TNPSC BITS

- ✤ Karnataka's highest civilian award, the 'Karnataka Ratna' was conferred posthumously on late actor Puneeth Rajkumar.
- Indian junior men's hockey team defeated Australia to win the Sultan of Johor Cup 2022.
- All India Football Federation, Ministry for Education and FIFA signed a MoU to broad base football across various schools in the country through the Football for Schools programme.
- ✤ The bi-annual Indian Naval Commanders' Conference held in new Delhi.
- The 15-member committee under Rakesh Joshi has been set up for two years by the IRDAI to achieve objective of universalization of health insurance in India.
- India is going to contribute half a million dollars to the United Nations' efforts to counter global terrorism at a time when new and emerging technologies used by terror groups are posing fresh threats to governments around the world.

NATIONAL

Sustainability performance in 2022



Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited (BPCL), has once again achieved the No.1 rank in the Indian oil and gas sector for its sustainability performance in the 2022 edition rankings.





- This index was released by S&P Dow Jones Sustainability Indices (DJSI) Corporate Sustainability Assessment (CSA).
- This is the 3rd consecutive year that BPCL is at the top of the DJSI Indices.

National Model Vedic School

- Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan inaugurated the country's second Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya (RAVV) in Puri.
- It aims to spreading knowledge of the Vedas among people.
- The RAVV or the National Model Vedic School has come up on the campus of the Central Sanskrit University.
- Maharishi Sandipani Rashtriya Ved Vidya Pratishthan is the first such school in Madhya Pradesh's Ujjain.



India Chem 2022







- ✤ The 12th edition of the India Chem 2022 will be jointly organized by the Department of Chemicals and Petrochemicals and FICCI.
- Theme of the event will be "Vision 2030: Chemicals and Petrochemicals Build India".
- India Chem is the flagship event of the Indian Government's Department of Chemicals & Petrochemicals.
- ◆ It is the largest event focusing on Indian chemicals and petrochemical industry.
- ✤ It is one of the largest composite events of the industry in the Asia-Pacific Region.

C-295 Aircraft



- Prime Minister laid the foundation stone of a C295 aircraft manufacturing plant in Vadodara, Gujarat.
- ✤ Tata-Airbus consortium that will manufacture the transport aircraft for the Indian Air Force (IAF).
- It is the first project of its kind in which a military aircraft will be manufactured in India by a private company.
- It is also the first time that the C295 aircraft will be manufactured outside of Europe.
- The C295 was originally produced by a Spanish aircraft manufacturer named Construccionaes Aeronauticcas SA.
- In September 2021, India signed deal with Airbus Defence and Space to procure 56 C295 aircraft to replace the IAF's Avro-748 planes.
- ✤ Under the agreement, Airbus will deliver the first 16 aircraft in 'fly-away' condition.





 Subsequent 40 aircraft will be manufactured by Tata Advanced Systems Ltd (TASL) in India as part of an industrial partnership between the two companies.

INTERNATIONAL

First Trilateral Exercise

- The first edition of the India-Mozambique-Tanzania Trilateral Exercise commenced at Tanzania.
- The exercise has three main objectives including capability development to address common threats through training and sharing of best practices, enhancing interoperability, and strengthening maritime cooperation.



GCOS conference

- The 'Global Climate Observing System (GCOS)' conference was organised in Darmstadt, Germany.
- ✤ It was hosted by Exploitation of Meteorological Satellites (EUMETSAT).
- It co-sponsored by the World Meteorological Organization (WMO), Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission of UNESCO, UNEP, and International Science Council.





✤ As per the declaration of the conference, sustainable and long-term funding is essential to ensure the continuity and expansion of observations.

- Russia recently came out of the Black Sea Grain Deal.
- It was launched to mitigate food inflation caused by conflict in Ukraine.
- It was an agreement between Russia and Ukraine with Turkey and the United Nations.
- It sought to create a safe passage of food grains exported from Ukraine, which is currently in war with Russia.
- Under this agreement, export of grain, food and fertilizers will be allowed to resume from Ukraine via a "safe maritime humanitarian corridor" from three key Ukrainian ports i.e., Chornomorsk, Odesa, and Yuzhny/Pivdennyi.
- ✤ Black Sea Grain deal was set to expire on November 19, 2022.
- The renewal negotiations were led by the United Nations throughout October 2022.





However, Russia pulled out of this agreement on October 29 due to drone attack on its naval ships in the port of Sevastopol.

ECONOMY

Gold import under CEPA

- Malabar Gold & Diamonds, is the first jeweller to import 25 kg of gold as part of the Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA) between India and the UAE.
- According to the arrangement, the gold was imported through ICICI Bank with a 1% duty rebate.
- For the first time in India, the firm has successfully utilised the duty benefits of the agreement for both import and export.
- ◆ The 5% import charge into the UAE has been waived as per the agreement.
- ✤ The CEPA between India and the UAE came into force on May 1, 2022.

STATES

First Electronics Manufacturing Cluster

- The government of India approves Maharashtra's first greenfield Electronics Manufacturing Cluster (EMC) at Ranjangaon, Pune.
- ✤ Its objective is to strengthen the electronics manufacturing ecosystem in India.

New national records



- Akanksha Vyavahare, has created three new national records in the 40kg weight category at the Khelo India National Ranking Women's Weightlifting Tournament.

- She recorded 71 kg in the clean jerk and





✤ The process registered a total lift of 131 kg.

Earnings call on the metaverse



- Reliance Industries Limited (RIL) posted the proceedings of its Q2 FY 2022-23 earnings call on the metaverse.
- This is the first time in the history of corporate India that a company has used metaverse to engage with its stakeholders.
- ✤ The RIL metaverse was produced in partnership with GMetri, a no-code metaverse creation platform.
