### TNPSC BITS

- ❖ Preeti Shenoy is set to publish a new novel titled "A Place Called Home".
  - o The new novel is about secrets, family, and finding yourself.
- ❖ The Union Cabinet Minister of Electronics & Information Technology, Ashwini Vaishnaw has inaugurated the National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology (NIELIT) Centre in Leh, Ladakh.
- ❖ Bharti Airtel board has reappointed Gopal Vittal as Managing Director & CEO for a further period of five years.
- ❖ The Delhi Lieutenant Governor, Anil Baijal has submitted his resignation to President Ram Nath Kovind citing personal reasons.
- Ruchi Soya, an edible oil company will acquire Patanjali Ayurved's food division.
- ❖ Jitendra Singh, Minister of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions released the e-book 'Civil List − 2022 of IAS officers.
- ❖ India's Nikhat Zareen has won the Women's World Boxing Championships in Turkey.
  - o She became only the fifth Indian woman to be crowned world champion.

### TAMIL NADU

#### Opening of Mettur dam







- ❖ Tamil Nadu Chief Minister ordered to release water from the Mettur dam on May 24.
- ❖ The level of water in the dam stood at 115.35 feet against a full reservoir level of 120 feet.
- ❖ This is the first time since Independence the Mettur dam will be opened in the month of May.

## 12,000th LHB

- ❖ The Union Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw launched the 12,000th Link Hadimani Busch (LHB) coach at the Integral Coach Factory (ICF) in Chennai.
- ❖ ICF is the first production unit of Indian Railways to achieve such a benchmark in the production of LHB coaches.
- ❖ Also, the Vande Bharat express coaches are being produced at the LHB shed of Furnishing Factory.



### 124th Ooty flower show







- ❖ Tamilnadu Chief Minister inaugurated 124<sup>th</sup> flower show at Government Botanical Garden (GBG) in Ooty.
- ❖ Ooty 200, a logo created to mark 200 years of discovery of the Nilgiris.
- ❖ In 1995, late CM J Jayalalithaa inaugurated the 100<sup>th</sup> edition of the flower show and the Government Rose Garden.
- ❖ After 22 years, the former CM Edappadi K Palanisamy inaugurated the shows in 2017 and 2018.

#### **NATIONAL**

#### **GST** council recommendations

- ❖ The Supreme Court held that the recommendations of the Goods and Services Tax (GST) Council are not binding on the Union and state governments.
- ❖ The bench stated that Article 279A of the Constitution does not begin with a non-obstante clause.
- ❖ It also stated that Article 246A does not envisage a repugnancy provision.

#### **Ethanol Blended Petrol**



- ❖ The Union Cabinet has approved amendments to the National Policy on Biofuels of 2018.
- ❖ It aims to advance the date by which fuel companies have to increase the percentage of ethanol in petrol to 20%, from 2030 to 2025.





- ❖ The policy to introduce 20% ethanol in petrol will take effect from April 1, 2023.
- ❖ India achieved 9.45% ethanol blending as on March 13, 2022, according to the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas.
- ❖ The Centre projects that this will reach 10% by the end of financial year 2022.

## **BHARAT TAP project**

- ❖ Plumbex India Exhibition ceremony of was started by Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs, Sh. Hardeep Singh Puri.
- ❖ He also announced the Bharat Tap project, a campaign to produce low-flow fixtures and sanitaryware to help India enter a new era of water conservation and sustainable development.
- ❖ Plumbex India is a three-day event that will take place in the Pragati Maidan in New Delhi.
- ❖ It is the country's largest solo exhibition on plumbing, water, and sanitation products.



### **INTERNATIONAL**

#### NDB at India

- ❖ The New Development Bank (NDB) of the BRICS countries plans to open its regional office of India at the Gujarat International Finance Tec-City (GIFT City).
- ❖ It aims to cater to infrastructure and sustainable development needs of the country.
- \* The NDB was established by BRICS nations Headquartered in Shanghai.





❖ The New Development Bank formally opened in July 2015.

### **ECONOMY**

### FDI inflow hits all-time high

- ❖ India recorded the "highest ever" annual foreign direct investment of \$83.57 billion in 2021-22.
- ❖ In 2020-21, the inflows were \$81.97 billion.
- ❖ The FDI equity inflows in manufacturing rose 76% in FY22.
- ❖ The FDI increased by around 22% post-Covid from March 2020 to March 2022 at \$171.84 billion.
- ❖ The inflows of \$141.10 billion reported pre-Covid from February 2018 to February 2020.



### **SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY**

#### World's First Habitable Planet search



❖ Chinese scientists have proposed a space project to survey the sky through a space-borne telescope.





- ❖ It aims to hunt for habitable Earth-like planets outside the solar system, about 32 light-years from Earth.
- ❖ The project, named Closeby Habitable Exoplanet Survey (CHES).
- ❖ It would be the first space mission specially designed to search for habitable terrestrial planets around nearby Sun-like stars.

## PERSONALITIES, AWARDS, AND EVENTS

#### Lifetime Achievement Award

- ❖ A.R. Venkatachalapathy, has been selected for the Lifetime Achievement Award (Iyal Award), of the Canada-based Tamil Literary Garden, for 2021.
- ❖ He is the Historian and professor of the Madras Institute of Development Studies (MIDS).
- ❖ He played a major role in taking Tamil literature and Tamil culture to people in foreign countries.
- ❖ He has been writing on history, language, culture, society and politics for the last 40 years and has written over 60 books and articles.
- Justice Chandru also selected for Iyal award for his 'Nanum Neethipathiyanen' book.



### Commander of the Order of the British Empire

- ❖ Chairman of the Piramal Group, Ajay Piramal has received an honorary Commander of the Order of the British Empire (CBE) by Her Majesty the Queen.
- ❖ He received the award for services to the UK-India trade relationship as India Co-Chair of the UK-India CEO Forum.






❖ The award was Instituted in 1917 by King George V.

# **World Economic Situation and Prospects**



❖ The World Economic Situation and Prospects (WESP) report was released by the United Nations.





- ❖ This report has been published by the Department of Economic and Social Affairs (DESA) of the UN.
- ❖ The global economy this year is expected to grow by only 3.1 per cent.
- ❖ The earlier prediction in January was 4.0 per cent.
- ❖ This report has highlighted that India is still the world's fastest-growing major economy even though the Russia-Ukraine conflict is impacting gross domestic product (GDP) across the globe.
- ❖ According to the report, in 2022, India has been projected to grow by 6.4 per cent.
- ❖ This is slower than 2021's 8.8 per cent.
