# **TNPSC BITS**

- The Ministry of Defence approved procurement of 26 defence items to boost "Make in India" initiative.
  - This was done through the amendment of Public Procurement Order 2017.
- The Chief Minister Edappadi K. Palaniswami on May 19th laid the foundation stone for the construction of a government medical college at Perumbakkam in Tiruvallur district.
  - $\circ~$  While 60% of the funds for this would be borne by the Centre, the remaining by the State government.
- The Tamilnadu health Department launched an intensive 'micro-plan' to control and contain the Covid virus infection in 34 most affected wards spread over three municipal zones in Chennai.
- The European country Slovakia has recorded the lowest number of deaths per capita from the coronavirus.

# NATIONAL

#### Konark sun temple - Mission Surya Nagari

- The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) has taken up the Complete Solarisation of Konark sun temple and Konark town in Odisha.
- It was built by King Narasimhadeva I, the great ruler of Ganga dynasty in the 13th century.
- This temple was also known as 'Black Pagoda' due to its dark color.
- Similarly, the Jagannath Temple in Puri was called the "White Pagoda".
- The Konark is the third link of Odisha's Golden Triangle.
- The first link is Jagannath Puri and the second link is Bhubaneswar (Capital city of Odisha).
- ✤ The temple is included in UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1984.
- ✤ The temple is perfect blend of Kalinga architecture and its heritage.
- ✤ The Chandrabhaga Mela is conducted here annually.







### **ECONOMY**

#### FME

- The Union Cabinet has given its approval to a new Centrally Sponsored Scheme

   "Scheme for Formalization of Micro food processing Enterprises (FME)" for the
   Unorganized Sector on All India basis.
- It envisages increased access to credit by existing micro food processing entrepreneurs, women entrepreneurs and entrepreneurs in the Aspirational Districts.
- ✤ It will have Cluster approach and will focus on perishables commodities.
- ◆ It will be implemented over a 5-year period from 2020-21 to 2024-25.
- ✤ It is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS).
- Expenditure for this is to be shared by Government of India and States at 60:40.

#### **ECLGS**

- The Union Cabinet has given its approval for the Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS) for MSMEs and MUDRA borrowers.
- Under the Scheme, 100% guarantee coverage is to be provided by National Credit Guarantee Trustee Company Limited (NCGTC) for additional funding of up to Rs. 3 lakh crore to eligible MSMEs and interested MUDRA borrowers.

### Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY)

- ✤ The Union Cabinet has given its approval for implementation of this scheme.
- ✤ It is a scheme to bring about Blue Revolution.
- It will be implemented during a period of 5 years from FY 2020-21 to FY 2024-25.





The Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying is the implementation agency.



- It will be implemented through two components namely, Central Sector Scheme (CS) and Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS).
- ✤ Central Sector Scheme (CS) The entire project cost will be borne by the Central government (i.e. 100% central funding).
- The Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) Component is divided into nonbeneficiary oriented and Beneficiary orientated sub components/activities.
- Under this, the entire project cost will be shared between Centre and State as detailed below for the non-beneficiary orientated sub-components/activities.
  - $\circ~$  North Eastern & Himalayan States 90% Central share and 10% State share.
  - $\circ~$  Other States 60% Central share and 40% State share.
  - $\circ~$  Union Territories (with legislature and without legislature) 100% Central share.

## SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

#### Agappe Chitra Magna

 It is a magnetic nanoparticle-based RNA extraction kit for use during testing for the detection of COVID-19.





- It was developed by Sree Chitra Tirunal Institute for Medical Sciences and Technology (SCTIMST) of Trivandrum along with Agappe Diagnostics Ltd of Cochin.
- ✤ The kit can be used for RNA extraction for RT-LAMP, RT-qPCR, RT-PCR and other isothermal and PCR based protocols for the detection of SARS-COV-2.

### **STATES**

#### Noise at Bengaluru

- ✤ A sonic boom is said to occur when an object travels through the air faster than the speed of sound and creates shock waves.
- If the aircraft is flying at a low altitude, the sonic boom may also lead to tremors similar to earthquakes and shattering of glass.

## **IMPORTANT DAYS**

#### World Day for Cultural Diversity for Dialogue and Development - May 21

- It is a United Nations-sanctioned international holiday for the promotion of diversity issues.
- This day was created as a result of the destruction of the Buddha statues of Bamiyan in Afghanistan in 2001.

#### 1<sup>st</sup> International Tea Day - May 21

- ✤ Due to the continued efforts of India, the United Nations General Assembly passed a resolution on 19 December 2019 designating 21st May as 'International Tea Day'.
- ✤ It was adopted in 2019 by the United Nations food and Agriculture Organization.
- India is the second largest tea producing country after China.
- India accounts for 23% of the total tea production of the world.
- ✤ Also India is the world's largest producer and consumer of black tea in the world.







### National Anti-Terrorism Day - May 21

- It is observed on May 21 across India to commemorate the death anniversary of former Prime Minister of India, Rajiv Gandhi who was assassinated on this day in 1991.
- It is also recognized to make people aware of ongoing terrorist activities so that ordinary people can prevent these acts of terrorism.
