TNPSC BITS

- 18-year-old Sankalp Gupta from Nagpur of Maharashtra became India's 71st Grandmaster.
 - Sankalp Gupta achieved this after he secured the three required GM norms in just 24 days in chess.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi signed up to the UK's Glasgow Breakthroughs, launched at the COP26 climate summit.
 - $\circ\,$ It is an international plan to deliver clean and affordable technology everywhere by 2030.
- The lawmakers in the US announced that a bill has been introduced in the House of Representatives to declare Diwali a federal holiday.
 - This was led by Carolyn B Maloney from New York.

TAMIL NADU

Madras high court on 10.5 per cent Vanniyar quota



- The Madurai Bench of Madras high court set aside a Tamil Nadu legislation granting 10.5% reservation to the Vanniyar community within an existing 20% quota for the most backward classes (MBC) in the state.
- ✤ It held the law to be unconstitutional.
- ✤ It held that the state government is empowered to do internal reservation.
- ✤ It asked how the percentage of 10.5% had been arrived with no clear caste census.





The court clarified that the order nullifying the reservation will not impact those who have been admitted to institutions under the quota.

Background

- The law carving 10.5% reservation for Vanniyar within 20% reservation for Most Backward Classes (MBCs) was notified by the previous AIADMK government on February 26 in 2021.
- The present Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (DMK) government issued an order to fully implement the reservation.

NATIONAL

India Green Guarantee

- ◆ The UK will provide an "India Green Guarantee" to the World Bank.
- ♦ It is to unlock an additional 750 million pounds for green projects across India.
- ✤ This was announced at the COP26 summit in Glasgow, Scotland.
- The green guarantee financing will support clean and resilient infrastructure in sectors such as clean energy, transport and urban development.
- The "Clean Green Initiative" was also launched at COP26 to help developing countries take advantage of green technology and grow their economies sustainably.

\$1 trillion Climate finance

- ✤ India said that climate finance cannot continue at the levels decided in 2009.
- ✤ It emphasised that it should be at least \$1 trillion to meet the goals of addressing climate change.
- This was said at the Ministerial meeting of Like-Minded Developing Countries (LMDC) at the 26th international climate conference in Glasgow, Scotland.

Electric vehicle charging stations

- The State-run refiners have announced plans to build thousands of electric vehicle (EV) charging stations to aid the country's net-zero carbon target by 2070.
- Indian Oil Corporation (IOC) will set up 10,000 electric vehicle charging stations in the next three years.
- ✤ It is also drawing up plans to cut greenhouse gas emissions from its operations.





- Bharat Petroleum also announced a plan to provide EV charging infrastructure at its 7,000 fuel stations in the next few years.
- In September 2021, Hindustan Petroleum Corporation announced a plan to set up 5,000 EV charging stations in the country in three years.

Malnourished children in India

- ✤ According to the Women and Child Ministry, there are more than 33 lakh malnourished children in India.
- The Ministry further notes that more than half of the children are in the severely malnourished category.
- ✤ This figure was reported from the Poshan tracker.
- ✤ Maharashtra, Bihar and Gujarat are topping the list.

- ✤ It is followed by Haryana, Punjab, Tamilnadu.
- ◆ LEADS 2021 is the 3rd edition of the LEADS report (1st -2018; 2nd 2019).
- It includes the methodologies to identify the logistics infrastructure and services across India.

Goa Maritime Conclave



- ✤ The third edition of the annual Goa Maritime Conclave (GMC-21) started in Goa.
- In the conclave, India will be host to the Navy chiefs of 12 nations of the Indian Ocean Region.
- Chief of the Naval Staff Admiral Karambir Singh would chair the conclave.
- They will discuss the significance of interoperability for effectively dealing with emerging & future maritime security challenges in the Indian Ocean Region.
- The theme of GMC 2021 is "Maritime Security and Emerging Non-Traditional Threats: A case for proactive role for Indian Ocean Region".

INTERNATIONAL

Global Drug Policy Index

- India ranked 18 out of 30 countries in the 1st edition of the Global Drug Policy Index.
- ♦ It was released by the Harm Reduction Consortium in November 2021.





- The index ranks Norway, New Zealand, Portugal, the United Kingdom (UK) and Australia as the top 5 countries on humane and health-driven drug policies.
- The five lowest-ranking countries are Brazil, Uganda, Indonesia, Kenya, and Mexico.

- November 9 marks the formation of the state of Uttaranchal in 2000.
- ✤ The state's name was changed to Uttarakhand in 2007.
- The state is known as the Land of Gods or "Dev Bhumi"





- Gairsain has been announced as the summer capital of Uttarakhand in March 2020.
- The winter capital of Uttarakhand is Dehradun.

- Every year from 9 to 14 November, the International Week of Science and Peace (IWOSP) is observed and celebrated globally.
- This special week is marked to inspire people to promote peace in their own countries as well as develop better technology for development.
