TNPSC BITS

- Microsoft Corporation has surpassed Apple to become the world's most valuable publicly-traded company by market capitalisation.
- The Union Minister Dr Jitendra Singh has dedicated to the nation "Sardar Patel Leadership Centre" at Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration (LBSNAA) in Mussoorie of Uttarakhand.
 - The facility was inaugurated on the occasion of Rashtriya Ekta Diwas on October 31, 2021.
- The Asian Development Bank has approved a USD 250 million (about Rs 1,875 crore) loan to support India's National Industrial Corridor Development Program (NICDP).
 - This is the first subprogram of the programmatic USD 500 million loans to develop 11 industrial corridors spanning 17 states.
- ✤ The National Small Matchbox Manufacturers Association has increased the price of a matchbox from Rs.1 to Rs. 2 per box.
 - The increase in the price of matchbox has been done after 14 years since last increase in 2007 from 50 paise to Re. 1.
- The World Vegan Day is observed globally on 1st November every year.
 - This day is celebrated to spread the benefits of veganism for humans, nonhuman animals, and the natural environment.

NATIONAL

Climate Equity Monitor

- Climate Equity Monitor is an online dashboard that went live recently.
- India's Climate Equity Monitor (CEM) will assess equity in climate action, inequalities in emissions, energy & resource consumption across the world, and ongoing climate policies of several countries.
- This will encourage a vigorous discussion on this crucial issue and engage experts from all countries.





NCLAT Chairperson - Ashok Bhushan

- The Centre has appointed former Supreme Court Judge Justice Ashok Bhushan as the new Chairperson of the National Company Law Appellate Tribunal (NCLAT).
- ✤ He was the former Chief Justice of Kerala High Court.
- NCLAT was formed by the government under Section 410 of the Companies Act, 2013.

- In India, seven states namely, Andhra Pradesh, Haryana, Chhattisgarh, Kerala, Karnataka, Punjab & Madhya Pradesh and two union territories Lakshadweep & Puducherry are celebrating Foundation Day on November 1, 2021.
- ♦ Earlier, Tamil Nadu also used to celebrate its foundation day on November 1.
- On October 30, 2021, the ruling DMK in Tamil Nadu announced that Tamil Nadu Formation Day will be celebrated on July 18.





In Karnataka, this day is celebrated as "Rajyotsav".

Dairy Sahakar Scheme

- The Union Minister of Cooperation Amit Shah launched the "Dairy Sahakar" scheme of the National Cooperative Development Corporation (NCDC).
- The overall objectives of the Dairy Sahakar scheme are
 - o Doubling the farmers' income and
 - o Atma nirbhar Bharat.
- Dairy Sahakar with a total investment of Rs. 5000 crores will be implemented to realize the vision, "from cooperation to prosperity"

INTERNATIONAL

Milu Deer



- The comeback of Milu Deer from the brink of extinction marks a rare success for China's conservation efforts.
- Milu deer (Elaphurus davidianus) is a rare and endangered species.
- ✤ Also known as Pere David's deer, these animals were on the verge of disappearing towards the end of the 19th century.






• Milu deer is native and endemic to the river valleys of China.

ECONOMY

Interest rate on EPF

- The Ministry of Finance has approved the interest rate on employee's provident fund (EPF) deposits for 2020-21 at 8.5%.
- ✤ The rate has been kept unchanged for the year 2019-20.
- EPF is one fixed-income instrument that is completely tax-free under the exempt-exempt-exempt (EEE) regime, along with PPF and the Sukanya Samriddhi Account.



ENVIRONMENT

India endorses Emission list

- India officially endorsed a website made by Indian climate experts, listing the historical carbon dioxide emissions of developed countries.
- An emission list was created with the aim of highlighting the disparity between the emissions of developed and developing countries.
- Countries like the United States, Australia, Canada & countries in Western Europe are shown as having a net carbon debt.
- Developing countries like India & China are having net credit.
- Thus, the database highlights that, it is only fair that developed countries should commit to steeper targets for curbing emissions as compared to developing countries.





Note

- India is the third-largest emitter of carbon emissions on yearly basis.
- ♦ However, it is the sixth-largest with respect to its historical emissions.
- When the size of its population is considered, it is among the lowest per capita emitters.

STATES

Apple Festival

- Union Agriculture Minister, Narendra Singh Tomar and Lt Governor, Manoj Sinha have virtually inaugurated Apple Festival.
- * This is organized for the first time in Srinagar, Jammu and Kashmir.
- With an annual production of more than 2 million metric tonnes, apple from J&K contributes to 87% of the national production.

Indus River dolphin - Census

- The state of Punjab is set to start the Census of Indus River dolphin.
- Indus River dolphin is scientifically called Platanista gangetica minor.
- ✤ It is a freshwater dolphin, found in the river Beas.
- ✤ The project will be implemented over five years.
- In 2019, the Indus River dolphin was declared as the State aquatic animal of Punjab.
