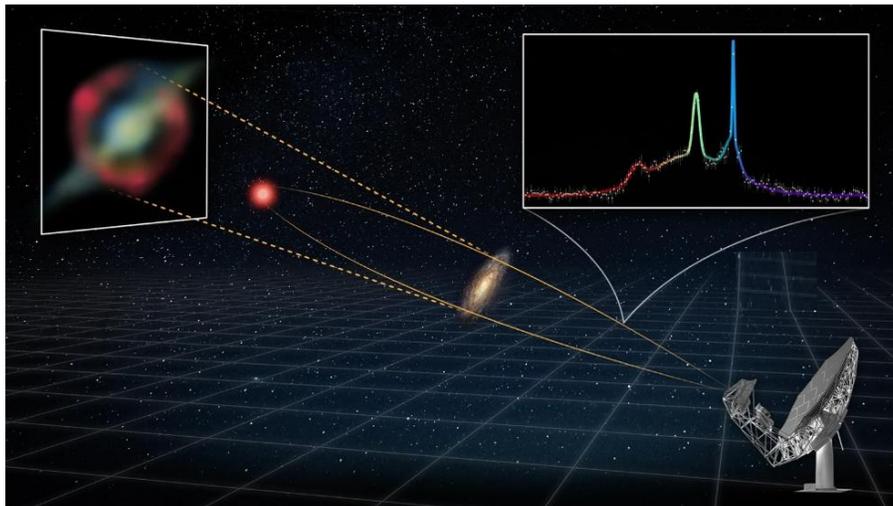


- ❖ Skyroot Aerospace is preparing to launch Vikram-1, India's first privately developed orbital rocket.
- ❖ The rocket is designed to carry satellites up to 300 kg into low Earth orbit and will be launched from Satish Dhawan Space Centre, Sriharikota.

- ❖ The rocket is named after Vikram Sarabhai, the father of India's space programme.
- ❖ Earlier, the company successfully launched Vikram-S, India's first private sub-orbital rocket, in 2022.

Megamaser Discovery

- ❖ The MeerKAT Radio Telescope detected a powerful cosmic "gigalaser" (hydroxyl megamaser) located about 8 billion light-years from Earth.
- ❖ A Megamaser is a natural cosmic source that amplifies microwave or radio waves through stimulated emission of radiation.
- ❖ The signal was produced by hydroxyl (OH) molecules in a distant galaxy during galaxy collisions and mergers.
- ❖ The radio signal was magnified by Gravitational Lensing, where a massive galaxy bends and amplifies light from a distant source.
- ❖ The MeerKAT Radio Telescope is located in South Africa and is part of the Square Kilometre Array (SKA) radio astronomy project.



ENVIRONMENT NEWS

Slender Loris Conservation Centre

- ❖ Slender Loris Conservation Centre was inaugurated in Dindigul district, the first such facility in India.
- ❖ The centre focuses on conservation and research of the Slender Loris.

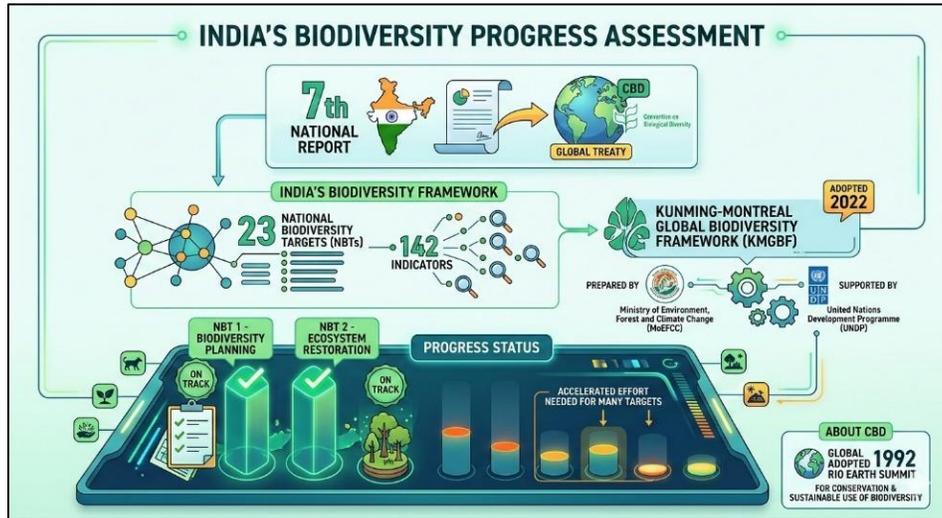
- ❖ The slender loris is a small arboreal primate found in the dry forests and scrub landscapes of southern India and Sri Lanka.
- ❖ The Tamil Nadu government earlier notified the Kadavur Slender Loris Sanctuary.
- ❖ The sanctuary covers 11,806.56 hectares across seven blocks in Dindigul and Karur districts.
- ❖ It includes reserve forests such as Thoppaswimalai, Thanneerkaradu, Mudimalai and D. Edayapatti.

India's Biodiversity Progress Assessment

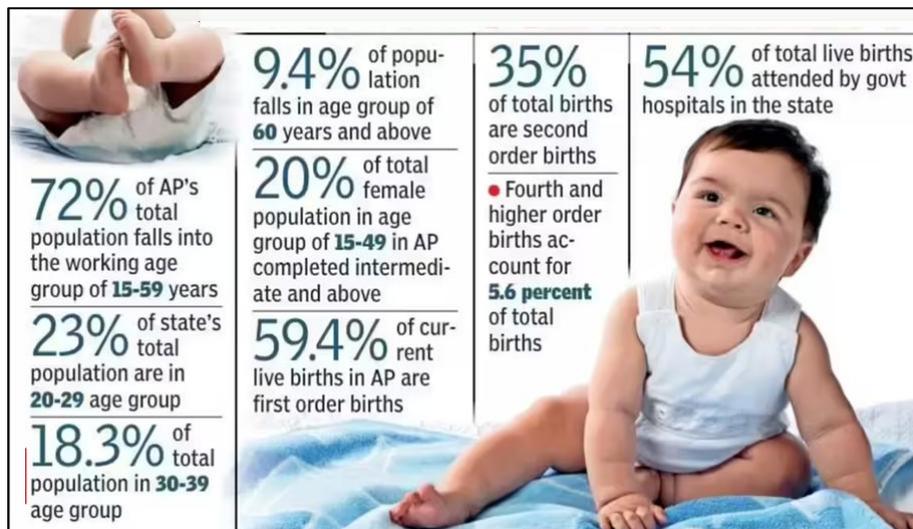
- ❖ India has submitted its 7th National Report to the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD).
- ❖ The report assesses India's progress on 23 National Biodiversity Targets (NBTs) and 142 indicators.
- ❖ These targets are aligned with the Kunming–Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework (KMGBF) adopted in 2022.
- ❖ The report was prepared by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC) with support from the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP).
- ❖ Only two targets (NBT1 – biodiversity planning and NBT2 – ecosystem restoration) are currently on track.

- ❖ The CBD is a global treaty adopted at the 1992 Rio Earth Summit for the conservation and sustainable use of biodiversity.



STATE NEWS

Childbirth Incentive Scheme



- ❖ The Andhra Pradesh government announced a ₹25,000 financial incentive for couples having a second or third child.
- ❖ The scheme aims to increase the Total Fertility Rate (TFR) in the state.
- ❖ The TFR of Andhra Pradesh is about 1.5, which is below the replacement level of 2.1.
- ❖ Under the scheme, ₹25,000 will be given to couples at the time of delivery for the second or third child.

- ❖ The policy aims to address declining birth rates and an increasing ageing population in the state.
- ❖ The government is also considering changes in rules related to the two-child norm in local body elections.
