
# TAMIL NADU

#### Kalaignar Village Integrated Agriculture Development Program

- M.K. Stalin launched the Kalaignar's All Village Integrated Agriculture Development Project in the districts of Krishnagiri, Dharmapuri and Erode.
- Under the programme, the schemes implemented by more than 15 departments including agriculture, horticulture and agricultural engineering will be focused on the villages.
- The government is planning to cover all the panchayats in the district in a few years.

# NATIONAL

#### First case of Omicron BA.5 variant



- The first case of Omicron sub-variant BA.5 in India has been detected in Telangana.
- ✤ He is the 1<sup>st</sup> person tested positive for the sub-variant, as per Indian SARS-COV-2 Genomics Consortium (INSACOG).
- ✤ INSACOG has also confirmed that a South African traveller, was reported positive for the BA.4 variant on arrival at Hyderabad airport.
- ✤ It was the first case of BA.4 Omicron sub-variant in India.





- ◆ A 19-year-old girl in Tamil Nadu was found infected with the BA.4 sub-variant.
- ◆ BA.4 and BA.5 are sub-variants of the Omicron variant circulating globally.

#### **Project WARDEC**

- The Army Training Command and Gandhinagar-based Rastriya Raksha University inked a memorandum of understanding to establish a Wargame Research and Development Centre in New Delhi.
- ✤ The project, was dubbed 'WARDEC' as a prototype.
- It will be India's first simulation-based training centre.
- It will use artificial intelligence (AI) to create virtual reality wargames.

## **INTERNATIONAL**

#### Meeting of Board of Governors of NDB

- Nirmala Sitharaman chaired the 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting of Board of Governors of NDB.
- The meeting was also attended by Governors/Alternate Governors of Brazil, China, Russia, South Africa and the newly joined members Bangladesh and United Arab Emirates (UAE).
- This year's theme for the Annual Meeting was "NDB: Optimising Development Impact".

#### Finland and Sweden NATO membership






- Turkey's president announced the country's opposition to Finland and Sweden joining NATO.
- ✤ NATO members, Norway, Denmark and Iceland have all said they are ready to support Sweden and Finland.
- ✤ UK has already given security guarantees to both countries to cover the transition period.
- However, without the support of all NATO members, Sweden and Finland cannot join the military alliance.

#### **Bankrupt Declaration of country - Srilanka**

- Sri Lankan Prime Minister Ranil Wickremesinghe has declared the country bankrupt as it faces a fuel crisis and food shortages.
- Meanwhile, Sri Lanka's central bank has secured foreign exchange to pay for fuel and cooking gas shipments that will ease crippling shortages.
- Most of Sri Lanka's petrol stations have run dry as the island nation battles its most devastating economic crisis since independence in 1948.

#### **Poliovirus case**



- Mozambique has identified its first case of wild poliovirus Type 1 after a child contracted the disease.
- $\clubsuit$  It is the country's first such case since 1992.
- ◆ It is the second imported case of wild poliovirus in Southern Africa this year.
- ♦ As of today, wild poliovirus is endemic only in Afghanistan and Pakistan.
- There are three variants of the poliovirus, numbered 1 to 3.





- For a country to be declared polio-free, the wild transmission of all three kinds has to be stopped.
- For eradication, cases of both wild and vaccine-derived polio infection have to be reduced to zero.
- ✤ India was declared polio-free in January 2014, after three years of zero cases.

## **Global Report on Assistive Technology (AT)**



- The World Health Organisation and UNICEF jointly launched the first Global Report on Assistive Technology (GReAT).
- This report is the culmination of the 71<sup>st</sup> World Health Assembly resolution in 2018 to prepare a global report on effective access to assistive technology.
- ✤ More than 2.5 billion people need one or more assistive products, such as wheelchairs, hearing aids, or apps that support communication and cognition.
- ✤ A billion of them are denied access.





- Particularly in low and middle income countries, access can be as low as 3% of the need for these life-changing products.
- The number of people in need of one or more assistive products is likely to rise to 3.5 billion by 2050.
- AT is any item, piece of equipment, software program or product system that is used to increase, maintain or improve the functional capabilities of persons with disabilities.

# SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

## **Flying Trainer HANSA-NG**

- ◆ It is developed by the CSIR-National Aerospace Laboratories (CSIR-NAL).
- The HANSA-NG, or HANSA-New Generation, is one of the most advanced flying trainers.
- HANSA-NG is an upgraded version of HANSA, which saw the first flight in 1993, and was certified in 2000.
- It is an ideal aircraft for Commercial Pilot Licensing (CPL) due to its low cost and low fuel consumption.

#### **International Professional Boxing Tournament**

The first ever professional international boxing tournament of Bangladesh was held in Dhaka.





India's two-time national Champion Harsh Gill won his bout by defeating Bangladesh's Hira Miah.

# **IMPORTANT DAYS**

### International Day for Biological Diversity (IDB) - May 22

- ✤ It aims to increase awareness and understanding of the issues of biodiversity.
- When first created by the Second Committee of the UN General Assembly in late 1993, 29 December.
- This date marks of entry into force of the Convention of Biological Diversity.
- ♦ Initially, this date was designated the International Day for Biological Diversity.
- ✤ In December 2000, the UN General Assembly adopted 22 May as IDB.
- ✤ The theme in 2022 is "Building a shared future for all life".



## **MISCELLANEOUS**

#### **Third Advance Estimates for Production of Major Crops**

- The Union Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare has released the third advance estimate of the production of major agricultural crops for 2021-22.
- The food grains production in the country has been estimated at 314.51 million tonnes.
- ✤ This is a record high.
- ✤ And it is higher by 3.77 million tonnes from the food grain production during 2020-21.
- During 2021-22, the average food grain production was higher by 23.80 million tonnes as compared to the previous five years from 2016-17 to 2020-21.





There has been an estimated record production of maize, rice, oilseeds, pulses, rapeseed, gram, sugarcane, and mustard.
