#### TNPSC BITS

- ❖ Tamil Nadu Chief Minister announced that the Chennai-Mahabalipuram East Coast Road will be named Muthamizh Arignar Kalaignar Karunanidhi road to honour the former CM's role in the development of state highways.
- ❖ The Greater Chennai Corporation has named a street after late actor and Padma Shri recipient Vivek.
  - o The road in Virugambakkam in Chennai where the actor used to reside has been renamed as Chinna Kalaivanar Vivek Road.
- ❖ The Supreme Court has observed that the reserved category candidates securing higher marks than the last of the general category candidates are entitled to get seat/post in the General category.
- ❖ The Semicon India Conference-2022 will be inaugurated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

### Highest ever power consumption

- ❖ Tamil Nadu on 28<sup>th</sup> April recorded its highest ever (387.047 million units) power consumption.
- ❖ The previous highest power consumption in the State was 378.328 MU recorded on March 29 this year.






- ❖ So far, the highest State demand was 17,196 Mega Watt (MW), which was recorded on March 29.
- ❖ The demand, however, touched 17,370 MW on 28th April.

#### **NATIONAL**

### **All-Time High Level GST Collections**



- ❖ The GST collections in April hit an all-time high of Rs 1,67,540 crore on the back of better compliance and faster economic recovery.
- ❖ It is Rs 25,000 crore more than the previous highest collection of Rs 1,42,095 crore recorded in March.
- Month of April 2022 saw the highest ever tax collection in a single day on 20th April 2022.
- ❖ State-wise, Maharashtra saw the most GST collection at Rs 27,495 crore, followed by Karnataka (Rs 11,820 crore), Gujarat (Rs 11,264 crore), Uttar Pradesh (Rs 8,534 crore), Haryana (Rs 8,197 crore).






❖ Among the lowest GST-collecting states were Mizoram with just Rs 46 crore, Nagaland (Rs 68 crore), Manipur (Rs 69 crore), Tripura (Rs 107 crore), and Arunachal Pradesh (Rs 196 crore).

### World Bank fund for Karmayogi program



- ❖ The World Bank has approved a \$47 million project to support the Government of India's Mission Karmayogi.
- ❖ There are nearly 18 million civil servants employed across India, with approximately two-thirds at the state government and local authority level.
- ❖ The Project is aligned with the India Country Partnership Framework (CPF) FY18-22 which includes strengthening public sector institutions as one of the four areas of engagement for the World Bank in India.

#### Mandate Document of National Curriculum Framework







- ❖ The Union Minister for Education, Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Dharmendra Pradhan released a mandate document for the National Curriculum Framework under the National Education Policy in Bengaluru.
- ❖ The mandate document is the stepping stone between National Educational Policy and National Curriculum Framework.
- ❖ He described the mandate document as a step forward towards formation of new National syllabus and textbooks.

#### INTERNATIONAL

### **Mission Sagar IX**

- ❖ With the overarching aim of providing critical medical aid to Sri Lanka during the ongoing crisis, INS Gharial as part of Mission SAGAR IX reached Colombo.
- ❖ It delivered over 760 kgs of 107 types of critical lifesaving medicines.
- ❖ The shipment was received by Sri Lankan Health Minister Channa Jayasumana.



## **ENVIRONMENT**

#### Use of Disposable Masks in Cement Mixture

\* Researchers have demonstrated a way of incorporating Single-use masks into a mixture of cement to create more durable and stronger concrete.





- ❖ The mixture that was made using mask materials was 47 percent stronger than the cement that is commonly used.
- ❖ If not reused the disposable masks do not decay for decades and thus, they pose a risk to the ecosystem.



### **STATES**

#### Govt reinstates IAS officer







- ❖ IAS officer Shah Faesal has been reinstated in service after the government accepted his application for the same.
- ❖ Faesal has submitted his resignation in January 2019.
- ❖ He had founded the J&K People's Movement (JKPM), a political party in March 2019
- ❖ He was detained under the stringent Public Safety Act immediately after the abrogation of the special status of the erstwhile state of Jammu and Kashmir.
- ❖ He was released from detention on June 3, 2020.

### **Whitley Gold Award**



- ❖ The snow leopard expert and wildlife conservationist Charu dutt Mishra has won the prestigious Whitley Gold Award.
- It is referred as "Green Oscars".
- ❖ It is given by Whitley Fund for Nature (WFN) of United Kingdom.
- ❖ It recognises his contribution to involving indigenous communities in the conservation and recovery of big cat species in Asia's high mountain ecosystems.
- ❖ This is his second Whitley Fund for Nature (WFN) Award.
- ❖ He got the first in 2005.

#### **Best Infrastructure Project' Award**

❖ Border Roads Organisation's Atal Tunnel, received the Indian Building Congress (IBC) 'Best Infrastructure Project' award.





- ❖ It is located in Rohtang, Himachal Pradesh.
- ❖ It was dedicated to the nation on October 3, 2020.



# Highest diplomatic award by Peru



- ❖ The former Honorary Consul of Peru in Mumbai, Ardeshir B.K. Dubash has received the Order of "Merit in the Diplomatic Service of Peru Jose Gregorio Paz Soldan".
- ❖ Dubash was designated as Honorary Consul of Peru in 1973.
- ❖ The Order of Merit was instituted in 2004.





❖ It was named after José Gregorio Paz Soldán, the former prime minister of Peru.


### **IMPORTANT DAYS**
