ENVIRONMENT


Snow leopard at Baltal-Zojila region

❖ The snow leopard presence was recorded from the Baltal-Zojila region, Kashmir.





- ❖ It is the first record of snow leopard from the Baltal-Zojila area.
- Snow Leopard population estimation is part of the Snow Leopard Population Assessment of India.
- Camera trapping exercises also raised hopes for other important and rare species such as the Asiatic ibex, brown bear and Kashmir musk deer in the upper reaches of the northernmost part of India.
- ❖ The Snow Leopard Population Assessment of India has been concluded so far in Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand.
- ❖ The estimated population of the great cat is 50 and 100 in these two States respectively.

World's Best Employers ranking 2022



- ❖ Forbes' recently released World's Best Employers ranking 2022.
- ❖ Reliance Industries Ltd is ranked India's best employer and among top 20 worldwide.
- ❖ The Forbes list is topped by South Korean smartphone and electronics maker Samsung.





- ❖ It is followed by tech giants Microsoft, IBM, Alphabet, and Apple.
- ❖ Reliance Industries occupies 20th place on the list and is the only Indian company in the top 100.
- ❖ Only 7 Indian companies figure in the top 500 in the list.
- Other Indian firms in the list are: HDFC Bank, (137), Bajaj (173), Aditya Birla Group (240), Larsen & Toubro (354), ICICI Bank (365), HCL Technologies (455), and State Bank of India at 499th place.

Uttarakhand Gaurav Samman



- ❖ National Security Advisor (NSA) Ajit Doval, and late CDS General Bipin Rawat are among five distinguished people for the "Uttarakhand Gaurav Samman" this year.
- ❖ The writer Prasoon Joshi, the late poet and author Girish Chandra Tiwari and late journalist Viren Dangwal will be awarded posthumously with the award.
- ❖ The award was introduced in 2021 by the Uttarakhand Government led by CM Pushkar Singh Dhami, as one of the two highest state-level civilian awards.
- ❖ Another one is Uttarakhand Ratna.
- ❖ People are awarded for their extraordinary contribution to any field of human endeavour.

Pushkar Fair

❖ This year, Pushkar Fair is hosted by Rajasthan.





- ❖ Pushkar Fair is also known as Pushkar Camel Fair, Kartik Mela, or Kartik ka Mela.

World Immunity Day - November 10




- ❖ It aims to spread the incredible health benefits of getting vaccinated and how it can prevent many diseases and disorders.

- ❖ In 1999, UNESCO and the International Council for Science organized the firstever World Scientific Conference in Budapest.
- ❖ November 10, 2002 marked the first World Science Day for Peace and Development

World Public Transport Day - November 10
